## Butterfly Stitch Hat and Shorts Set Crochet Pattern



## Materials:

- Yarn: Approximately 160 yards (30 yards of color 1 (trim) and 130 yards of color 2) of DK (3) weight yarn for smaller sizes, and approx.. 250 yards ( 60 yards of color 1 and 190 yards of color 2) for larger sizes (I used Classic Elite Yarns-Giselle for pictured set)
-***This set is designed to work up tight and stretch to the correct size-I recommend picking a stretchy yarn to help***
-***You will be working with 2 strands of color 2 yarn at the same time. I used one skein and wound a separate ball so I had two bals of yarn to work with. You can also pull from both ends***
- Crochet Hook: Size 5.5mm (I/9) - OR whatever size is needed to achieve gauge
- Yan or tapestry needle


## Abbreviations:

- CH: Chain
- SC: Single Crochet
- TW: Turn Work
- SC2tog: Single Crochet the next two sts together (single crochet decrease)


## Gauge:

8 sts and 10 rows = 2 inches
in single crochet
***It is important to check your gauge!***

## Average Head Circumference:

Newborn: 13-14"
0-3 Months: 14-15"
3-6 Months: $14-17$ "
6-12 Months: 16-19"
1-3 Years: 18-20"
3-10 Years: 19-20.5"

## Hat

## Newborn Pattern

Chain 48 with color 1 (trim) yarn
Join in the round by slip stitching the first and last chains together, slip stitch into first stitch, CH1
Rounds 1-3: SC into same stitch as CH1 (you will always start your rounds this way), SC into each stitch around, slip stitch into first stitch, CH1 (48 total sts)
Drop and cut color 1 yarn and pick up one strand of color 2 yarn
Rounds 4-6: (See Photos 1-3) *SC into next 6 sts, move yarn to front of work and drop it there, pick up a second strand of color 2 yarn and SC into the next 6 sts, drop your second strand of yarn behind your work and loosely pull your first strand of yarn across the front of your work, use this strand to work the next section* Repeat around, slip stitch into first st, CH1
Round 7: (See Photos 4-7) Using your first strand of color 2 only, *SC into next 9 sts, pick up loose strands onto your hook and SC together with next st, SC into next 2 sts* Repeat around, slip stitch into first st, CH1
Rounds 8-10: *move yarn to front of work and drop it there, pick up your second strand of color 2 yarn and SC into next 6 sts, drop your second strand of yarn behind your work and loosely pull your first strand of yarn across the front of your work, use this strand to SC into next 6 sts* Repeat around, slip stitch into first st, CH1
Round 11: Using your first strand of color 2 only, *SC into next 3 sts, pick up loose strands onto your hook and SC together with next st, SC into next 8 sts* Repeat around, slip stitch into first st, CH1
Continue to repeat rounds $4-11$ until your piece measures approx. 3.5 inches ( 8.75 cm ) from the edge. Be sure to end on a repeat of Round 11.

## Decreases:

Round 1: *SC2tog, SC into next 2 sts, SC2tog, move yarn to front of work and drop it there, pick up the second strand and SC into the next 6 sts, drop your second strand of yarn behind your work and loosely pull your first strand of yarn across the front of your work, use this strand to work the next section* Repeat around, slip stitch into first st, CH1 (40 total sts)
Round 2: *SC into next 4 sts, move yarn to front of work and drop it there, pick up the second strand and SC2tog, SC into next 2 sts, SC2tog, drop your second strand of yarn behind your work and loosely pull your first strand of yarn across the front of your work, use this strand to work the next section* Repeat around, slip stitch into first st, CH1 (32 total sts)
Round 3: *SC2tog, SC2tog, move yarn to front of work and drop it there, pick up the second strand and SC into next 4 sts, drop your second strand of yarn behind your work and loosely pull your first strand of yarn across the front of your work, use this strand to work the next section* Repeat around, slip stitch into first st, CH1 (24 total sts)
Round 4: Using your first strand of color 2 only (you can cut the second strand at this point), *SC into next 4 sts, pick up loose strands onto your hook and SC together with next st, SC into next st* Repeat around, slip stitch into first st, CH1
Round 5: *SC into next 2 sts, SC2tog, SC2tog* Repeat around, slip stitch into first st, CH1 (16 total sts)
Round 6: *SC2tog, SC into next 2 sts* Repeat around, slip stitch into first st, CH1 (12 total sts)
Round 7: *SC2tog* repeat around until top of hat is closed. (6 total sts)
Cut approx. $7^{\prime \prime}(17.75 \mathrm{~cm})$ tail. Using yarn needle, sew up any gap that may be left in the top of your hat. Using yarn needle, pull tail through to the inside of the hat. Tie a knot and weave in ends.

