

Baby Bush Pilot Knitting Pattern



Materials:

- Yarn: Approximately 55 yards of aran (4) weight yarn for smaller sizes and approx. 95 yards for larger sizes. Also approx. 25 yards of aran (4) as an accent color (I used Laines Du Nord – Opaline. State it is a bulky, but is really more of an aran)
- Knitting Needles: Size 6.0 mm (US 10) Double Pointed Needles (or use the Magic Loop Method) and Straight Needles OR size needed to obtain gauge
- Yarn or Tapestry Needle
- 2 Buttons

Abbreviations:

- M1 (Make 1): On a knit row: Insert left needle, front to back, under the strand between st on left needle and st on right needle making a new loop on left needle. Knit this loop through the back.
- K2tog: Knit two stitches together
- **: Repeat the section in between the two stars as specified

Gauge:

9 sts and 12 rows = 2 inches (5 centimeters) in stockinette stitch
It is important to check your gauge!

Average Head Circumference:

0-3 Months: 14-15"
3-6 Months: 14-17"
6-12 Months: 16-19"
1-3 Years: 18-20"
3-10 Years: 19-20.5"
Pre-teen/Teen: 20.5-22"
Adult Female: 21.5-22.5"
Adult Male: 23-24"

Newborn Hat Pattern

CO 4 sts with main yarn onto straight needles (Leave a 18-20 inch tail to use for sewing on the inside accent yarn parts into the earflaps)

Row 1: Knit

Row 2: Purl

Row 3: K1, M1, K2, M1, K1 (6 total sts)

Row 4: Purl

Row 5: K1, M1, K4, M1, K1 (8 total sts)

Row 6: Purl

Row 7: K1, M1, K6, M1, K1 (10 total sts)

Row 8: Purl

Row 9: K1, M1, K8, M1, K1 (12 total sts)

Row 10: Purl

Row 11: K1, M1, K10, M1, K1 (14 total sts)

Row 12: Purl

Row 13: K1, M1, K12, M1, K1 (16 total sts)

Rows 14-18: Alternate between purling and knitting, purling row 14

Place on stitch holder, cut yarn and set aside.

Cast on 12 sts with accent yarn onto straight needles

Row 1: *K1, P1* Repeat across

Row 2: *P1, K1* Repeat across

Repeat row 1 for all odd rows through row 11

Repeat row 2 for all even rows through row 12

Place on stitch holder, cut yarn and set aside.

Repeat Rows 1-18 from first earflap for the second earflap. Cast on 10 more stitches

Place earflaps and accent yarn piece onto Double Pointed Needles (or use the Magic Loop Method), or on a smaller circular needle. The accent yarn piece should be in the center of the two earflaps, and the earflap without the extra cast on stitches should be the first one purled after being joined in the round. See picture 1.

Join in the round with the purled side facing and place stitch marker.

You should have a total of 54 sts

Round 1: P16, K12, P26

Rounds 2-19: Purl

Round 20: *P2tog, P7* Repeat around (48 total sts)

Round 21: *P2tog, P6* Repeat around (42 total sts)

Switch to Double Pointed Needles at this point if you are using a cable needle

Round 22: *P2tog, P5* Repeat around (36 total sts)

Round 23: *P2tog, P4* Repeat around (30 total sts)

Round 24: *P2tog, P3* Repeat around (24 total sts)

Round 25: *P2tog, P2* Repeat around (18 total sts)

Round 26: *P2tog, P1* Repeat around (12 total sts)

Do not bind off. Cut approx. 7 inch tail. Using yarn needle, remove all sts from DPNs or magic loop, as if to purl. Pull tail through sts to cinch the top of hat. Using yarn needle, pull tail through to the inside of the hat. Tie a knot and weave in all ends except at the base of the earflaps.

