## Moose Hat and Cape Crochet Pattern



Materials:

- Yarn: Approximately 200 yards of worsted (4) yarn for smaller sizes, and approx. 375 yards for larger sizes of color 1 (brown) yarn and approx. 20 yards of color 2 (tan) yarn. (I used Vanna's Choice)
- Crochet Hook: Size $5.5 \mathrm{~mm}(\mathrm{I} / 9)$ OR whatever size is needed to obtain gauge
- Yarn or Tapestry Needle


## Abbreviations:

- SC: Single Crochet
- CH: Chain
- SC2tog: Single Crochet the next two stitches together
-**: Repeat the section in between the two stars as specified

Gauge:
7 sts and 9 rows $=2$ inches ( 5 centimeters) in single crochet
***It is important to check your gauge! ${ }^{* * *}$

Average Head Circumference:
Newborn: 13-14"
0-3 Months: 14-15"
3-6 Months: 14-17"
6-12 Months: 16-19"
1-3 Year: 18-20"

## Newborn Hat Pattern

Chain 45 with color 1 yarn
Join in the round by slip stitching first and last chains together. Place Stitch Marker.
This pattern is worked in continuous rounds. Move stitch marker up with each round.
Round 1: Single Crochet into each stitch around. ( 45 total sts)
Continue to Single Crochet each round until your piece measures approx. 4.75 inches ( 12 cm ) from the starting edge.
Then move on to decreases.
Decreases:
Round 1: *SC2tog, SC3* Repeat around (36 total sts)
Round 2: *SC2tog, SC2* Repeat around (27 total sts)
Round 3: *SC2tog, SC1* Repeat around (18 total sts)
Round 4: *SC2tog* Repeat around (9 total sts)
Continue to SC2tog until the hole at the top of your hat is closed. Cut yarn with an approx. 7 inch yarn tail. Use your yarn or tapestry needle to secure the top hole, and secure and weave in all ends.
Gently roll approx. . 5 inches ( 1.25 cm ) of your brim up.

## Antler Pattern

Chain 6 with color 2 yarn (leave an approx. 12 inch ( 30.5 cm ) yarn tail)
Join in the round by slip stitching first and last chains together. Place Stitch Marker.
This pattern is worked in continuous rounds. Move stitch marker up with each round.
Round 1: Single Crochet into each stitch around ( 6 total sts)
Continue to Single Crochet each round until your piece measures approx. 3 inches ( 7.5 cm ) from the starting edge.
Cut your yarn with an approx. 12 inch yarn tail. Secure your last stitch, and use your yarn needle to pick up each of your last stitches and cinch the tip of your antler. Use yarn needle to pull yarn tail to inside, tie a knot, and weave in the end.
Use your starting yarn tail to secure your antler to the upper side of your hat, facing directly out. Insert your hook through the uppermost stitch on your antler approx. .75 inches ( 2 cm ) from the outer edge, and pick up your yarn. This is the start of your outer antler tip.
Pick up two sts towards the base of your hat, and then turn to work the opposite direction, picking up two more sts for a total of 4 stitches.
Work these 4 sts with single crochet in the round until your outer antler tip measures approx. . 5 inches $(1.25 \mathrm{~cm})$ tall. Use your yarn needle to cinch the tip like you did previously.
Repeat this process for the inner antler tip approx. . 5 inch ( 1.25 cm ) towards the base of the hat. Repeat the whole process for the second antler.

## Cape Pattern

Use color 1 yarn
Row 1: Pick up and Single Crochet 10 sts along the base of the brim roll directly in the back of your hat, CH1, Turn Work (10 total sts) See Photos On Last Page For Sample
Row 2: Single crochet into each stitch across, CH1, Turn work (TW) (10 total sts)
Row 3: Single crochet twice into first stitch, single crochet into each stitch across to last stitch, single crochet twice in last stitch, CH1, TW (12 total sts)
Row 4: Single crochet into each stitch across, CH1, Turn work
Row 5: Single crochet twice into first stitch, single crochet into each stitch across to last stitch, single crochet twice in last stitch, CH1, TW ( 14 total sts)
Row 6: Single crochet into each stitch across, CH1, Turn work
Row 7: Single crochet twice into first stitch, single crochet into each stitch across to last stitch, single crochet twice in last stitch, CH1, TW (16 total sts)

