## Melodys Makings

Lacy Cloche Crochet Pattern


## Materials:

- Yarn: Approximately 60 yards of worsted (4) yarn for smaller sizes, and approx. 80 yards for larger sizes (I used Red Heart Boutique - Eclipse yarn)
- Crochet Hook: Size 6.5 mm (US K) OR size needed to obtain gauge
- Yarn or Tapestry Needle
- Piece of lace approx. 1 yard long


## Abbreviations:

- CH: Chain
- SC: Single Crochet
- DC: Double Crochet
- HDC: Half Double Crochet
- ST: Stitch
- Shell Stitch: (DC, CH1, DC, CH1, DC) all into the same stitch
-**: Repeat the section in between the two stars as specified


## Gauge:

7 sts and 4 rows $=2.5$ inches $(6.35 \mathrm{~cm})$
in Double Crochet
***It is important to check your gauge!***

## Average Head Circumference:

Preemie: 11.5-13"
Newborn: 13-14"
0-3 Months: 14-15"
3-6 Months: $14-17$ "
6-12 Months: 16-19"
1-3 Years: 18-20"
3-10 Years: 19-20.5"

## Newborn Pattern

Each round is considered over at the end of the instructions for that round. Sometimes you will have unused stitches at the end of the round which is why it is important to keep your stitch marker in place. The next round will start at the stitch marker - not at the unused stitches.

Ch 4 and slip stitch with first Ch to join in the round.
Round 1: SC 9 times into the center of the ring. Place stitch marker (laying a piece of yarn over last stitch in last row may be easiest for this pattern).
Round 2: *SC twice into the next st, SC* Repeat 3 more times, SC twice into the next st (14 total stitches)
Round 3: *SC twice into the next st, SC* Repeat 5 more times, SC twice into the next 2 stitches ( 22 total stitches)
Round 4: Ch1, Skip 1 st, DC, skip one st *shell stitch (DC, CH1, DC, CH1, DC) into the next st, skip 1 st, DC into the next stitch, skip $1 \mathrm{st}^{*}$ Repeat around ***Please note that once you hit the end of the final repeat, you do not do the last skip 1 st.*** ( 32 total stitches)
Round 5: Ch1, Skip 1 st, Shell st into the next st, Ch1, *skip 2 sts, DC, Ch1, skip 2 sts, Shell st into the next st, Ch1* Repeat around ( 47 total stitches)
Round 6: Skip 3 sts, DC, Ch1, *Skip 3 sts, Shell st into the next st, Ch1, Skip 3 sts, DC, Ch1,* Repeat around (42 total stitches)
Round 7: Shell st into the next st, Ch1, *Skip 3 sts, DC, Ch1, Skip 3 sts, Shell st into the next st, Ch1 * Repeat around (46 total stitches)
Round 8: Repeat round 6
Round 9: Repeat round 7
Round 10: Repeat round 6
Round 11: Make a HDC shell st into the next st, Ch1, skip 3 sts, SC, slip st into the next st. Edging:
Pick up at the next single DC from row 10 *Shell stitch with DC, CH1, SC in center DC of next shell st, CH2* Repeat around for edging, and slip stitch into first DC at the end of the round.
Weave a piece of lace through the holes (behind the shell stitches) all the way around the hat, and tie a small bow in the center front.

## 0-3 Month Pattern

Each round is considered over at the end of the instructions for that round. Sometimes you will have unused stitches at the end of the round which is why it is important to keep your stitch marker in place. The next round will start at the stitch marker - not at the unused stitches.

Ch 4 and slip stitch with first Ch to join in the round.
Round 1: SC 9 times into the center of the ring. Place stitch marker (laying a piece of yarn over last stitch in last row may be easiest for this pattern).
Round 2: *SC twice into the next st, SC* Repeat 3 more times, SC twice into the next st ( 14 total stitches)
Round 3: *SC twice into the next st, SC* Repeat 5 more times, SC twice into the next 2 stitches (22 total stitches)
Round 4: Ch1, Skip 1 st, DC, skip one st *shell stitch (DC, CH1, DC, CH1, DC) into the next st, skip 1 st, DC into the next stitch, skip $1 \mathrm{st}^{*}$ Repeat around ${ }^{* * *}$ Please note that once you hit the end of the final repeat, you do not do the last skip 1 st.*** ( 32 total stitches)
Round 5: Ch1, Skip 1 st, Shell st into the next st, Ch1, *skip 2 sts, DC, Ch1, skip 2 sts, Shell st into the next st, Ch1* Repeat around ( 47 total stitches)
Round 6: Skip 3 sts, DC, Ch2, *Skip 3 sts, Shell st into the next st, Ch1, Skip 3 sts, DC, Ch2,* Repeat around (48 total stitches)
Round 7: Shell st into the next st, Ch1, *Skip 4 sts, DC, Ch2, Skip 3 sts, Shell st into the next st, Ch1 * Repeat around (51 total stitches)
Round 8: Skip 2 sts, DC, Ch2, *Skip 3 sts, Shell st into the next st, Ch1, Skip 4 sts, DC, Ch2,* Repeat around (48 total stitches)
Round 9: Repeat round 7
Round 10: Repeat round 8
Round 11: Repeat round 7
Round 12: Skip 2 sts, HDC into the next st, Ch2, skip 3 sts, make a SC shell stitch into the next st, Ch1, skip 4 sts, slip st into the next st.