Cast on 2 stitches with accent yarn onto straight needles

Row 1: Purl

Row 2: K1, M1, K1 (3 total sts)

Row 3: Purl

Row 4: K1, M1, K1, M1, K1 (5 total sts)

Row 5: Purl

Row 6: K1, M1, K3, M1, K1 (7 total sts)

Row 7: Purl

Row 8: K1, M1, K5, M1, K1 (9 total sts)

Row 9: Purl

Row 10: K1, M1, K7, M1, K1 (11 total sts)

Row 11: Purl

Row 12: K1, M1, K9, M1, K1 (13 total sts)

Row 13: Purl

Row 14: K1, M1, K11, M1, K1 (15 total sts)

Row 15: Purl

Bind off as if to knit. Cut and weave in all ends and use your yarn needle and the main yarn at the base of the earflaps to secure to the inside of the earflap (knit side faces the baby on mine).

Fold up the accent yarn piece and use your main color of yarn to stitch around the edge.

Secure two buttons to the piece on either side.

0-3 Month Hat Pattern

CO 4 sts with main yarn onto straight needles (Leave a 18-20 inch tail to use for sewing on the inside accent yarn parts into the earflaps)

Row 1: Knit

Row 2: Purl

Row 3: K1, M1, K2, M1, K1 (6 total sts)

Row 4: Purl

Row 5: K1, M1, K4, M1, K1 (8 total sts)

Row 6: Purl

Row 7: K1, M1, K6, M1, K1 (10 total sts)

Row 8: Purl

Row 9: K1, M1, K8, M1, K1 (12 total sts)

Row 10: Purl

Row 11: K1, M1, K10, M1, K1 (14 total sts)

Row 12: Purl

Row 13: K1, M1, K12, M1, K1 (16 total sts)

Rows 14-18: Alternate between purling and knitting, purling row 14

Place on stitch holder, cut yarn and set aside.

Cast on 14 sts with accent yarn onto straight needles

Row 1: *K1, P1* Repeat across

Row 2: *P1, K1* Repeat across

Repeat row 1 for all odd rows through row 11

Repeat row 2 for all even rows through row 12

Place on stitch holder, cut yarn and set aside.

Repeat Rows 1-18 from first earflap for the second earflap. Cast on 12 more stitches

Place earflaps and accent yarn piece onto Double Pointed Needles (or use the Magic Loop Method), or on a smaller circular needle. The accent yarn piece should be in the center of the two earflaps, and the earflap without the extra cast on stitches should be the first one purled after being joined in the round. See picture 1.

Join in the round with the purled side facing and place stitch marker.

You should have a total of 58 sts

Round 1: P16, K14, P28

Rounds 2-21: Purl

Round 23: P2tog, P12, P2tog, P13, P2tog, P12, P2tog, P13 (54 total sts)

Round 24: *P2tog, P7* Repeat around (48 total sts)

Round 25: *P2tog, P6* Repeat around (42 total sts)

Switch to Double Pointed Needles at this point if you are using a cable needle

Round 26: *P2tog, P5* Repeat around (36 total sts)

Round 27: *P2tog, P4* Repeat around (30 total sts)

Round 28: *P2tog, P3* Repeat around (24 total sts)

Round 29: *P2tog, P2* Repeat around (18 total sts)

Round 30: *P2tog, P1* Repeat around (12 total sts)

Do not bind off. Cut approx. 7 inch tail. Using yarn needle, remove all sts from DPNs or magic loop, as if to purl. Pull tail through sts to cinch the top of hat. Using yarn needle, pull tail through to the inside of the hat. Tie a knot and weave in all ends except at the base of the earflaps.

Cast on 2 stitches with accent yarn onto straight needles

Row 1: Purl

Row 2: K1, M1, K1 (3 total sts)

Row 3: Purl

Row 4: K1, M1, K1, M1, K1 (5 total sts)

Row 5: Purl

Row 6: K1, M1, K3, M1, K1 (7 total sts)

Row 7: Purl

Row 8: K1, M1, K5, M1, K1 (9 total sts)

Row 9: Purl

Row 10: K1, M1, K7, M1, K1 (11 total sts)

Row 11: Purl

Row 12: K1, M1, K9, M1, K1 (13 total sts)

Row 13: Purl

Row 14: K1, M1, K11, M1, K1 (15 total sts)

Row 15: Purl

Bind off as if to knit. Cut and weave in all ends and use your yarn needle and the main yarn at the base of the earflaps to secure to the inside of the earflap (knit side faces the baby on mine).

