

Handsome Hoppy Frog Hat Knitting Pattern



Materials:

- Yarn: Approximately 50 yards of green worsted or aran (4) weight yarn for smaller sizes, and approx. 90 yards for larger sizes, approx. 15 yards of white worsted or aran (4) weight yarn, and approx. 15 yards of black worsted or aran (4) weight yarn (I used Vanna's Choice for the green)
- Knitting Needles: Size 5.5 mm (US 9) Double Pointed Needles, (or use the magic loop method) and straight needles
- Yarn or Tapestry Needle

Abbreviations:

- K2tog: Knit two stitches together
- P2tog: Purl two stitches together
- **: Repeat the section in between the two stars as specified

Gauge:

9 sts and 12 rows = 2 inches (5 centimeters)
in stockinette stitch
It is important to check your gauge!

Average Head Circumference:

Newborn: 13-14"
0-3 Months: 14-15"
3-6 Months: 14-17"
6-12 Months: 16-19"
1-3 Years: 18-20"
3-10 Years: 19-20.5"
Pre-teen/Teen: 20.5-22"
Adult Female: 21.5-22.5"
Adult Male: 23-24"

Newborn Hat Pattern

Cast on 50 sts onto Double Pointed Needles (or use the magic loop method)

Join in the round and place stitch marker

Round 1: K2, *P2, K2* Repeat around

Round 2: P2, *K2, P2* Repeat around

Rounds 3-27: For all odd rounds, repeat round 1. For all even rounds, repeat round 2.

Round 28: *K2tog, K2tog, P2, K2, P2, K2* Repeat 3 more times, P2 (42 total sts)

Round 29: *P2, K2* Repeat, P2, *P2, K2* Repeat, P2, *P2, K2* Repeat, P2, *P2, K2* Repeat, P2, K2

Round 30: *K2, P2* Repeat, K2, *K2, P2* Repeat, K2, *K2, P2* Repeat, K2, *K2, P2* Repeat, K2, P2

Round 31: *K2tog, K2tog, P2, K2, P2* Repeat 3 more times, K2 (34 total sts)

Round 32: P2, *K2, P2* Repeat around

Round 33: K2, *P2, K2* Repeat around

Round 34: *K2tog, K2tog, P2, K2* Repeat 3 times, P2 (26 total sts)

Round 35: *P2, K2, P2* Repeat 3 more times, K2

Round 36: *K2, P2, K2* Repeat 3 more times, P2

Round 37: *K2tog, K2tog, P2* Repeat 3 more times, K2 (18 total sts)

Round 38: *P2, K2* Repeat 3 more times, P2

Do not bind off. Cut approx. 7 inch tail. Using yarn needle, remove all sts from DPNs or magic loop, as if to purl. Pull tail through sts to cinch the top of hat. Using yarn needle, pull tail through to the inside of the hat. Tie a knot and weave in ends.

0-3 Month Hat Pattern

Cast on 52 sts onto Double Pointed Needles (or use the magic loop method)

Join in the round and place stitch marker

Round 1: *K2, P2* Repeat around

Round 2: *P2, K2* Repeat around

Rounds 3-27: For all odd rounds, repeat round 1. For all even rounds, repeat round 2.

Round 28: K2tog, K2tog *P2, K2* Repeat around (50 total sts)

Round 29: P2, *K2, P2* Repeat around

Round 30: *K2tog, K2tog, P2, K2, P2, K2* Repeat 3 more times, P2 (42 total sts)

Round 31: *P2, K2* Repeat, P2, *P2, K2* Repeat, P2, *P2, K2* Repeat, P2, *P2, K2* Repeat, P2, K2

Round 32: *K2, P2* Repeat, K2, *K2, P2* Repeat, K2, *K2, P2* Repeat, K2, *K2, P2* Repeat, K2, P2

Round 33: *K2tog, K2tog, P2, K2, P2* Repeat 3 more times, K2 (34 total sts)

Round 34: P2, *K2, P2* Repeat around

Round 35: K2, *P2, K2* Repeat around

Round 36: *K2tog, K2tog, P2, K2* Repeat 3 times, P2 (26 total sts)

Round 37: *P2, K2, P2* Repeat 3 more times, K2

Round 38: *K2, P2, K2* Repeat 3 more times, P2

Round 39: *K2tog, K2tog, P2* Repeat 3 more times, K2 (18 total sts)

Round 40: *P2, K2* Repeat 3 more times, P2

Do not bind off. Cut approx. 7 inch tail. Using yarn needle, remove all sts from DPNs or magic loop, as if to purl. Pull tail through sts to cinch the top of hat. Using yarn needle, pull tail through to the inside of the hat. Tie a knot and weave in ends.