Row 8: Single crochet into each stitch across, CH1, Turn work
Row 9: Single crochet twice into first stitch, single crochet into each stitch across to last stitch, single crochet twice in last stitch, CH1, TW (18 total sts)
Row 10: Single crochet into each stitch across, CH1, Turn work
Row 11: Single crochet twice into first stitch, single crochet into each stitch across to last stitch, single crochet twice in last stitch, CH1, TW ( 20 total sts)
Row 12: Single crochet into each stitch across, CH1, Turn work
Row 13: Single crochet twice into first stitch, single crochet into each stitch across to last stitch, single crochet twice in last stitch, CH1, TW (22 total sts)
Row 14: Single crochet into each stitch across, CH1, Turn work
Row 15: Single crochet twice into first stitch, single crochet into each stitch across to last stitch, single crochet twice in last stitch, CH1, TW (24 total sts)
Row 16: Single crochet into each stitch across, CH1, Turn work ( 24 total sts)
Repeat row 16 until your piece measures approx. 10 inches ( 25.5 cm ) from the starting edge of the cape.
Row 17: SC2tog, Single crochet each stitch across to last two, SC2tog, CH1, TW (22 total sts)
Row 18: Single crochet into each stitch across, CH1, TW
Row 19: SC2tog, Single crochet each stitch across to last two, SC2tog, CH1, TW (20 total sts)
Row 20: Single crochet into each stitch across, CH1, TW
Row 21: SC2tog, Single crochet each stitch across to last two, SC2tog, CH1, TW (18 total sts)
Row 22: Single crochet into each stitch across, CH1, TW
Row 23: SC2tog, Single crochet each stitch across to last two, SC2tog, CH1, TW (16 total sts)
Row 24: SC2tog, Single crochet each stitch across to last two, SC2tog, CH1, TW (14 total sts)
Row 25: SC2tog, Single crochet each stitch across to last two, SC2tog, CH1, TW (12 total sts)
Row 26: SC2tog, Single crochet each stitch across to last two, SC2tog, CH1, TW (10 total sts)
Secure and weave in all ends.

## Tail Pattern

Chain 13 sts with color 1 yarn (leave an approx. 12 inch ( 30.5 cm ) yarn tail)
Row 1: Single crochet into the second chain from hook and each stitch across, CH1, TW (12 total)
Row 2: Single crochet into each stitch across, CH1, TW
Rows 3-6: Repeat row 2
Row 7: SC2tog, Single crochet each stitch across to last two, SC2tog, CH1, TW (10 total sts)
Row 8: SC2tog, Single crochet each stitch across to last two, SC2tog, CH1, TW (8 total sts)
Row 9: SC2tog, Single crochet each stitch across to last two, SC2tog, CH1, TW (6 total sts)
Row 10: SC2tog, SC2, SC2tog, CH1, TW (4 total sts)
Row 11: SC2tog, SC2tog, CH1, TW (2 total sts)
Row 12: SC2tog (1 total st)
Secure and weave in end. Fold your piece in half with decreases together, and use your starting yarn tail to attach starting edge to the center back of the cape creating a little tail. Tail should stick straight up into the air.

## 0-3 Month Hat Pattern

Chain 50 with color 1 yarn
Join in the round by slip stitching first and last chains together. Place Stitch Marker.
This pattern is worked in continuous rounds. Move stitch marker up with each round.
Round 1: Single Crochet into each stitch around. (50 total sts)
Continue to Single Crochet each round until your piece measures approx. 5 inches ( 12.75 cm ) from the starting edge.
Then move on to decreases.
Decreases:
Round 1: *SC2tog, SC3* Repeat around (40 total sts)
Round 2: *SC2tog, SC2* Repeat around (30 total sts)
Round 3: *SC2tog, SC1* Repeat around (20 total sts)
Round 4: *SC2tog* Repeat around ( 10 total sts)
Round 5: *SC2tog* Repeat around (5 total sts)
Continue to SC2tog until the hole at the top of your hat is closed. Cut yarn with an approx. 7 inch yarn tail. Use your yarn or tapestry needle to secure the top hole, and secure and weave in all ends.
Gently roll approx. . 5 inches ( 1.25 cm ) of your brim up.