Fold up the accent yarn piece and use your main color of yarn to stitch around the edge.

Secure two buttons to the piece on either side.

3-6 Month Hat Pattern

CO 4 sts with main yarn onto straight needles (Leave a 18-20 inch tail to use for sewing on the inside accent yarn parts into the earflaps)

Row 1: Knit

Row 2: Purl

Row 3: K1, M1, K2, M1, K1 (6 total sts)

Row 4: Purl

Row 5: K1, M1, K4, M1, K1 (8 total sts)

Row 6: Purl

Row 7: K1, M1, K6, M1, K1 (10 total sts)

Row 8: Purl

Row 9: K1, M1, K8, M1, K1 (12 total sts)

Row 10: Purl

Row 11: K1, M1, K10, M1, K1 (14 total sts)

Row 12: Purl

Row 13: K1, M1, K12, M1, K1 (16 total sts)

Row 14: Purl

Row 15: K1, M1, K14, M1, K1 (18 total sts)

Rows 16-20: Alternate between purling and knitting, purling row 16

Place on stitch holder, cut yarn and set aside.

Cast on 14 sts with accent yarn onto straight needles

Row 1: *K1, P1* Repeat across

Row 2: *P1, K1* Repeat across

Repeat row 1 for all odd rows through row 13

Repeat row 2 for all even rows through row 14

Place on stitch holder, cut yarn and set aside.

Repeat Rows 1-20 from first earflap for the second earflap. Cast on 12 more stitches

Place earflaps and accent yarn piece onto Double Pointed Needles (or use the Magic Loop Method), or on a smaller circular needle. The accent yarn piece should be in the center of the two earflaps, and the earflap without the extra cast on stitches should be the first one purled after being joined in the round. See picture 1.

Join in the round with the purled side facing and place stitch marker.

You should have a total of 62 sts

Round 1: P18, K14, P30

Rounds 2-23: Purl

Round 24: *P2tog, P29* Repeat around (60 total sts)

Round 25: *P2tog, P8* Repeat around (54 total sts)

Round 26: *P2tog, P7* Repeat around (48 total sts)

Round 27: *P2tog, P6* Repeat around (42 total sts)

Switch to Double Pointed Needles at this point if you are using a cable needle

Round 28: *P2tog, P5* Repeat around (36 total sts)

Round 29: *P2tog, P4* Repeat around (30 total sts)

Round 30: *P2tog, P3* Repeat around (24 total sts)

Round 31: *P2tog, P2* Repeat around (18 total sts)

Round 32: *P2tog, P1* Repeat around (12 total sts)

Do not bind off. Cut approx. 7 inch tail. Using yarn needle, remove all sts from DPNs or magic loop, as if to purl. Pull tail through sts to cinch the top of hat. Using yarn needle, pull tail through to the inside of the hat.

Tie a knot and weave in all ends except at the base of the earflaps.

Cast on 2 stitches with accent yarn onto straight needles

Row 1: Purl

Row 2: K1, M1, K1 (3 total sts)

Row 3: Purl

Row 4: K1, M1, K1, M1, K1 (5 total sts)

Row 5: Purl

Row 6: K1, M1, K3, M1, K1 (7 total sts)

Row 7: Purl

Row 8: K1, M1, K5, M1, K1 (9 total sts)

Row 9: Purl

Row 10: K1, M1, K7, M1, K1 (11 total sts)

Row 11: Purl

Row 12: K1, M1, K9, M1, K1 (13 total sts)

Row 14: K1, M1, K11, M1, K1 (15 total sts)

Bind off as if to knit. Cut and weave in all ends and use your yarn needle and the main yarn at the base of the earflaps to secure to the inside of the earflap (knit side faces the baby on mine).

Fold up the accent yarn piece and use your main color of yarn to stitch around the edge.