## 0-3 Month Pattern

Chain 52 with color 1 (trim) yarn
Join in the round by slip stitching the first and last chains together, slip stitch into first stitch, CH1
Rounds 1-3: SC into same stitch as CH1 (you will always start your rounds this way), SC into each stitch around, slip stitch into first stitch, CH1 (52 total sts)
Drop and cut color 1 yarn and pick up color 2 yarn
Rounds 4-6: (See Photos 1-3) SC into next 5 sts, move yarn to front of work and drop it there, pick up a second strand of color 2 yarn and SC into the next 5 sts, drop your second strand of yarn behind your work and loosely pull your first strand of yarn across the front of your work, use this strand to SC into the next 6 sts, move yarn to front of work and drop it there, pick up your second strand of yarn and SC into the next 5 sts, drop your second strand of yarn behind your work and loosely pull your first strand of yarn across the front of your work, use this strand to SC into next 5 sts, move yarn to front of work and drop it there, pick up your second strand of yarn and SC into the next 5 sts, drop your second strand of yarn behind your work and loosely pull your first strand of yarn across the front of your work, use this strand to SC into the next 5 sts, move yarn to front of work and drop it there, pick up your second strand of yarn and SC into next 6 sts, drop your second strand of yarn behind your work and loosely pull your first strand of yarn across the front of your work, use this strand to SC into next 5 sts, move yarn to front of work and drop it there, pick up your second strand of yarn and SC into next 5 sts, drop your second strand of yarn behind your work and loosely pull your first strand of yarn across the front of your work, use this strand to work the next section, slip stitch into first stitch, CH1

Continue to repeat rounds $4-11$ until your piece measures approx. 4 inches $(10 \mathrm{~cm})$ from the edge. Be sure to end on a repeat of Round 11.

## Decreases:

Round 1: SC2tog, SC one, SC2tog, move yarn to front of work and drop it there, pick up a second strand of color 2 yarn and SC into the next 5 sts, drop your second strand of yarn behind your work and loosely pull your first strand of yarn across the front of your work, use this strand to SC2tog, SC into next 2 sts, SC2tog, move yarn to front of work and drop it there, pick up a second strand of color 2 yarn and SC into the next 5 sts, drop your second strand of yarn behind your work and loosely pull your first strand of yarn across the front of your work, use this strand to SC2tog, SC one, SC2tog, move yarn to front of work and drop it there, pick up a second strand of color 2 yarn and SC into the next 5 sts, drop your second strand of yarn behind your work and loosely pull your first strand of yarn across the front of your work, use this strand to SC2tog, SC one, SC2tog, move yarn to front of work and drop it there, pick up a second strand of color 2 yarn and SC into the next 6 sts, drop your second strand of yarn behind your work and loosely pull your first strand of yarn across the front of your work, use this strand to SC2tog, SC one, SC2tog, move yarn to front of work and drop it there, pick up a second strand of color 2 yarn and SC into the next 5 sts, drop your second strand of yarn behind your work and loosely pull your first strand of yarn across the front of your work, use this strand to work next section, slip stitch into first stitch, CH1 (42 total sts)