## Antler Pattern

Chain 6 with color 2 yarn (leave an approx. 12 inch ( 30.5 cm ) yarn tail)
Join in the round by slip stitching first and last chains together. Place Stitch Marker.
This pattern is worked in continuous rounds. Move stitch marker up with each round.
Round 1: Single Crochet into each stitch around ( 6 total sts)
Continue to Single Crochet each round until your piece measures approx. 3 inches ( 7.5 cm ) from the starting edge.
Cut your yarn with an approx. 12 inch yarn tail. Secure your last stitch, and use your yarn needle to pick up each of your last stitches and cinch the tip of your antler. Use yarn needle to pull yarn tail to inside, tie a knot, and weave in the end.
Use your starting yarn tail to secure your antler to the upper side of your hat, facing directly out. Insert your hook through the uppermost stitch on your antler approx. .75 inches ( 2 cm ) from the outer edge, and pick up your yarn. This is the start of your outer antler tip.
Pick up two sts towards the base of your hat, and then turn to work the opposite direction, picking up two more sts for a total of 4 stitches.
Work these 4 sts with single crochet in the round until your outer antler tip measures approx. . 5 inches ( 1.25 cm ) tall. Use your yarn needle to cinch the tip like you did previously.
Repeat this process for the inner antler tip approx. . 5 inch ( 1.25 cm ) towards the base of the hat. Repeat the whole process for the second antler.

## Cape Pattern

Use color 1 yarn
Row 1: Pick up and Single Crochet 10 sts along the base of the brim roll directly in the back of your hat, CH1, Turn Work (10 total sts) See Photos On Last Page For Sample
Row 2: Single crochet into each stitch across, CH1, Turn work (TW) (10 total sts)
Row 3: Single crochet twice into first stitch, single crochet into each stitch across to last stitch, single crochet twice in last stitch, CH1, TW (12 total sts)
Row 4: Single crochet into each stitch across, CH1, Turn work
Row 5: Single crochet twice into first stitch, single crochet into each stitch across to last stitch, single crochet twice in last stitch, CH1, TW (14 total sts)
Row 6: Single crochet into each stitch across, CH1, Turn work

Row 7: Single crochet twice into first stitch, single crochet into each stitch across to last stitch, single crochet twice in last stitch, CH1, TW ( 16 total sts)
Row 8: Single crochet into each stitch across, CH1, Turn work
Row 9: Single crochet twice into first stitch, single crochet into each stitch across to last stitch, single crochet twice in last stitch, CH1, TW (18 total sts)
Row 10: Single crochet into each stitch across, CH1, Turn work
Row 11: Single crochet twice into first stitch, single crochet into each stitch across to last stitch, single crochet twice in last stitch, CH1, TW (20 total sts)
Row 12: Single crochet into each stitch across, CH1, Turn work
Row 13: Single crochet twice into first stitch, single crochet into each stitch across to last stitch, single crochet twice in last stitch, CH1, TW ( 22 total sts)
Row 14: Single crochet into each stitch across, CH1, Turn work
Row 15: Single crochet twice into first stitch, single crochet into each stitch across to last stitch, single crochet twice in last stitch, CH1, TW ( 24 total sts)
Row 16: Single crochet into each stitch across, CH1, Turn work ( 24 total sts)
Row 17: Single crochet twice into first stitch, single crochet into each stitch across to last stitch, single crochet twice in last stitch, CH1, TW (26 total sts)
Row 18: Single crochet into each stitch across, CH1, Turn work ( 26 total sts)
Repeat row 18 until your piece measures approx. 10 inches $(25.5 \mathrm{~cm})$ from the starting edge of the cape.
Row 19: SC2tog, Single crochet each stitch across to last two, SC2tog, CH1, TW (24 total sts)
Row 20: Single crochet into each stitch across, CH1, TW
Row 21: SC2tog, Single crochet each stitch across to last two, SC2tog, CH1, TW (22 total sts)
Row 22: Single crochet into each stitch across, CH1, TW
Row 23: SC2tog, Single crochet each stitch across to last two, SC2tog, CH1, TW (20 total sts)
Row 24: Single crochet into each stitch across, CH1, TW
Row 25: SC2tog, Single crochet each stitch across to last two, SC2tog, CH1, TW (18 total sts)
Row 26: Single crochet into each stitch across, CH1, TW
Row 27: SC2tog, Single crochet each stitch across to last two, SC2tog, CH1, TW (16 total sts)
Row 28: SC2tog, Single crochet each stitch across to last two, SC2tog, CH1, TW (14 total sts)
Row 29: SC2tog, Single crochet each stitch across to last two, SC2tog, CH1, TW (12 total sts)
Row 30: SC2tog, Single crochet each stitch across to last two, SC2tog, CH1, TW (10 total sts)
Secure and weave in all ends.

