

## Little Sweet Heart Hat Crochet Pattern



### Materials:

- Yarn: Approximately 50 yards of red bulky (5) yarn for smaller sizes, and approx. 100 yards for larger sizes (I used Serenity from the Deborah Norville Collection) and a small piece of pink yarn or ribbon for the bow.

- Crochet Hook: Size 9 mm (M/N)
- 1 Heart Shaped Button
- Yarn or Tapestry Needle

### Abbreviations:

- SC: Single Crochet
- CH: Chain
- TW: Turn Work
- SC2tog: Single Crochet the next two sts together
- \*\*: Repeat the section in between the two stars as specified

### Gauge:

5 sts and 6 rows = 2 inches (5 centimeters)  
in single crochet

\*\*\*It is important to check your gauge!\*\*\*

### Average Head Circumference:

Newborn: 13-14"

0-3 Months: 14-15"

3-6 Months: 14-17"

6-12 Months: 16-19"

1-3 Years: 18-20"

**\*\*Note:** You will be working in rounds from the bottom of the hat to the top of the hat where it turns into the heart. You will need to use a stitch marker to mark the beginning of each round\*\*

## **Newborn Pattern**

CH 26 sts

Place stitch marker and slip st the two ends of the chain together to make a circle (be careful not to twist it).

Round 1: CH1, SC around (27 total sts including the beginning chain)

Continue to SC in continuous rounds (do not chain at beginning of round – each round should have 27 sts) around each round until your project measures approx. 3.5” from the edge (total of 8 more rounds).

Decreases:

Round 1: \*SC2tog, SC7\* Repeat around (24 total sts)

Round 2: \*SC2tog, SC6\* Repeat around (21 total sts)

Round 3: \*SC2tog, SC5\* Repeat around (18 total sts)

Round 4: \*SC2tog, SC4\* Repeat around (15 total sts)

Round 5: \*SC2tog, SC3\* Repeat around (12 total sts)

You will now be working the heart in two separate sections

**First Section (just continue on from your stitch marker)**

Row 1: SC 6, CH1, TW (6 total sts)

Row 2: SC across, CH1, TW (6 total sts)

Row 3: SC1, SC twice in next stitch, SC2, SC twice in next stitch, SC1, CH1, TW (8 total sts)

Row 4: SC1, SC twice in next stitch, SC4, SC twice in next stitch, SC1, CH1, TW (10 total sts)

Row 5: SC across

Now you are going to work the top section one half at a time

Rows 6&7: SC5, CH1, TW (5 total sts)

Row 8: SC2tog, SC1, SC2tog, CH1, TW (3 total sts)

Row 9: SC1, SC2tog, CH1, TW (2 total sts)

Row 10: SC2tog, CH1, TW (1 total st)

Cut yarn and secure end. See picture 1. Go back and repeat rows 6-10 for the second half of top.

You will need to reattach your yarn to the first un-worked stitch in the second section of the heart.

Repeat rows 1-10 (including repeat of top section) for the other 6 sts (the second section) from the base of the heart. See picture 2.

Turn the hat inside out and using your heart yarn tails, use your yarn needle to seam the edges of the two hearts together. Seam all the way around the hearts including down onto the sides of them to ensure you do not have any holes. Secure and weave in all the ends. Turn your hat right side out and loosely tie a strand of pink yarn or ribbon around the base of the heart. Then secure a heart shaped button over the bow on the front.

## 0-3 Month Pattern

CH 32 sts

Place stitch marker and slip st the two ends of the chain together to make a circle (be careful not to twist it).

Round 1: CH1, SC around (33 total sts including the beginning chain)

Continue to SC in continuous rounds (do not chain at beginning of round – each round should have 33 sts) around each round until your project measures approx. 3.5” from the edge (total of 8 more rounds).