3-6 Month Hat Pattern

Cast on 56 sts onto Double Pointed Needles (or use the magic loop method)

Join in the round and place stitch marker

Round 1: *K2, P2* Repeat around

Round 2: *P2, K2* Repeat around

Rounds 3-29: For all odd rounds, repeat round 1. For all even rounds, repeat round 2.

Round 30: *K2tog, K2tog, P2, K2, P2, K2, P2, K2, P2* Repeat two more times, K2 (50 total sts)

Round 31: P2, *K2, P2* Repeat around

Round 32: K2, *P2, K2* Repeat around

Round 33: *K2tog, K2tog, P2, K2, P2, K2* Repeat 3 more times, P2 (42 total sts)

Round 34: *P2, K2* Repeat, P2, *P2, K2* Repeat, P2, *P2, K2* Repeat, P2, *P2, K2* Repeat, P2, K2

Round 35: *K2, P2* Repeat, K2, *K2, P2* Repeat, K2, *K2, P2* Repeat, K2, *K2, P2* Repeat, K2, P2

Round 36: *K2tog, K2tog, P2, K2, P2* Repeat 3 more times, K2 (34 total sts)

Round 37: P2, *K2, P2* Repeat around

Round 38: K2, *P2, K2* Repeat around

Round 39: *K2tog, K2tog, P2, K2* Repeat 3 times, P2 (26 total sts)

Round 40: *P2, K2, P2* Repeat 3 more times, K2

Round 41: *K2, P2, K2* Repeat 3 more times, P2

Round 42: *K2tog, K2tog, P2* Repeat 3 more times, K2 (18 total sts)

Round 43: *P2, K2* Repeat 3 more times, P2

Do not bind off. Cut approx. 7 inch tail. Using yarn needle, remove all sts from DPNs or magic loop, as if to purl. Pull tail through sts to cinch the top of hat. Using yarn needle, pull tail through to the inside of the hat. Tie a knot and weave in ends.

6-12 Month Hat Pattern

Cast on 66 sts onto Double Pointed Needles (or use the magic loop method)

Join in the round and place stitch marker

Round 1: K2, *P2, K2* Repeat around

Round 2: P2, *K2, P2* Repeat around

Rounds 3-31: For all odd rounds, repeat round 1. For all even rounds, repeat round 2.

Round 32: *K2tog, K2tog, P2, K2, P2, K2, P2, K2* Repeat 3 more times, P2 (58 total sts)

Round 33: *P2, K2* Repeat 2 more times, P2, *P2, K2* Repeat 2 more times, P2, *P2, K2* Repeat 2 more times, P2, *P2, K2* Repeat 2 more times, P2, K2

Round 34: *K2, P2* Repeat 2 more times, K2, *K2, P2* Repeat 2 more times, K2, *K2, P2* Repeat 2 more times, K2, *K2, P2* Repeat 2 more times, K2, P2

Round 35: *K2tog, K2tog, P2, K2, P2, K2, P2* Repeat 3 more times, K2 (50 total sts)

Round 36: P2, *K2, P2* Repeat around

Round 37: K2, *P2, K2* Repeat around

Round 38: *K2tog, K2tog, P2, K2, P2, K2* Repeat 3 more times, P2 (42 total sts)

Round 39: *P2, K2* Repeat, P2, *P2, K2* Repeat, P2, *P2, K2* Repeat, P2, *P2, K2* Repeat, P2, K2

Round 40: *K2, P2* Repeat, K2, *K2, P2* Repeat, K2, *K2, P2* Repeat, K2, *K2, P2* Repeat, K2, P2

Round 45: *P2, K2, P2* Repeat 3 more times, K2

Round 48: *P2, K2* Repeat 3 more times, P2

Round 49: *K2, P2* Repeat 3 more times, K2

Do not bind off. Cut approx. 7 inch tail. Using yarn needle, remove all sts from DPNs or magic loop, as if to purl. Pull tail through sts to cinch the top of hat. Using yarn needle, pull tail through to the inside of the hat. Tie a knot and weave in ends.

