Melody's Makings

Lady's Little Leggies Knit-Crochet Pattern



Materials:

- Yarn: Approximately 60 yards (30 of color 1 and 30 of color 2) of super bulky (6) yarn for smaller sizes and approx. 120 yards (60 of color 1 and 60 of color 2) for larger sizes (I used Loops and Threads Cozy Wool)
- Knitting Needles: Size 10.0mm (US 15) Double Pointed Needles (or use the magic loop method) Crochet Hook: Size 10.0mm (N) or use a smaller hook if you crochet loosely and would like your edging to lay a bit flatter
 - Yarn or Tapestry Needle

Abbreviations:

- TC: Triple Crochet
- SC: Single Crochet
- **: Repeat the section in between the two stars as specified

Gauge:

5 sts and 7 rows = 2 inches (5 centimeters) in stockinette stitch
It is important to check your gauge!

Average Head Circumference:

Newborn: 13-14" 0-3 Months: 14-15" 3-6 Months: 14-17" 6-12 Months: 16-19" 1-3 Years: 18-20"

Newborn Pattern

Cast on 15 sts with color 1 onto Double Pointed Needles or use the Magic Loop Method (pink)

Join in the round and place stitch marker

Rounds 1-3: Knit

Drop color 1 (do not cut) and pick up color 2 (white)

Rounds 4-6: Knit

Drop color 2 (do not cut) and pick up color 1

Rounds 7-9: Knit

Drop color 1 and pick up color 2

Rounds 10-12: Knit

Drop color 2 and pick up color 1

Rounds 13-15: Knit

Bind off as if to knit. Cut approx. 7 inch tail. Using yarn needle, weave in all ends.

Pick up color 2 yarn and your crochet hook. Make sure you start your crochet stitch in the back of the leggies on the bind off edge. All of the next sts will be through the back loop only. *TC 3 times into the first stitch, skip one stitch, SC once into the next stitch, skip one stitch* Repeat 2 more times, TC 3 times into the next stitch, skip one stitch, SC once into the last stitch. Slip stitch into the first TC and cut yarn and secure ends. Repeat this sequence on the cast on edge and weave in all ends.

For headband, use your crochet hook and 1 strand of each color 1 and color 2 (leave approx. 7 inches of color 2 yarn at beginning). Chain until your piece measures approx. 13" (not including yarn tail at beginning). Slip stitch your last stitch with your first. Cut color 1 yarn and secure and weave in ends. Leave approx. 7 inches of color 2 yarn. Use a matching button and attach it over your seam using the two strands of left over color 2 yarn. Tie a bow in the center of the button. Trim excess yarn.

0-3 Month Pattern

Cast on 16 sts with color 1 onto Double Pointed Needles or use the Magic Loop Method (pink) Ioin in the round and place stitch marker

Rounds 1-4: Knit

Drop color 1 (do not cut) and pick up color 2 (white)

Rounds 5-7: Knit

Drop color 2 (do not cut) and pick up color 1

Rounds 8-10: Knit

Drop color 1 and pick up color 2

Rounds 11-13: Knit

Drop color 2 and pick up color 1

Rounds 14-17: Knit

Bind off as if to knit. Cut approx. 7 inch tail. Using yarn needle, weave in all ends.

Pick up color 2 yarn and your crochet hook. Make sure you start your crochet stitch in the back of the leggies on the bind off edge. All of the next sts will be through the back loop only. *TC 3 times into the first stitch, skip one stitch, SC once into the next stitch, skip one stitch* Repeat 3 more times. Slip stitch into the first TC and cut yarn and secure ends. Repeat this sequence on the cast on edge and weave in all ends.

For headband, use your crochet hook and 1 strand of each color 1 and color 2 (leave approx. 7 inches of color 2 yarn at beginning). Chain until your piece measures approx. 14" (not including yarn tail at beginning). Slip stitch your last stitch with your first. Cut color 1 yarn and secure and weave in ends. Leave approx. 7 inches of color 2 yarn. Use a matching button and attach it over your seam using the two strands of left over color 2 yarn. Tie a bow in the center of the button. Trim excess yarn.

3-6 Month Pattern

Cast on 18 sts with color 1 onto Double Pointed Needles or use the Magic Loop Method (pink) Ioin in the round and place stitch marker

Rounds 1-4: Knit

Drop color 1 (do not cut) and pick up color 2 (white)

Rounds 5-8: Knit

Drop color 2 (do not cut) and pick up color 1

Rounds 9-12: Knit

Drop color 1 and pick up color 2

Rounds 13-16: Knit

Drop color 2 and pick up color 1

Rounds 17-20: Knit

Bind off as if to knit. Cut approx. 7 inch tail. Using yarn needle, weave in all ends.