Decreases:

Round 1: \*SC2tog, SC9\* Repeat around (30 total sts)

Round 2: \*SC2tog, SC8\* Repeat around (27 total sts)

Round 3: \*SC2tog, SC7\* Repeat around (24 total sts)

Round 4: \*SC2tog, SC6\* Repeat around (21 total sts)

Round 5: \*SC2tog, SC5\* Repeat around (18 total sts)

Round 6: \*SC2tog, SC4\* Repeat around (15 total sts)

Round 7: \*SC2tog, SC3\* Repeat around (12 total sts)

You will now be working the heart in two separate sections

**First Section (just continue on from your stitch marker)**

Row 1: SC 6, CH1, TW (6 total sts)

Row 2: SC across, CH1, TW (6 total sts)

Row 3: SC1, SC twice in next stitch, SC2, SC twice in next stitch, SC1, CH1, TW (8 total sts)

Row 4: SC1, SC twice in next stitch, SC4, SC twice in next stitch, SC1, CH1, TW (10 total sts)

Row 5: SC across

Now you are going to work the top section one half at a time

Rows 6&7: SC5, CH1, TW (5 total sts)

Row 8: SC2tog, SC1, SC2tog, CH1, TW (3 total sts)

Row 9: SC1, SC2tog, CH1, TW (2 total sts)

Row 10: SC2tog, CH1, TW (1 total st)

Cut yarn and secure end. See picture 1. Go back and repeat rows 6-10 for the second half of top.

You will need to reattach your yarn to the first un-worked stitch in the second section of the heart.

Repeat rows 1-10 (including repeat of top section) for the other 6 sts (the second section) from the base of the heart. See picture 2.

Turn the hat inside out and using your heart yarn tails, use your yarn needle to seam the edges of the two hearts together. Seam all the way around the hearts including down onto the sides of them to ensure you do not have any holes. Secure and weave in all the ends. Turn your hat right side out and loosely tie a strand of pink yarn or ribbon around the base of the heart. Then secure a heart shaped button over the bow on the front.

### 3-6 Month Pattern

CH 35 sts

Place stitch marker and slip st the two ends of the chain together to make a circle (be careful not to twist it).

Round 1: CH1, SC around (36 total sts including the beginning chain)

Continue to SC in continuous rounds (do not chain at beginning of round – each round should have 36 sts) around each round until your project measures approx. 3.5” from the edge (total of 8 more rounds).

Decreases:

Round 1: \*SC2tog, SC10\* Repeat around (33 total sts)

Round 2: \*SC2tog, SC9\* Repeat around (30 total sts)

Round 3: \*SC2tog, SC8\* Repeat around (27 total sts)

Round 4: \*SC2tog, SC7\* Repeat around (24 total sts)

Round 5: \*SC2tog, SC6\* Repeat around (21 total sts)

Round 6: \*SC2tog, SC5\* Repeat around (18 total sts)

Round 7: \*SC2tog, SC4\* Repeat around (15 total sts)

Round 8: \*SC2tog, SC3\* Repeat around (12 total sts)

You will now be working the heart in two separate sections

**First Section (just continue on from your stitch marker)**

Row 1: SC 6, CH1, TW (6 total sts)

Row 2: SC across, CH1, TW (6 total sts)

Row 3: SC1, SC twice in next stitch, SC2, SC twice in next stitch, SC1, CH1, TW (8 total sts)

Row 4: SC1, SC twice in next stitch, SC4, SC twice in next stitch, SC1, CH1, TW (10 total sts)

Row 5: SC across

Now you are going to work the top section one half at a time

Rows 6&7: SC5, CH1, TW (5 total sts)

Row 8: SC2tog, SC1, SC2tog, CH1, TW (3 total sts)

Row 9: SC1, SC2tog, CH1, TW (2 total sts)

Row 10: SC2tog, CH1, TW (1 total st)

Cut yarn and secure end. See picture 1. Go back and repeat rows 6-10 for the second half of top.

You will need to reattach your yarn to the first un-worked stitch in the second section of the heart.

Repeat rows 1-10 (including repeat of top section) for the other 6 sts (the second section) from the base of the heart. See picture 2.

Turn the hat inside out and using your heart yarn tails, use your yarn needle to seam the edges of the two hearts together. Seam all the way around the hearts including down onto the sides of them to ensure you do not have any holes. Secure and weave in all the ends. Turn your hat right side out and loosely tie a strand of pink yarn or ribbon around the base of the heart. Then secure a heart shaped button over the bow on the front.

## 6-12 Month Pattern

CH 38 sts

Place stitch marker and slip st the two ends of the chain together to make a circle (be careful not to twist it).

Round 1: CH1, SC around (39 total sts including the beginning chain)

Continue to SC in continuous rounds (do not chain at beginning of round – each round should have 39 sts) around each round until your project measures approx. 5" from the edge (total of 14 more rounds).