Secure two buttons to the piece on either side.

6-12 Month Hat Pattern

CO 4 sts with main yarn onto straight needles (Leave a 18-20 inch tail to use for sewing on the inside accent yarn parts into the earflaps)

Row 1: Knit

Row 2: Purl

Row 3: K1, M1, K2, M1, K1 (6 total sts)

Row 4: Purl

Row 5: K1, M1, K4, M1, K1 (8 total sts)

Row 6: Purl

Row 7: K1, M1, K6, M1, K1 (10 total sts)

Row 8: Purl

Row 9: K1, M1, K8, M1, K1 (12 total sts)

Row 10: Purl

Row 11: K1, M1, K10, M1, K1 (14 total sts)

Row 12: Purl

Row 13: K1, M1, K12, M1, K1 (16 total sts)

Row 14: Purl

Row 15: K1, M1, K14, M1, K1 (18 total sts)

Rows 16-20: Alternate between purling and knitting, purling row 16

Place on stitch holder, cut yarn and set aside.

Cast on 18 sts with accent yarn onto straight needles

Row 1: *K1, P1* Repeat across

Row 2: *P1, K1* Repeat across

Repeat row 1 for all odd rows through row 13

Repeat row 2 for all even rows through row 14

Place on stitch holder, cut yarn and set aside.

Repeat Rows 1-20 from first earflap for the second earflap. Cast on 16 more stitches

Place earflaps and accent yarn piece onto Double Pointed Needles (or use the Magic Loop Method), or on a smaller circular needle. The accent yarn piece should be in the center of the two earflaps, and the earflap without the extra cast on stitches should be the first one purled after being joined in the round. See picture 1.

Join in the round with the purled side facing and place stitch marker.

You should have a total of 70 sts

Round 1: P18, K18, P34

Rounds 2-28: Purl

Round 29: P2tog, P15, P2tog, P16, P2tog, P15, P2tog, P16 (66 total sts)

Round 30: *P2tog, P9* Repeat around (60 total sts)

Round 31: *P2tog, P8* Repeat around (54 total sts)

Round 32: *P2tog, P7* Repeat around (48 total sts)

Round 33: *P2tog, P6* Repeat around (42 total sts)

Switch to Double Pointed Needles at this point if you are using a cable needle

Round 34: *P2tog, P5* Repeat around (36 total sts)

Round 35: *P2tog, P4* Repeat around (30 total sts)

Round 36: *P2tog, P3* Repeat around (24 total sts)

Round 37: *P2tog, P2* Repeat around (18 total sts)

Round 38: *P2tog, P1* Repeat around (12 total sts)

CO 4 sts with main yarn onto straight needles (Leave a 18-20 inch tail to use for sewing on the inside accent yarn parts into the earflaps)

Row 1: Knit

Row 2: Purl

Row 3: K1, M1, K2, M1, K1 (6 total sts)

Row 4: Purl

Row 5: K1, M1, K4, M1, K1 (8 total sts)

Row 6: Purl

Row 7: K1, M1, K6, M1, K1 (10 total sts)

Row 8: Purl

Row 9: K1, M1, K8, M1, K1 (12 total sts)

Row 10: Purl

Row 11: K1, M1, K10, M1, K1 (14 total sts)

Row 12: Purl

Row 13: K1, M1, K12, M1, K1 (16 total sts)

Row 14: Purl

Place on stitch holder, cut yarn and set aside.

Repeat Rows 1-22 from first earflap for the second earflap. Cast on 17 more stitches

Place earflaps and accent yarn piece onto Double Pointed Needles (or use the Magic Loop Method), or on a smaller circular needle. The accent yarn piece should be in the center of the two earflaps, and the earflap without the extra cast on stitches should be the first one purled after being joined in the round. See picture 1.

Join in the round with the purled side facing and place stitch marker.