## Tail Pattern

Chain 13 sts with color 1 yarn (leave an approx. 12 inch ( 30.5 cm ) yarn tail)
Row 1: Single crochet into the second chain from hook and each stitch across, CH1, TW (12 total)
Row 2: Single crochet into each stitch across, CH1, TW
Rows 3-6: Repeat row 2
Row 7: SC2tog, Single crochet each stitch across to last two, SC2tog, CH1, TW (10 total sts)
Row 8: SC2tog, Single crochet each stitch across to last two, SC2tog, CH1, TW (8 total sts)
Row 9: SC2tog, Single crochet each stitch across to last two, SC2tog, CH1, TW (6 total sts)
Row 10: SC2tog, SC2, SC2tog, CH1, TW (4 total sts)
Row 11: SC2tog, SC2tog, CH1, TW (2 total sts)
Row 12: SC2tog (1 total st)
Secure and weave in end. Fold your piece in half with decreases together, and use your starting yarn tail to attach starting edge to the center back of the cape creating a little tail. Tail should stick straight up into the air.

## 3-6 Month Hat Pattern

Chain 54 with color 1 yarn
Join in the round by slip stitching first and last chains together. Place Stitch Marker.
This pattern is worked in continuous rounds. Move stitch marker up with each round.
Round 1: Single Crochet into each stitch around. (54 total sts)
Continue to Single Crochet each round until your piece measures approx. 5.25 inches ( 13.25 cm ) from the starting edge.
Then move on to decreases.
Decreases:
Round 1: *SC2tog, SC4* Repeat around (45 total sts)
Round 2: *SC2tog, SC3* Repeat around (36 total sts)
Round 3: *SC2tog, SC2* Repeat around (27 total sts)
Round 4: *SC2tog, SC1* Repeat around (18 total sts)
Round 5: *SC2tog* Repeat around (9 total sts)
Continue to SC2tog until the hole at the top of your hat is closed. Cut yarn with an approx. 7 inch yarn tail. Use your yarn or tapestry needle to secure the top hole, and secure and weave in all ends.
Gently roll approx. . 5 inches ( 1.25 cm ) of your brim up.

## Antler Pattern

Chain 7 with color 2 yarn (leave an approx. 12 inch ( 30.5 cm ) yarn tail)
Join in the round by slip stitching first and last chains together. Place Stitch Marker.
This pattern is worked in continuous rounds. Move stitch marker up with each round.
Round 1: Single Crochet into each stitch around (7 total sts)
Continue to Single Crochet each round until your piece measures approx. 3.25 inches ( 8.25 cm ) from the starting edge.
Cut your yarn with an approx. 12 inch yarn tail. Secure your last stitch, and use your yarn needle to pick up each of your last stitches and cinch the tip of your antler. Use yarn needle to pull yarn tail to inside, tie a knot, and weave in the end.
Use your starting yarn tail to secure your antler to the upper side of your hat, facing directly out. Insert your hook through the uppermost stitch on your antler approx. .75 inches ( 2 cm ) from the outer edge, and pick up your yarn. This is the start of your outer antler tip.
Pick up two sts towards the base of your hat, and then turn to work the opposite direction, picking up two more sts for a total of 4 stitches.
Work these 4 sts with single crochet in the round until your outer antler tip measures approx. . 75 inches ( 2 cm ) tall. Use your yarn needle to cinch the tip like you did previously.
Repeat this process for the inner antler tip approx. . 5 inch ( 1.25 cm ) towards the base of the hat. Repeat the whole process for the second antler.