Decreases:

Round 1: \*SC2tog, SC11\* Repeat around (36 total sts)

Round 2: \*SC2tog, SC10\* Repeat around (33 total sts)

Round 3: \*SC2tog, SC9\* Repeat around (30 total sts)

Round 4: \*SC2tog, SC8\* Repeat around (27 total sts)

Round 5: \*SC2tog, SC7\* Repeat around (24 total sts)

Round 6: \*SC2tog, SC6\* Repeat around (21 total sts)

Round 7: \*SC2tog, SC5\* Repeat around (18 total sts)

Round 8: \*SC2tog, SC4\* Repeat around (15 total sts)

Round 9: \*SC2tog, SC3\* Repeat around (12 total sts)

You will now be working the heart in two separate sections

**First Section (just continue on from your stitch marker)**

Row 1: SC 6, CH1, TW (6 total sts)

Row 2: SC across, CH1, TW (6 total sts)

Row 3: SC1, SC twice in next stitch, SC2, SC twice in next stitch, SC1, CH1, TW (8 total sts)

Row 4: SC1, SC twice in next stitch, SC4, SC twice in next stitch, SC1, CH1, TW (10 total sts)

Row 5: SC across

Now you are going to work the top section one half at a time

Rows 6&7: SC5, CH1, TW (5 total sts)

Row 8: SC2tog, SC1, SC2tog, CH1, TW (3 total sts)

Row 9: SC1, SC2tog, CH1, TW (2 total sts)

Row 10: SC2tog, CH1, TW (1 total st)

Cut yarn and secure end. See picture 1. Go back and repeat rows 6-10 for the second half of top.

You will need to reattach your yarn to the first un-worked stitch in the second section of the heart.

Repeat rows 1-10 (including repeat of top section) for the other 6 sts (the second section) from the base of the heart. See picture 2.

Turn the hat inside out and using your heart yarn tails, use your yarn needle to seam the edges of the two hearts together. Seam all the way around the hearts including down onto the sides of them to ensure you do not have any holes. Secure and weave in all the ends. Turn your hat right side out and loosely tie a strand of pink yarn or ribbon around the base of the heart. Then secure a heart shaped button over the bow on the front.

## 12 Month – 3 Year Pattern

CH 44 sts

Place stitch marker and slip st the two ends of the chain together to make a circle (be careful not to twist it).

Round 1: CH1, SC around (45 total sts including the beginning chain)

Continue to SC in continuous rounds (do not chain at beginning of round – each round should have 45 sts) around each round until your project measures approx. 3.5” from the edge (total of 8 more rounds).

Decreases:

Round 1: \*SC2tog, SC13\* Repeat around (42 total sts)

Round 2: \*SC2tog, SC12\* Repeat around (39 total sts)

Round 3: \*SC2tog, SC11\* Repeat around (36 total sts)

Round 4: \*SC2tog, SC10\* Repeat around (33 total sts)

Round 5: \*SC2tog, SC9\* Repeat around (30 total sts)

Round 6: \*SC2tog, SC8\* Repeat around (27 total sts)

Round 7: \*SC2tog, SC7\* Repeat around (24 total sts)

Round 8: \*SC2tog, SC6\* Repeat around (21 total sts)

Round 9: \*SC2tog, SC5\* Repeat around (18 total sts)

Round 10: \*SC2tog, SC4\* Repeat around (15 total sts)

Round 11: \*SC2tog, SC3\* Repeat around (12 total sts)

You will now be working the heart in two separate sections

**First Section (just continue on from your stitch marker)**

Row 1: SC 6, CH1, TW (6 total sts)

Row 2: SC across, CH1, TW (6 total sts)

Row 3: SC1, SC twice in next stitch, SC2, SC twice in next stitch, SC1, CH1, TW (8 total sts)

Row 4: SC1, SC twice in next stitch, SC4, SC twice in next stitch, SC1, CH1, TW (10 total sts)

Row 5: SC across

Now you are going to work the top section one half at a time

Rows 6&7: SC5, CH1, TW (5 total sts)

Row 8: SC2tog, SC1, SC2tog, CH1, TW (3 total sts)

Row 9: SC1, SC2tog, CH1, TW (2 total sts)

Row 10: SC2tog, CH1, TW (1 total st)

Cut yarn and secure end. See picture 1. Go back and repeat rows 6-10 for the second half of top.

You will need to reattach your yarn to the first un-worked stitch in the second section of the heart.

Repeat rows 1-10 (including repeat of top section) for the other 6 sts (the second section) from the base of the heart. See picture 2.