Pick up color 2 yarn and your crochet hook. Make sure you start your crochet stitch in the back of the leggies on the bind off edge. All of the next sts will be through the back loop only. *TC 3 times into the first stitch, skip one stitch, SC once into the next stitch, skip one stitch* Repeat 3 more times, TC 3 times into the next stitch, skip the last stitch. Slip stitch into the first TC and cut yarn and secure ends. Repeat this sequence on the cast on edge and weave in all ends.

For headband, use your crochet hook and 1 strand of each color 1 and color 2 (leave approx. 7 inches of color 2 yarn at beginning). Chain until your piece measures approx. 15" (not including yarn tail at beginning). Slip stitch your last stitch with your first. Cut color 1 yarn and secure and weave in ends. Leave approx. 7 inches of color 2 yarn. Use a matching button and attach it over your seam using the two strands of left over color 2 yarn. Tie a bow in the center of the button. Trim excess yarn.

6-12 Month Pattern

Cast on 20 sts with color 1 onto Double Pointed Needles or use the Magic Loop Method (pink)

Join in the round and place stitch marker

Rounds 1-4: Knit

Drop color 1 (do not cut) and pick up color 2 (white)

Rounds 5-8: Knit

Drop color 2 (do not cut) and pick up color 1

Rounds 9-11: Knit

Drop color 1 (do not cut) and pick up color 2

Rounds 12-14: Knit

Drop color 2 (do not cut) and pick up color 1

Rounds 15-17: Knit

Drop color 1 (do not cut) and pick up color 2

Rounds 18-21: Knit

Drop color 2 (do not cut) and pick up color 1

Rounds 22-25: Knit

Bind off as if to knit. Cut approx. 7 inch tail. Using yarn needle, weave in all ends.

Pick up color 2 yarn and your crochet hook. Make sure you start your crochet stitch in the back of the leggies on the bind off edge. All of the next sts will be through the back loop only. *TC 3 times into the first stitch, skip one stitch, SC once into the next stitch, skip one stitch* Repeat 4 more times. Slip stitch into the first TC and cut yarn and secure ends. Repeat this sequence on the cast on edge and weave in all ends.

For headband, use your crochet hook and 1 strand of each color 1 and color 2 (leave approx. 7 inches of color 2 yarn at beginning). Chain until your piece measures approx. 16" (not including yarn tail at beginning). Slip stitch your last stitch with your first. Cut color 1 yarn and secure and weave in ends. Leave approx. 7 inches of color 2 yarn. Use a matching button and attach it over your seam using the two strands of left over color 2 yarn. Tie a bow in the center of the button. Trim excess yarn.

12 Month - 3 Year Pattern

Cast on 22 sts with color 1 onto Double Pointed Needles or use the Magic Loop Method (pink)

Join in the round and place stitch marker

Rounds 1-4: Knit

Drop color 1 (do not cut) and pick up color 2 (white)

Rounds 5-8: Knit

Drop color 2 (do not cut) and pick up color 1

Rounds 9-12: Knit

Drop color 1 (do not cut) and pick up color 2

Rounds 13-16: Knit

Drop color 2 (do not cut) and pick up color 1

Rounds 17-20: Knit

Drop color 1 (do not cut) and pick up color 2

Rounds 21-24: Knit

Drop color 2 (do not cut) and pick up color 1

Rounds 25-28: Knit

Bind off as if to knit. Cut approx. 7 inch tail. Using yarn needle, weave in all ends.

Pick up color 2 yarn and your crochet hook. Make sure you start your crochet stitch in the back of the leggies on the bind off edge. All of the next sts will be through the back loop only. *TC 3 times into the first stitch, skip one stitch, SC once into the next stitch, skip one stitch* Repeat 4 more times, TC 3 times into the next stitch, skip the last stitch. Slip stitch into the first TC and cut yarn and secure ends. Repeat this sequence on the cast on edge and weave in all ends.

For headband, use your crochet hook and 1 strand of each color 1 and color 2 (leave approx. 7 inches of color 2 yarn at beginning). Chain until your piece measures approx. 17.5" (not including yarn tail at beginning). Slip stitch your last stitch with your first. Cut color 1 yarn and secure and weave in ends. Leave approx. 7 inches of color 2 yarn. Use a matching button and attach it over your seam using the two strands of left over color 2 yarn. Tie a bow in the center of the button. Trim excess yarn.

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