## Cape Pattern

Row 3: Single crochet twice into first stitch, single crochet into each stitch across to last stitch, single crochet twice in last stitch, CH1, TW (12 total sts)
Row 4: Single crochet into each stitch across, CH1, Turn work
Row 5: Single crochet twice into first stitch, single crochet into each stitch across to last stitch, single crochet twice in last stitch, CH1, TW (14 total sts)
Row 6: Single crochet into each stitch across, CH1, Turn work

Row 7: Single crochet twice into first stitch, single crochet into each stitch across to last stitch, single crochet twice in last stitch, CH1, TW (16 total sts)
Row 8: Single crochet into each stitch across, CH1, Turn work
Row 9: Single crochet twice into first stitch, single crochet into each stitch across to last stitch, single crochet twice in last stitch, CH1, TW (18 total sts)
Row 10: Single crochet into each stitch across, CH1, Turn work
Row 11: Single crochet twice into first stitch, single crochet into each stitch across to last stitch, single crochet twice in last stitch, CH1, TW (20 total sts)
Row 12: Single crochet into each stitch across, CH1, Turn work
Row 13: Single crochet twice into first stitch, single crochet into each stitch across to last stitch, single crochet twice in last stitch, CH1, TW ( 22 total sts)
Row 14: Single crochet into each stitch across, CH1, Turn work
Row 15: Single crochet twice into first stitch, single crochet into each stitch across to last stitch, single crochet twice in last stitch, CH1, TW ( 24 total sts)
Row 16: Single crochet into each stitch across, CH1, Turn work ( 24 total sts)
Row 17: Single crochet twice into first stitch, single crochet into each stitch across to last stitch, single crochet twice in last stitch, CH1, TW ( 26 total sts)
Row 18: Single crochet into each stitch across, CH1, Turn work (26 total sts)
Row 19: Single crochet twice into first stitch, single crochet into each stitch across to last stitch, single crochet twice in last stitch, CH1, TW (28 total sts)
Row 20: Single crochet into each stitch across, CH1, Turn work (28 total sts)
Repeat row 20 until your piece measures approx. 10.5 inches ( 26.5 cm ) from the starting edge of the cape.
Row 21: SC2tog, Single crochet each stitch across to last two, SC2tog, CH1, TW (26 total sts)
Row 22: Single crochet into each stitch across, CH1, TW
Row 23: SC2tog, Single crochet each stitch across to last two, SC2tog, CH1, TW (24 total sts)
Row 24: Single crochet into each stitch across, CH1, TW
Row 25: SC2tog, Single crochet each stitch across to last two, SC2tog, CH1, TW (22 total sts)
Row 26: Single crochet into each stitch across, CH1, TW
Row 27: SC2tog, Single crochet each stitch across to last two, SC2tog, CH1, TW (20 total sts)
Row 28: Single crochet into each stitch across, CH1, TW
Row 29: SC2tog, Single crochet each stitch across to last two, SC2tog, CH1, TW (18 total sts)
Row 30: Single crochet into each stitch across, CH1, TW
Row 31: SC2tog, Single crochet each stitch across to last two, SC2tog, CH1, TW (16 total sts)
Row 32: SC2tog, Single crochet each stitch across to last two, SC2tog, CH1, TW (14 total sts)
Row 33: SC2tog, Single crochet each stitch across to last two, SC2tog, CH1, TW (12 total sts)
Row 34: SC2tog, Single crochet each stitch across to last two, SC2tog, CH1, TW (10 total sts)
Secure and weave in all ends.