Round 3: SC2tog, SC one, move yarn to front of work and drop it there, pick up your second strand of color 2 yarn and SC 3 sts, drop your second strand of yarn behind your work and loosely pull your first strand of yarn across the front of your work, use this strand to SC2tog, SC2tog, move yarn to front of work and drop it there, pick up your second strand of color 2 yarn and SC 3 sts, drop your second strand of yarn behind your work and loosely pull your first strand of yarn across the front of your work, use this strand to SC2tog, SC one, move yarn to front of work and drop it there, pick up your second strand of color 2 yarn and SC 3 sts, drop your second strand of yarn behind your work and loosely pull your first strand of yarn across the front of your work, use this strand to SC2tog, SC1, move yarn to front of work and drop it there, pick up your second strand of color 2 yarn and SC 4 sts, drop your second strand of yarn behind your work and loosely pull your first strand of yarn across the front of your work, use this strand to SC2tog, SC one, move yarn to front of work and drop it there, pick up your second strand of color 2 yarn and SC 3 sts, drop your second strand of yarn behind your work and loosely pull your first strand of yarn across the front of your work, use this strand to work the next section, slip stitch into first st, CH1 (26 total sts)
Round 4: Using your first strand of color 2 only (you can cut the second strand at this point), SC into next 3 sts, pick up loose strands onto your hook and SC together with next st, SC into next 4 sts, pick up loose strands onto your hook and SC together with next st, SC into next 4 sts, pick up
loose strands onto your hook and SC together with next st, SC into next 5 sts, pick up loose strands onto your hook and SC together with next st, SC into next 4 sts, pick up loose strands onto your hook and SC together with next st, SC one, slip stitch into first st, CH1
Round 5: SC into next 2 sts, SC2tog, SC into next 3 sts, SC2tog, SC into next 3 sts, SC2tog, SC into next 3 sts, SC2tog, SC2tog, SC into next 2 sts, SC2tog, SC into next stitch, slip stitch into first st, CH1 (20 total sts)
Round 6: *SC2tog, SC into next 2 sts* Repeat around (15 total sts)
Round 7: *SC2tog* Repeat around until the top of hat is closed
Cut approx. 7 " $(17.75 \mathrm{~cm})$ tail. Using yarn needle, sew up any gap that may be left in the top of your hat. Using yarn needle, pull tail through to the inside of the hat. Tie a knot and weave in ends.

## 3-6 Month Pattern

Chain 60 with color 1 (trim) yarn
Join in the round by slip stitching the first and last chains together, slip stitch into first stitch, CH1
Rounds 1-3: SC into same stitch as CH1 (you will always start your rounds this way), SC into each stitch around, slip stitch into first stitch, CH1 (60 total sts)
Drop and cut color 1 yarn and pick up color 2 yarn
Rounds 4-6: (See Photos 1-3) *SC into next 6 sts, move yarn to front of work and drop it there, pick up a second strand of color 2 yarn and SC into the next 6 sts, drop your second strand of yarn behind your work and loosely pull your first strand of yarn across the front of your work, use this strand to work the next section* Repeat around, slip stitch into first st, CH1
Round 7: (See Photos 4-7) Using your first strand of color 2 only, *SC into next 9 sts, pick up loose strands onto your hook and SC together with next st, SC into next 2 sts* Repeat around, slip stitch into first st, CH1
Rounds 8-10: *move yarn to front of work and drop it there, pick up your second strand of color 2 yarn and SC into next 6 sts, drop your second strand of yarn behind your work and loosely pull your first strand of yarn across the front of your work, use this strand to SC into next 6 sts* Repeat around, slip stitch into first st, CH1
Round 11: Using your first strand of color 2 only, *SC into next 3 sts, pick up loose strands onto your hook and SC together with next st, SC into next 8 sts* Repeat around, slip stitch into first st, CH1
Continue to repeat rounds $4-11$ until your piece measures approx. 5 inches $(12.75 \mathrm{~cm})$ from the edge. Be sure to end on a repeat of Round 11.