You should have a total of 76 sts

Round 1: P20, K19, P37

Rounds 2-30: Purl

Round 31: *P2tog, P17* Repeat around (72 total sts)

Round 32: *P2tog, P10* Repeat around (66 total sts)

Round 33: *P2tog, P9* Repeat around (60 total sts)

Round 34: *P2tog, P8* Repeat around (54 total sts)

Round 35: *P2tog, P7* Repeat around (48 total sts)

Round 36: *P2tog, P6* Repeat around (42 total sts)

Switch to Double Pointed Needles at this point if you are using a cable needle

Round 37: *P2tog, P5* Repeat around (36 total sts)

Round 38: *P2tog, P4* Repeat around (30 total sts)

Round 39: *P2tog, P3* Repeat around (24 total sts)

Round 40: *P2tog, P2* Repeat around (18 total sts)

Round 41: *P2tog, P1* Repeat around (12 total sts)

Do not bind off. Cut approx. 7 inch tail. Using yarn needle, remove all sts from DPNs or magic loop, as if to purl. Pull tail through sts to cinch the top of hat. Using yarn needle, pull tail through to the inside of the hat. Tie a knot and weave in all ends except at the base of the earflaps.

Cast on 2 stitches with accent yarn onto straight needles

3-10 Year Hat Pattern

CO 4 sts with main yarn onto straight needles (Leave a 18-20 inch tail to use for sewing on the inside accent yarn parts into the earflaps)

Row 1: Knit

Row 2: Purl

Row 3: K1, M1, K2, M1, K1 (6 total sts)

Row 4: Purl

Row 5: K1, M1, K4, M1, K1 (8 total sts)

Row 6: Purl

Row 7: K1, M1, K6, M1, K1 (10 total sts)

Row 8: Purl

Row 9: K1, M1, K8, M1, K1 (12 total sts)

Row 10: Purl

Row 11: K1, M1, K10, M1, K1 (14 total sts)

Row 12: Purl

Row 13: K1, M1, K12, M1, K1 (16 total sts)

Repeat row 2 for all even rows through row 14

Place on stitch holder, cut yarn and set aside.

Repeat Rows 1-22 from first earflap for the second earflap. Cast on 18 more stitches

Place earflaps and accent yarn piece onto Double Pointed Needles (or use the Magic Loop Method), or on a smaller circular needle. The accent yarn piece should be in the center of the two earflaps, and the earflap without the extra cast on stitches should be the first one purled after being joined in the round. See picture 1.

Join in the round with the purled side facing and place stitch marker.

You should have a total of 78 sts

Round 1: P20, K20, P38

Rounds 2-33: Purl

Round 34: *P2tog, P11* Repeat around (72 total sts)

Round 35: *P2tog, P10* Repeat around (66 total sts)

Round 36: *P2tog, P9* Repeat around (60 total sts)

Round 37: *P2tog, P8* Repeat around (54 total sts)

Round 38: *P2tog, P7* Repeat around (48 total sts)

Round 39: *P2tog, P6* Repeat around (42 total sts)

Switch to Double Pointed Needles at this point if you are using a cable needle

Round 40: *P2tog, P5* Repeat around (36 total sts)

Round 41: *P2tog, P4* Repeat around (30 total sts)

Round 42: *P2tog, P3* Repeat around (24 total sts)

Round 43: *P2tog, P2* Repeat around (18 total sts)

Round 44: *P2tog, P1* Repeat around (12 total sts)

Do not bind off. Cut approx. 7 inch tail. Using yarn needle, remove all sts from DPNs or magic loop, as if to purl. Pull tail through sts to cinch the top of hat. Using yarn needle, pull tail through to the inside of the hat. Tie a knot and weave in all ends except at the base of the earflaps.

CO 4 sts with main yarn onto straight needles (Leave a 18-20 inch tail to use for sewing on the inside accent yarn parts into the earflaps)

Row 1: Knit

Row 2: Purl

Row 3: K1, M1, K2, M1, K1 (6 total sts)

Row 4: Purl

Row 5: K1, M1, K4, M1, K1 (8 total sts)

Row 6: Purl

Row 7: K1, M1, K6, M1, K1 (10 total sts)

Row 8: Purl

Row 9: K1, M1, K8, M1, K1 (12 total sts)

Row 10: Purl

Row 11: K1, M1, K10, M1, K1 (14 total sts)

Row 12: Purl

Row 13: K1, M1, K12, M1, K1 (16 total sts)

Row 14: Purl

Row 15: K1, M1, K14, M1, K1 (18 total sts)

Place on stitch holder, cut yarn and set aside.