## Tail Pattern

Chain 13 sts with color 1 yarn (leave an approx. 12 inch ( 30.5 cm ) yarn tail)
Row 1: Single crochet into the second chain from hook and each stitch across, CH1, TW (12 total) Row 2: Single crochet into each stitch across, CH1, TW
Rows 3-6: Repeat row 2
Row 7: SC2tog, Single crochet each stitch across to last two, SC2tog, CH1, TW (10 total sts)
Row 8: SC2tog, Single crochet each stitch across to last two, SC2tog, CH1, TW (8 total sts)
Row 9: SC2tog, Single crochet each stitch across to last two, SC2tog, CH1, TW (6 total sts)
Row 10: SC2tog, SC2, SC2tog, CH1, TW (4 total sts)
Row 11: SC2tog, SC2tog, CH1, TW (2 total sts)
Row 12: SC2tog (1 total st)

Secure and weave in end. Fold your piece in half with decreases together, and use your starting yarn tail to attach starting edge to the center back of the cape creating a little tail. Tail should stick straight up into the air.

## 6-12 Month Hat Pattern

Chain 56 with color 1 yarn
Join in the round by slip stitching first and last chains together. Place Stitch Marker.
This pattern is worked in continuous rounds. Move stitch marker up with each round.
Round 1: Single Crochet into each stitch around. ( 56 total sts)
Continue to Single Crochet each round until your piece measures approx. 5.75 inches ( 14.5 cm )
from the starting edge.
Then move on to decreases.
Decreases:
Round 1: *SC2tog, SC5* Repeat around (48 total sts)
Round 2: *SC2tog, SC4* Repeat around (40 total sts)
Round 3: *SC2tog, SC3* Repeat around (32 total sts)
Round 4: *SC2tog, SC2* Repeat around ( 24 total sts)
Round 5: *SC2tog, SC1* Repeat around (16 total sts)
Round 6: *SC2tog* Repeat around (8 total sts)
Continue to SC2tog until the hole at the top of your hat is closed. Cut yarn with an approx. 7 inch yarn tail. Use your yarn or tapestry needle to secure the top hole, and secure and weave in all ends.
Gently roll approx. . 5 inches ( 1.25 cm ) of your brim up.

## Antler Pattern

Chain 7 with color 2 yarn (leave an approx. 12 inch ( 30.5 cm ) yarn tail)
Join in the round by slip stitching first and last chains together. Place Stitch Marker.
This pattern is worked in continuous rounds. Move stitch marker up with each round.
Round 1: Single Crochet into each stitch around (7 total sts)
Continue to Single Crochet each round until your piece measures approx. 3.25 inches ( 8.25 cm ) from the starting edge.
Cut your yarn with an approx. 12 inch yarn tail. Secure your last stitch, and use your yarn needle to pick up each of your last stitches and cinch the tip of your antler. Use yarn needle to pull yarn tail to inside, tie a knot, and weave in the end.
Use your starting yarn tail to secure your antler to the upper side of your hat, facing directly out. Insert your hook through the uppermost stitch on your antler approx. .75 inches $(2 \mathrm{~cm})$ from the outer edge, and pick up your yarn. This is the start of your outer antler tip.
Pick up two sts towards the base of your hat, and then turn to work the opposite direction, picking up two more sts for a total of 4 stitches.
Work these 4 sts with single crochet in the round until your outer antler tip measures approx. . 75 inches ( 2 cm ) tall. Use your yarn needle to cinch the tip like you did previously.

Row 5: Single crochet twice into first stitch, single crochet into each stitch across to last stitch, single crochet twice in last stitch, CH1, TW (14 total sts)
Row 6: Single crochet into each stitch across, CH1, Turn work