1-3 Year Hat Pattern

Cast on 74 sts onto Double Pointed Needles (or use the magic loop method)

Join in the round and place stitch marker

Round 1: K2, *P2, K2* Repeat around

Round 2: P2, *K2, P2* Repeat around

Rounds 3-31: For all odd rounds, repeat round 1. For all even rounds, repeat round 2.

Round 32: *K2tog, K2tog, P2, K2, P2, K2, P2, K2, P2* Repeat 3 more times, K2 (66 total sts)

Round 33: P2, *K2, P2* Repeat around

Round 34: K2, *P2, K2* Repeat around

Round 35: *K2tog, K2tog, P2, K2, P2, K2, P2, K2* Repeat 3 more times, P2 (58 total sts)

Round 36: *P2, K2* Repeat 2 more times, P2, *P2, K2* Repeat 2 more times, P2, *P2, K2* Repeat 2 more times, P2, K2

3-10 Year Hat Pattern

Cast on 76 sts onto Double Pointed Needles (or use the magic loop method)

Join in the round and place stitch marker

Round 1: *K2, P2* Repeat around

Rounds 3-33: For all odd rounds, repeat round 1. For all even rounds, repeat round 2.

Round 34: K2tog, K2tog, *P2, K2* Repeat around (74 total sts)

Round 35: *P2, K2* Repeat around

Round 36: *K2tog, K2tog, P2, K2, P2, K2, P2, K2* Repeat 3 more times, K2 (66 total sts)

Round 37: P2, *K2, P2* Repeat around

Cast on 80 sts onto Double Pointed Needles (or use the magic loop method)

Join in the round and place stitch marker

Round 1: *K2, P2* Repeat around

Rounds 3-33: For all odd rounds, repeat round 1. For all even rounds, repeat round 2.

Round 34: *K2tog, K2tog, P2, K2, P2, K2, P2, K2, P2, K2, P2* Repeat 2 more times, K2 (74 total sts)

Round 35: *P2, K2* Repeat around

Round 36: *K2, P2* Repeat around

Round 37: *P2, K2* Repeat around

Round 38: *K2tog, K2tog, P2, K2, P2, K2, P2, K2, P2* Repeat 3 more times, K2 (66 total sts)

Do not bind off. Cut approx. 7 inch tail. Using yarn needle, remove all sts from DPNs or magic loop, as if to purl. Pull tail through sts to cinch the top of hat. Using yarn needle, pull tail through to the inside of the hat. Tie a knot and weave in ends.

Adult Woman Hat Pattern

Cast on 84 sts onto Double Pointed Needles (or use the magic loop method)

Join in the round and place stitch marker

Round 1: *K2, P2* Repeat around

Round 2: *P2, K2* Repeat around

Rounds 3-37: For all odd rounds, repeat round 1. For all even rounds, repeat round 2.

Round 38: K2tog, K2tog, *P2, K2* Repeat around (82 total sts)

Round 39: P2, *K2, P2* Repeat around

Round 40: *K2tog, K2tog, P2, K2, P2, K2, P2, K2, P2, K2* Repeat 3 more times, P2 (74 total sts)

Round 41: P2, *K2, P2* Repeat around

Round 42: K2, *P2, K2* Repeat around

Round 43: *K2tog, K2tog, P2, K2, P2, K2, P2, K2, P2* Repeat 3 more times, K2 (66 total sts)

Round 44: P2, *K2, P2* Repeat around

Round 62: *P2, K2* Repeat 3 more times, P2

Round 63: *K2, P2* Repeat 3 more times, K2

Do not bind off. Cut approx. 7 inch tail. Using yarn needle, remove all sts from DPNs or magic loop, as if to purl. Pull tail through sts to cinch the top of hat. Using yarn needle, pull tail through to the inside of the hat. Tie a knot and weave in ends.

Adult Man Hat Pattern

Cast on 86 sts onto Double Pointed Needles (or use the magic loop method)

Join in the round and place stitch marker

Round 1: K2, *P2, K2* Repeat around

Round 2: P2, *K2, P2* Repeat around

Rounds 3-42: For all odd rounds, repeat round 1. For all even rounds, repeat round 2.