Cast on 21 sts with accent yarn onto straight needles

Rows 1-14: *K1, P1* Repeat across

Place on stitch holder, cut yarn and set aside.

Repeat Rows 1-22 from first earflap for the second earflap. Cast on 19 more stitches

Place earflaps and accent yarn piece onto Double Pointed Needles (or use the Magic Loop Method), or on a smaller circular needle. The accent yarn piece should be in the center of the two earflaps, and the earflap without the extra cast on stitches should be the first one purled after being joined in the round. See picture 1.

Join in the round with the purled side facing and place stitch marker.

You should have a total of 80 sts

Round 1: P20, K21, P39

Rounds 2-35: Purl

Round 36: *P2tog, P38* Repeat around (78 total sts)

Round 37: *P2tog, P11* Repeat around (72 total sts)

Round 38: *P2tog, P10* Repeat around (66 total sts)

Round 39: *P2tog, P9* Repeat around (60 total sts)

Round 40: *P2tog, P8* Repeat around (54 total sts)

Round 41: *P2tog, P7* Repeat around (48 total sts)

Round 42: *P2tog, P6* Repeat around (42 total sts)

Switch to Double Pointed Needles at this point if you are using a cable needle

Round 43: *P2tog, P5* Repeat around (36 total sts)

Round 44: *P2tog, P4* Repeat around (30 total sts)

Round 45: *P2tog, P3* Repeat around (24 total sts)

Round 46: *P2tog, P2* Repeat around (18 total sts)

Round 47: *P2tog, P1* Repeat around (12 total sts)

Do not bind off. Cut approx. 7 inch tail. Using yarn needle, remove all sts from DPNs or magic loop, as if to purl. Pull tail through sts to cinch the top of hat. Using yarn needle, pull tail through to the inside of the hat. Tie a knot and weave in all ends except at the base of the earflaps.

Cast on 2 stitches with accent yarn onto straight needles

Row 1: Purl

Row 2: K1, M1, K1 (3 total sts)

Row 3: Purl

Row 4: K1, M1, K1, M1, K1 (5 total sts)

Row 5: Purl

Row 6: K1, M1, K3, M1, K1 (7 total sts)

Row 7: Purl

Row 8: K1, M1, K5, M1, K1 (9 total sts)

Row 9: Purl

Row 10: K1, M1, K7, M1, K1 (11 total sts)

Row 11: Purl

Row 12: K1, M1, K9, M1, K1 (13 total sts)

Row 13: Purl

Row 14: K1, M1, K11, M1, K1 (15 total sts)

Row 15: Purl

Row 16: K1, M1, K13, M1, K1 (17 total sts)

Row 17: Purl

Row 18: K1, M1, K15, M1, K1 (19 total sts)

Row 19: Purl

Bind off as if to knit. Cut and weave in all ends and use your yarn needle and the main yarn at the base of the earflaps to secure to the inside of the earflap (knit side faces the person on mine). Fold up the accent yarn piece and use your main color of yarn to stitch around the edge. Secure two buttons to the piece on either side.

Adult Woman Hat Pattern

CO 4 sts with main yarn onto straight needles (Leave a 18-20 inch tail to use for sewing on the inside accent yarn parts into the earflaps)

Row 1: Knit

Row 2: Purl

Row 3: K1, M1, K2, M1, K1 (6 total sts)

Row 4: Purl

Row 5: K1, M1, K4, M1, K1 (8 total sts)

Row 6: Purl

Row 7: K1, M1, K6, M1, K1 (10 total sts)

Row 8: Purl

Row 9: K1, M1, K8, M1, K1 (12 total sts)

Row 10: Purl

Row 11: K1, M1, K10, M1, K1 (14 total sts)

Row 12: Purl

Row 13: K1, M1, K12, M1, K1 (16 total sts)

Row 14: Purl

Row 15: K1, M1, K14, M1, K1 (18 total sts)

Row 16: Purl

Row 17: K1, M1, K16, M1, K1 (20 total sts)

Rows 18-22: Alternate between purling and knitting, purling row 18

Place on stitch holder, cut yarn and set aside.