## Edging:

Pick up at the next single DC from row 11 *Shell stitch with DC, Ch1, SC in center DC of next shell st, Ch2* Repeat around for edging, and slip stitch into the first DC of the first shell st at the end of the round. Cut yarn and secure and weave in ends.
Weave a piece of lace through the holes (behind the shell stitches) all the way around the hat, and tie a small bow in the center front.

## 3-6 Month Pattern

Each round is considered over at the end of the instructions for that round. Sometimes you will have unused stitches at the end of the round which is why it is important to keep your stitch marker in place. The next round will start at the stitch marker - not at the unused stitches.

Ch 4 and slip stitch with first Ch to join in the round.
Round 1: SC 9 times into the center of the ring. Place stitch marker (laying a piece of yarn over last stitch in last row may be easiest for this pattern).
Round 2: *SC twice into the next st, SC* Repeat 3 more times, SC twice into the next st ( 14 total stitches)
Round 3: *SC twice into the next st, SC* Repeat 5 more times, SC twice into the next 2 stitches (22 total stitches)
Round 4: *SC twice into the next st, SC* Repeat 9 more times, SC, SC ( 32 total stitches)
Round 5: Ch1, Skip 1 st, Shell st (DC, CH1, DC, CH1, DC) into the next st, Ch1, *skip 2 sts, DC, Ch1, skip 2 sts, Shell st into the next st, Ch1* Repeat around ( 47 total stitches)
Round 6: Skip 3 sts, DC, Ch2, *Skip 3 sts, Shell st into the next st, Ch2, Skip 3 sts, DC, Ch2,* Repeat around (53 total stitches)
Round 7: Shell st into the next st, Ch2, *Skip 4 sts, DC, Ch2, Skip 4 sts, Shell st into the next st, Ch2 * Repeat around (57 total stitches)
Round 8: Skip 2 sts, DC, Ch2, *Skip 4 sts, Shell st into the next st, Ch2, Skip 4 sts, DC, Ch2,* Repeat around (53 total stitches)
Round 9: Repeat round 7
Round 10: Repeat round 8
Round 11: Repeat round 7
Round 12: Repeat round 8
Round 13: Repeat round 7
Round 14: Skip 2 sts, HDC into the next st, Ch2, skip 4 sts, make a SC shell stitch into the next st, Ch2, skip 4 sts, slip st into the next st.
Edging:
Pick up at the next single DC from row 13 *Shell stitch with DC, Ch2, SC in center DC of next shell st, Ch2* Repeat around for edging, and slip stitch into the first DC of the first shell st at the end of the round. Cut yarn and secure and weave in ends.
Weave a piece of lace through the holes (behind the shell stitches) all the way around the hat, and tie a small bow in the center front.

## 6-12 Month Pattern

Each round is considered over at the end of the instructions for that round. Sometimes you will have unused stitches at the end of the round which is why it is important to keep your stitch marker in place. The next round will start at the stitch marker - not at the unused stitches.

Ch 4 and slip stitch with first Ch to join in the round.
Round 1: SC 9 times into the center of the ring. Place stitch marker (laying a piece of yarn over last stitch in last row may be easiest for this pattern).
Round 2: *SC twice into the next st, SC* Repeat 3 more times, SC twice into the next st ( 14 total stitches)
Round 3: *SC twice into the next st, SC* Repeat 5 more times, SC twice into the next 2 stitches ( 22 total stitches)
Round 4: *SC twice into the next st, SC* Repeat 9 more times, SC, SC ( 32 total stitches)
Round 5: *SC twice into the next st, SC in the next three sts* Repeat 7 more times ( 40 total sts)
Round 6: Ch1, Skip 1 st, Shell st (DC, CH1, DC, CH1, DC) into the next st, Ch1, *skip 2 sts, DC, Ch1, skip 2 sts, Shell st into the next st, Ch1* Repeat around ( 55 total sts)
Round 7: Skip 3 sts, DC, Ch2, *Skip 3 sts, Shell st into the next st, Ch2, Skip 3 sts, DC, Ch2,* Repeat around (57 total stitches)
Round 8: Shell st into the next st, Ch2, *Skip 4 sts, DC, Ch2, Skip 3 sts, Shell st into the next st, Ch2 * Repeat around ( 67 total stitches)
Round 9: Skip 2 sts, DC, Ch2, *Skip 4 sts, Shell st into the next st, Ch2, Skip 4 sts, DC, Ch2,* Repeat around (63 total stitches)
Round 10: Repeat round 8
Round 11: Repeat round 9
Round 12: Repeat round 8
Round 13: Repeat round 9
Round 14: Repeat round 8
Round 15: Skip 2 sts, HDC into the next st, Ch2, skip 4 sts, make a SC shell stitch into the next st, Ch2, skip 4 sts, slip st into the next st.
Edging:
Pick up at the next single DC from row 14 *Shell stitch with DC, Ch2, SC in center DC of next shell st, Ch2* Repeat around for edging, and slip stitch into the first DC of the first shell st at the end of the round. Cut yarn and secure and weave in ends.
Weave a piece of lace through the holes (behind the shell stitches) all the way around the hat, and tie a small bow in the center front.