Row 7: Single crochet twice into first stitch, single crochet into each stitch across to last stitch, single crochet twice in last stitch, CH1, TW ( 16 total sts)
Row 8: Single crochet into each stitch across, CH1, Turn work
Row 9: Single crochet twice into first stitch, single crochet into each stitch across to last stitch, single crochet twice in last stitch, CH1, TW (18 total sts)
Row 10: Single crochet into each stitch across, CH1, Turn work
Row 11: Single crochet twice into first stitch, single crochet into each stitch across to last stitch, single crochet twice in last stitch, CH1, TW (20 total sts)
Row 12: Single crochet into each stitch across, CH1, Turn work
Row 13: Single crochet twice into first stitch, single crochet into each stitch across to last stitch, single crochet twice in last stitch, CH1, TW ( 22 total sts)
Row 14: Single crochet into each stitch across, CH1, Turn work
Row 15: Single crochet twice into first stitch, single crochet into each stitch across to last stitch, single crochet twice in last stitch, CH1, TW ( 24 total sts)
Row 16: Single crochet into each stitch across, CH1, Turn work ( 24 total sts)
Row 17: Single crochet twice into first stitch, single crochet into each stitch across to last stitch, single crochet twice in last stitch, CH1, TW ( 26 total sts)
Row 18: Single crochet into each stitch across, CH1, Turn work (26 total sts)
Row 19: Single crochet twice into first stitch, single crochet into each stitch across to last stitch, single crochet twice in last stitch, CH1, TW ( 28 total sts)
Row 20: Single crochet into each stitch across, CH1, Turn work (28 total sts)
Repeat row 20 until your piece measures approx. 11.5 inches ( 29.25 cm ) from the starting edge of the cape.
Row 21: SC2tog, Single crochet each stitch across to last two, SC2tog, CH1, TW (26 total sts)
Row 22: Single crochet into each stitch across, CH1, TW
Row 23: SC2tog, Single crochet each stitch across to last two, SC2tog, CH1, TW (24 total sts)
Row 24: Single crochet into each stitch across, CH1, TW
Row 25: SC2tog, Single crochet each stitch across to last two, SC2tog, CH1, TW (22 total sts)
Row 26: Single crochet into each stitch across, CH1, TW
Row 27: SC2tog, Single crochet each stitch across to last two, SC2tog, CH1, TW (20 total sts)
Row 28: Single crochet into each stitch across, CH1, TW
Row 29: SC2tog, Single crochet each stitch across to last two, SC2tog, CH1, TW (18 total sts)
Row 30: Single crochet into each stitch across, CH1, TW
Row 31: SC2tog, Single crochet each stitch across to last two, SC2tog, CH1, TW (16 total sts)
Row 32: SC2tog, Single crochet each stitch across to last two, SC2tog, CH1, TW (14 total sts)
Row 33: SC2tog, Single crochet each stitch across to last two, SC2tog, CH1, TW (12 total sts)
Row 34: SC2tog, Single crochet each stitch across to last two, SC2tog, CH1, TW (10 total sts)
Secure and weave in all ends.

## Tail Pattern

Chain 13 sts with color 1 yarn (leave an approx. 12 inch ( 30.5 cm ) yarn tail)
Row 1: Single crochet into the second chain from hook and each stitch across, CH1, TW (12 total)
Row 2: Single crochet into each stitch across, CH1, TW
Rows 3-6: Repeat row 2
Row 7: SC2tog, Single crochet each stitch across to last two, SC2tog, CH1, TW (10 total sts)
Row 8: SC2tog, Single crochet each stitch across to last two, SC2tog, CH1, TW (8 total sts)
Row 9: SC2tog, Single crochet each stitch across to last two, SC2tog, CH1, TW (6 total sts)
Row 10: SC2tog, SC2, SC2tog, CH1, TW (4 total sts)
Row 11: SC2tog, SC2tog, CH1, TW (2 total sts)
Row 12: SC2tog (1 total st)

Secure and weave in end. Fold your piece in half with decreases together, and use your starting yarn tail to attach starting edge to the center back of the cape creating a little tail. Tail should stick straight up into the air.

## 1-3 Year Hat Pattern

Chain 60 with color 1 yarn
Join in the round by slip stitching first and last chains together. Place Stitch Marker.
This pattern is worked in continuous rounds. Move stitch marker up with each round.
Round 1: Single Crochet into each stitch around. ( 60 total sts)
Continue to Single Crochet each round until your piece measures approx. 6.25 inches ( 15.75 cm )
from the starting edge.
Then move on to decreases.
Decreases:
Round 1: *SC2tog, SC4* Repeat around (50 total sts)
Round 2: *SC2tog, SC3* Repeat around (40 total sts)
Round 3: *SC2tog, SC2* Repeat around ( 30 total sts)
Round 4: *SC2tog, SC1* Repeat around ( 20 total sts)
Round 5: *SC2tog* Repeat around (10 total sts)
Round 6: *SC2tog* Repeat around (5 total sts)
Continue to SC2tog until the hole at the top of your hat is closed. Cut yarn with an approx. 7 inch yarn tail. Use your yarn or tapestry needle to secure the top hole, and secure and weave in all ends.
Gently roll approx. . 5 inches ( 1.25 cm ) of your brim up.