Cast on 22 sts with accent yarn onto straight needles

Row 1: *K1, P1* Repeat across

Row 2: *P1, K1* Repeat across

Repeat row 1 for all odd rows through row 15

Repeat row 2 for all even rows through row 14

Place on stitch holder, cut yarn and set aside.

Repeat Rows 1-22 from first earflap for the second earflap. Cast on 20 more stitches

Place earflaps and accent yarn piece onto Double Pointed Needles (or use the Magic Loop Method), or on a smaller circular needle. The accent yarn piece should be in the center of the two earflaps, and the earflap without the extra cast on stitches should be the first one purlled after being joined in the round. See picture 1.

Join in the round with the purlled side facing and place stitch marker.

You should have a total of 82 sts

Round 1: P20, K22, P40

Rounds 2-38: Purl

Round 39: P2tog, P18, P2tog, P19, P2tog, P18, P2tog, P19 (78 total sts)

Round 40: *P2tog, P11* Repeat around (72 total sts)

Round 41: *P2tog, P10* Repeat around (66 total sts)

Round 42: *P2tog, P9* Repeat around (60 total sts)

Round 43: *P2tog, P8* Repeat around (54 total sts)

Round 44: *P2tog, P7* Repeat around (48 total sts)

Round 45: *P2tog, P6* Repeat around (42 total sts)

Switch to Double Pointed Needles at this point if you are using a cable needle

Round 46: *P2tog, P5* Repeat around (36 total sts)

Round 47: *P2tog, P4* Repeat around (30 total sts)

Round 48: *P2tog, P3* Repeat around (24 total sts)

Round 49: *P2tog, P2* Repeat around (18 total sts)

Round 50: *P2tog, P1* Repeat around (12 total sts)

Do not bind off. Cut approx. 7 inch tail. Using yarn needle, remove all sts from DPNs or magic loop, as if to purl. Pull tail through sts to cinch the top of hat. Using yarn needle, pull tail through to the inside of the hat. Tie a knot and weave in all ends except at the base of the earflaps.

Cast on 2 stitches with accent yarn onto straight needles

Row 1: Purl

Row 2: K1, M1, K1 (3 total sts)

Row 3: Purl

Row 4: K1, M1, K1, M1, K1 (5 total sts)

Row 5: Purl

Row 6: K1, M1, K3, M1, K1 (7 total sts)

Row 7: Purl

Row 8: K1, M1, K5, M1, K1 (9 total sts)

Row 9: Purl

Row 10: K1, M1, K7, M1, K1 (11 total sts)

Row 11: Purl

Row 12: K1, M1, K9, M1, K1 (13 total sts)

Row 13: Purl

Row 14: K1, M1, K11, M1, K1 (15 total sts)

Row 15: Purl

Row 16: K1, M1, K13, M1, K1 (17 total sts)

Row 17: Purl

Row 18: K1, M1, K15, M1, K1 (19 total sts)

Row 19: Purl

Bind off as if to knit. Cut and weave in all ends and use your yarn needle and the main yarn at the base of the earflaps to secure to the inside of the earflap (knit side faces the person on mine). Fold up the accent yarn piece and use your main color of yarn to stitch around the edge. Secure two buttons to the piece on either side.