## Decreases:

Round 1: *SC2tog, SC into next 2 sts, SC2tog, move yarn to front of work and drop it there, pick up the second strand and SC into the next 6 sts, drop your second strand of yarn behind your work and loosely pull your first strand of yarn across the front of your work, use this strand to work the next section* Repeat around, slip stitch into first st, CH1 (50 total sts)
Round 2: *SC into next 4 sts, move yarn to front of work and drop it there, pick up the second strand and SC2tog, SC into next 2 sts, SC2tog, drop your second strand of yarn behind your work and loosely pull your first strand of yarn across the front of your work, use this strand to work the next section* Repeat around, slip stitch into first st, CH1 (40 total sts)
Round 3: *SC2tog, SC2tog, move yarn to front of work and drop it there, pick up the second strand and SC into next 4 sts, drop your second strand of yarn behind your work and loosely pull your first strand of yarn across the front of your work, use this strand to work the next section* Repeat around, slip stitch into first st, CH1 (30 total sts)
Round 4: Using your first strand of color 2 only (you can cut the second strand at this point), *SC into next 4 sts, pick up loose strands onto your hook and SC together with next st, SC into next st* Repeat around, slip stitch into first st, CH1
Round 5: *SC2tog, SC into next 2 sts* Repeat around, slip stitch into first st, CH1 (15 total sts)
Round 6: *SC2tog* repeat around until the top of your hat is closed.
Cut approx. $7^{\prime \prime}(17.75 \mathrm{~cm})$ tail. Using yarn needle, sew up any gap that may be left in the top of your hat. Using yarn needle, pull tail through to the inside of the hat. Tie a knot and weave in ends.

## 6-12 Month Pattern

Chain 64 with color 1 (trim) yarn
Join in the round by slip stitching the first and last chains together, slip stitch into first stitch, CH1
Rounds 1-3: SC into same stitch as CH1 (you will always start your rounds this way), SC into each stitch around, slip stitch into first stitch, CH1 (64 total sts)
Drop and cut color 1 yarn and pick up color 2 yarn

## Decreases:

Round 1: SC2tog, SC into next 3 sts, SC2tog, move yarn to front of work and drop it there, pick up a second strand and SC into the next 6 sts, drop your second strand of yarn behind your work and

Rounds 5-7: SC into the next 7 sts, move yarn to front of work and drop it there, pick up a second strand and SC into the next 6 sts, drop your second strand of yarn behind your work and loosely pull your first strand of yarn across the front of your work, use this strand to SC into next 6 sts, move yarn to front of work and drop it there, pick up a second strand and SC into the next 7 sts, drop your second strand of yarn behind your work and loosely pull your first strand of yarn across the front of your work, use this strand to SC into next 6 sts, slip stitch into the first st, CH1
Round 8: SC into the next 10 sts, pick up loose strands onto your hook and SC together with next st, SC into the next 11 sts, pick up loose strands onto your hook and SC together with next st, SC into the next 9 sts

Drop and cut color 2 yarn and pick up color 1 yarn
Rounds 9-11: SC into each stitch around, slip stitch into first stitch, CH1 (do not ch1 on round 11) Fasten Off and weave in ends.
Cut yarn and weave in all ends. Using your yarn tail from earlier on and your yarn needle, seam up the crotch section as needed.

## 1-3 Year Pattern - Should measure approx. 18 " $(45.75 \mathrm{~cm})$ in circumference and approx. 9.75" $(24.75 \mathrm{~cm})$ in length un-stretched