Round 43: K2tog, K2tog, *P2, K2* Repeat 9 times, P2, K2tog, K2tog, *P2, K2* Repeat 10 times (82 total sts)

Round 44: P2, *K2, P2* Repeat around

Round 45: K2, *P2, K2* Repeat around

Round 46: *K2tog, K2tog, P2, K2, P2, K2, P2, K2, P2, K2* Repeat 3 more times, P2 (74 total sts)

Round 47: P2, *K2, P2* Repeat around

Round 48: K2, *P2, K2* Repeat around

Round 49: *K2tog, K2tog, P2, K2, P2, K2, P2, K2, P2* Repeat 3 more times, K2 (66 total sts)

Round 50: P2, *K2, P2* Repeat around

Round 51: K2, *P2, K2* Repeat around

Round 52: *K2tog, K2tog, P2, K2, P2, K2, P2, K2* Repeat 3 more times, P2 (58 total sts)

Round 60: *K2, P2* Repeat, K2, *K2, P2* Repeat, K2, *K2, P2* Repeat, K2, *K2, P2* Repeat, K2, P2

Round 61: *K2tog, K2tog, P2, K2, P2* Repeat 3 more times, K2 (34 total sts)

Round 62: P2, *K2, P2* Repeat around

Round 63: K2, *P2, K2* Repeat around

Round 64: *K2tog, K2tog, P2, K2* Repeat 3 times, P2 (26 total sts)

Round 65: *P2, K2, P2* Repeat 3 more times, K2

Round 66: *K2, P2, K2* Repeat 3 more times, P2

Round 67: *K2tog, K2tog, P2* Repeat 3 more times, K2 (18 total sts)

Round 68: *P2, K2* Repeat 3 more times, P2

Round 69: *K2, P2* Repeat 3 more times, K2

Do not bind off. Cut approx. 7 inch tail. Using yarn needle, remove all sts from DPNs or magic loop, as if to purl. Pull tail through sts to cinch the top of hat. Using yarn needle, pull tail through to the inside of the hat. Tie a knot and weave in ends.

Eyes

Newborn, 0-3 Month, and 3-6 Month Eye Pattern

Cast on 16 sts onto straight needles with green yarn

Row 1: *K2, P2* Repeat across

Row 2: *P2, K2* Repeat across

Row 3: *K2, P2* Repeat across

Cut green and pick up white yarn

Row 4: Knit

Row 5: Purl

Row 6: Knit

Row 7: Purl

Cut white and pick up black yarn

Row 8: Knit

Row 9: Purl

Row 10: Knit

Do not bind off. Cut yarn with approx 9-10 inch tail. Using yarn or tapestry needle, take stitches off of knitting needle as if to purl. Pull tail through all stitches, to cinch the middle. Using the yarn tail, use your yarn needle to attach the eyes to the very top of the hat. The eyes can be slightly folded over as pictured above, or can be more “bug eyed” as pictured below. If you would like the eyes to stand up straighter instead of folding over, you will need to slightly bunch them at the base as you sew them on.

Use your yarn needle and a piece of black yarn to sew on a mouth. Enjoy!

6-12 Month, 1-3 Year and 3-10 Year Eye Pattern

Cast on 20 sts onto straight needles with green yarn

Row 1: *K2, P2* Repeat across

Row 2: *P2, K2* Repeat across

Row 3: *K2, P2* Repeat across

Cut green and pick up white yarn

Row 4: Knit

Row 5: Purl

Row 6: Knit

Row 7: Purl

Cut white and pick up black yarn

Row 8: Knit

Row 9: Purl

Row 10: Knit

Do not bind off. Cut yarn with approx 9-10 inch tail. Using yarn or tapestry needle, take stitches off of knitting needle as if to purl. Pull tail through all stitches, to cinch the middle. Using the yarn tail, use your yarn needle to attach the eyes to the very top of the hat. The eyes can be slightly folded over as pictured above, or can be more “bug eyed” as pictured below. If you would like the eyes to stand up straighter instead of folding over, you will need to slightly bunch them at the base as you sew them on.

Use your yarn needle and a piece of black yarn to sew on a mouth. Enjoy!

Pre-teen/Teen and Adult Eye Pattern

Cast on 24 sts onto straight needles with green yarn

Row 1: *K2, P2* Repeat across

Row 2: *P2, K2* Repeat across

Row 3: *K2, P2* Repeat across

Cut green and pick up white yarn

Row 4: Knit

Row 5: Purl

Row 6: Knit

Row 7: Purl

Cut white and pick up black yarn

Row 8: Knit

Row 9: Purl

Row 10: Knit

Do not bind off. Cut yarn with approx 9-10 inch tail. Using yarn or tapestry needle, take stitches off of knitting needle as if to purl. Pull tail through all stitches, to cinch the middle.