Adult Man Hat Pattern

CO 4 sts with main yarn onto straight needles (Leave a 18-20 inch tail to use for sewing on the inside accent yarn parts into the earflaps)

Row 1: Knit

Row 2: Purl

Row 3: K1, M1, K2, M1, K1 (6 total sts)

Row 4: Purl

Row 5: K1, M1, K4, M1, K1 (8 total sts)

Row 6: Purl

Row 7: K1, M1, K6, M1, K1 (10 total sts)

Row 8: Purl

Row 9: K1, M1, K8, M1, K1 (12 total sts)

Row 10: Purl

Row 11: K1, M1, K10, M1, K1 (14 total sts)

Row 12: Purl

Row 13: K1, M1, K12, M1, K1 (16 total sts)

Row 14: Purl

Row 15: K1, M1, K14, M1, K1 (18 total sts)

Row 16: Purl

Row 17: K1, M1, K16, M1, K1 (20 total sts)

Rows 18-22: Alternate between purling and knitting, purling row 18

Place on stitch holder, cut yarn and set aside.

Cast on 24 sts with accent yarn onto straight needles

Row 1: *K1, P1* Repeat across

Row 2: *P1, K1* Repeat across

Repeat row 1 for all odd rows through row 15

Repeat row 2 for all even rows through row 14

Place on stitch holder, cut yarn and set aside.

Repeat Rows 1-22 from first earflap for the second earflap. Cast on 22 more stitches

Place earflaps and accent yarn piece onto Double Pointed Needles (or use the Magic Loop Method), or on a smaller circular needle. The accent yarn piece should be in the center of the two earflaps, and the earflap without the extra cast on stitches should be the first one purled after being joined in the round. See picture 1.

Join in the round with the purled side facing and place stitch marker.

You should have a total of 86 sts

Round 1: P20, K24, P42

Rounds 2-40: Purl

Round 41: P2tog, P19, P2tog, P20, P2tog, P19, P2tog, P20 (82 total sts)

Round 42: *P2tog, P12* Repeat around (78 total sts)

Round 43: *P2tog, P11* Repeat around (72 total sts)

Round 44: *P2tog, P10* Repeat around (66 total sts)

Round 45: *P2tog, P9* Repeat around (60 total sts)

Round 46: *P2tog, P8* Repeat around (54 total sts)

Round 47: *P2tog, P7* Repeat around (48 total sts)

Round 48: *P2tog, P6* Repeat around (42 total sts)

Switch to Double Pointed Needles at this point if you are using a cable needle

Round 49: *P2tog, P5* Repeat around (36 total sts)

Round 50: *P2tog, P4* Repeat around (30 total sts)

Round 51: *P2tog, P3* Repeat around (24 total sts)

Round 52: *P2tog, P2* Repeat around (18 total sts)

Round 53: *P2tog, P1* Repeat around (12 total sts)

Do not bind off. Cut approx. 7 inch tail. Using yarn needle, remove all sts from DPNs or magic loop, as if to purl. Pull tail through sts to cinch the top of hat. Using yarn needle, pull tail through to the inside of the hat. Tie a knot and weave in all ends except at the base of the earflaps.

Cast on 2 stitches with accent yarn onto straight needles

Row 1: Purl

Row 2: K1, M1, K1 (3 total sts)

Row 3: Purl

Row 4: K1, M1, K1, M1, K1 (5 total sts)

Row 5: Purl

Row 6: K1, M1, K3, M1, K1 (7 total sts)

Row 7: Purl

Row 8: K1, M1, K5, M1, K1 (9 total sts)

Row 9: Purl

Row 10: K1, M1, K7, M1, K1 (11 total sts)

Row 11: Purl

Row 12: K1, M1, K9, M1, K1 (13 total sts)

Row 13: Purl

Row 14: K1, M1, K11, M1, K1 (15 total sts)

Row 15: Purl

Row 16: K1, M1, K13, M1, K1 (17 total sts)

Row 17: Purl

Row 18: K1, M1, K15, M1, K1 (19 total sts)

Row 19: Purl

Bind off as if to knit. Cut and weave in all ends and use your yarn needle and the main yarn at the base of the earflaps to secure to the inside of the earflap (knit side faces the person on mine). Fold up the accent yarn piece and use your main color of yarn to stitch around the edge. Secure two buttons to the piece on either side.