Chain 72 with color 1 (trim) yarn
Join in the round by slip stitching the first and last chains together, slip stitch into first stitch, CH1
Rounds 1-3: SC into same stitch as CH1 (you will always start your rounds this way), SC into each stitch around, slip stitch into first stitch, CH1 (72 total sts)
Drop and cut color 1 yarn and pick up color 2 yarn
Rounds 4-6: (See Photos 1-3) *SC into next 6 sts, move yarn to front of work and drop it there, pick up a second strand of color 2 yarn and SC into the next 6 sts, drop your second strand of yarn behind your work and loosely pull your first strand of yarn across the front of your work, use this strand to work the next section* Repeat around, slip stitch into first st, CH1
Round 7: (See Photos 4-7) Using your first strand of color 2 only, *SC into next 9 sts, pick up loose strands onto your hook and SC together with next st, SC into next 2 sts* Repeat around, slip stitch into first st, CH1
Rounds 8-10: *move yarn to front of work and drop it there, pick up your second strand of color 2 yarn and SC into next 6 sts, drop your second strand of yarn behind your work and loosely pull your first strand of yarn across the front of your work, use this strand to SC into next 6 sts* Repeat around, slip stitch into first st, CH1
Round 11: Using your first strand of color 2 only, *SC into next 3 sts, pick up loose strands onto your hook and SC together with next st, SC into next 8 sts* Repeat around, slip stitch into first st, CH1
Continue to repeat rounds $4-11$ until your piece measures approx. 7.5 inches $(19 \mathrm{~cm})$ from the edge. Be sure to end on a repeat of Round 11.

## Legs:

Rounds 1-3: *SC into next 6 sts, move yarn to front of work and drop it there, pick up a second strand of color 2 yarn and SC into the next 6 sts, drop your second strand of yarn behind your work and loosely pull your first strand of yarn across the front of your work, use this strand to work the next section* Repeat 2 times, slip stitch into first st, CH1 (36 sts worked)
Ignore the other 36 sts for the time being
Round 4: Using your first strand of color 2 only, *SC into next 9 sts, pick up loose strands onto your hook and SC together with next st, SC into next 2 sts* Repeat around, slip stitch into first st, CH1
Rounds 5-7: *move yarn to front of work and drop it there, pick up a second strand of color 2 yarn and SC into the next 6 sts, drop your second strand of yarn behind your work and loosely pull your first strand of yarn across the front of your work, use this strand to SC into the next 6 sts* Repeat two more times, slip stitch into the first st, CH1
Round 8: SC into next 3 sts pick up loose strands onto your hook and SC together with next st, SC into next 11 sts, pick up loose strands onto your hook and SC together with next st, SC into next 11 sts, pick up loose strands onto your hook and SC together with next st, SC into next 8 sts, slip stitch into the first st, CH1
Drop and cut color 2 yarn and pick up color 1 yarn
Rounds 9-11: SC into each stitch around, slip stitch into first stitch, CH1 (do not ch1 on round 11) Fasten Off and weave in ends.
Pick up a new strand of color 2 yarn (leave an approx. 7 " ( 17.75 cm ) yarn tail to use to seam crotch later) and return to the 32 sts you left un-worked.
Join in the round and place stitch marker.
Rounds 1-3: *SC into next 6 sts, move yarn to front of work and drop it there, pick up a second strand of color 2 yarn and SC into the next 6 sts, drop your second strand of yarn behind your work and loosely pull your first strand of yarn across the front of your work, use this strand to work the next section* Repeat 2 times, slip stitch into first st, CH1 (36 sts worked)

Round 4: Using your first strand of color 2 only, *SC into next 9 sts, pick up loose strands onto your hook and SC together with next st, SC into next 2 sts* Repeat around, slip stitch into first st, CH1
Rounds 5-7: *move yarn to front of work and drop it there, pick up a second strand of color 2 yarn and SC into the next 6 sts, drop your second strand of yarn behind your work and loosely pull your first strand of yarn across the front of your work, use this strand to SC into the next 6 sts* Repeat two more times, slip stitch into the first st, CH1
Round 8: SC into next 3 sts pick up loose strands onto your hook and SC together with next st, SC into next 11 sts, pick up loose strands onto your hook and SC together with next st, SC into next 11 sts, pick up loose strands onto your hook and SC together with next st, SC into next 8 sts, slip stitch into the first st, CH1
Drop and cut color 2 yarn and pick up color 1 yarn
Rounds 9-11: SC into each stitch around, slip stitch into first stitch, CH1 (do not ch1 on round 11) Fasten Off and weave in ends.
Cut yarn and weave in all ends. Using your yarn tail from earlier on and your yarn needle, seam up the crotch section as needed.