## Antler Pattern

Chain 8 with color 2 yarn (leave an approx. 12 inch ( 30.5 cm ) yarn tail)
Join in the round by slip stitching first and last chains together. Place Stitch Marker.
This pattern is worked in continuous rounds. Move stitch marker up with each round.
Round 1: Single Crochet into each stitch around (8 total sts)
Continue to Single Crochet each round until your piece measures approx. 3.5 inches ( 8.75 cm ) from the starting edge.
Cut your yarn with an approx. 12 inch yarn tail. Secure your last stitch, and use your yarn needle to pick up each of your last stitches and cinch the tip of your antler. Use yarn needle to pull yarn tail to inside, tie a knot, and weave in the end.
Use your starting yarn tail to secure your antler to the upper side of your hat, facing directly out. Insert your hook through the uppermost stitch on your antler approx. .75 inches ( 2 cm ) from the outer edge, and pick up your yarn. This is the start of your outer antler tip.
Pick up two sts towards the base of your hat, and then turn to work the opposite direction, picking up three more sts for a total of 5 stitches.
Work these 5 sts with single crochet in the round until your outer antler tip measures approx. . 75 inches ( 2 cm ) tall. Use your yarn needle to cinch the tip like you did previously.
Repeat this process for the inner antler tip approx. . 5 inch ( 1.25 cm ) towards the base of the hat. Repeat the whole process for the second antler.

## 3-10 Year Hat Pattern

Chain 64 with color 1 yarn
Join in the round by slip stitching first and last chains together. Place Stitch Marker.
This pattern is worked in continuous rounds. Move stitch marker up with each round.
Round 1: Single Crochet into each stitch around. (64 total sts)
Continue to Single Crochet each round until your piece measures approx. 6.5 inches ( 16.5 cm ) from the starting edge.
Then move on to decreases.
Decreases:
Round 1: *SC2tog, SC6* Repeat around (56 total sts)
Round 2: *SC2tog, SC5* Repeat around (48 total sts)
Round 3: *SC2tog, SC4* Repeat around ( 40 total sts)
Round 4: *SC2tog, SC3* Repeat around ( 32 total sts)
Round 5: *SC2tog, SC2* Repeat around (24 total sts)
Round 6: *SC2tog, SC1* Repeat around (16 total sts)
Round 7: *SC2tog* Repeat around (8 total sts)
Continue to SC2tog until the hole at the top of your hat is closed. Cut yarn with an approx. 7 inch yarn tail. Use your yarn or tapestry needle to secure the top hole, and secure and weave in all ends.
Gently roll approx. . 5 inches ( 1.25 cm ) of your brim up.

## Antler Pattern

Chain 8 with color 2 yarn (leave an approx. 12 inch ( 30.5 cm ) yarn tail) Join in the round by slip stitching first and last chains together. Place Stitch Marker. This pattern is worked in continuous rounds. Move stitch marker up with each round.
Round 1: Single Crochet into each stitch around (8 total sts)
Continue to Single Crochet each round until your piece measures approx. 3.5 inches ( 8.75 cm ) from the starting edge.
Cut your yarn with an approx. 12 inch yarn tail. Secure your last stitch, and use your yarn needle to pick up each of your last stitches and cinch the tip of your antler. Use yarn needle to pull yarn tail to inside, tie a knot, and weave in the end.
Use your starting yarn tail to secure your antler to the upper side of your hat, facing directly out. Insert your hook through the uppermost stitch on your antler approx. 75 inches $(2 \mathrm{~cm})$ from the outer edge, and pick up your yarn. This is the start of your outer antler tip.
Pick up two sts towards the base of your hat, and then turn to work the opposite direction, picking up three more sts for a total of 5 stitches.
Work these 5 sts with single crochet in the round until your outer antler tip measures approx. . 75 inches ( 2 cm ) tall. Use your yarn needle to cinch the tip like you did previously.
Repeat this process for the inner antler tip approx. . 5 inch ( 1.25 cm ) towards the base of the hat. Repeat the whole process for the second antler.
