

Vintage Bonnet Knitting Pattern



Materials:

- Yarn: Approximately 60 yards of worsted (4) yarn for smaller sizes, and approx. 80 yards for larger sizes (I used Lamb's Pride SuperWash)
- Knitting Needles: Size 5 mm (US 8) (Or size needed to obtain gauge) Straight Needles and Double Pointed Needles (DPNs) or use the Magic Loop Method
- Yarn or Tapestry Needle
- 1.5 Yards of Ribbon Lace, Sewing Needle and Thread
- Approx. 8 Pearl Beads

Abbreviations:

- P5togM5: Purl 5 together (without dropping sts from left needle) and make 5 all in the same stitch. See my video at: <http://www.youtube.com/watch?v=yYdFXCNdqQ0> for an in-depth explanation of this stitch.
- K2tog: Knit two stitches together
- **: Repeat the section in between the two stars as specified

Gauge:

10 sts and 14 rows = 2 inches (5 centimeters)
in stockinette stitch
It is important to check your gauge!

Average Head Circumference:

Newborn: 13-14"
0-3 Months: 14-15"
3-6 Months: 14-17"
6-12 Months: 16-19"
1-3 Years: 18-20"

Newborn Pattern

Cast on 57 sts onto straight needles

Row 1: K1, P55, K1

Row 2: P2, *P5togM5, P1* Repeat 8 more times, P1 (57 total sts)

Row 3: K1, P55, K1

Row 4: P1 (wrap your yarn two extra times), K55 (wrap yarn two extra times on each st), P1 (wrap yarn two extra times) (171 total sts)

Row 5: K1 (drop the two extra wraps from row 4), P55 (drop two extra wraps for each st), K1 (drop two extra wraps) (57 total sts)

Rows 6-13: Alternate between knitting and purling, knitting row 6

Row 14: K27, M1, K3, M1, K27 (59 total sts)

Row 15: Purl

Row 16: K27, M1, K5, M1, K27 (61 total sts)

Row 17: Purl

Row 18: K27, M1, K7, M1, K27 (63 total sts)

Row 19: Purl

Row 20: K27, M1, K9, M1, K27 (65 total sts)

Row 21: Purl

Row 22: K27, M1, K11, M1, K27 (67 total sts)

Row 23: Purl

Row 24: K27, K2tog, K9, K2tog, K27 (65 total sts)

Row 25: Purl

Row 26: K27, K2tog, K7, K2tog, K27 (63 total sts)

Row 27: Purl

Row 28: K27, K2tog, K5, K2tog, K27 (61 total sts)

Row 29: Purl

Row 30: K27, K2tog, K3, K2tog, K27 (59 total sts)

Move to Double Pointed Needles, Join in the round and place stitch marker

Round 1: *K2tog, K4* Repeat 8 more times, K2tog, K3 (49 total sts)

Round 2: *K2tog, K3* Repeat 8 more times, K2tog, K2 (39 total sts)

Round 3: *K2tog, K2* Repeat 8 more times, K2tog, K1 (29 total sts)

Round 4: *K2tog, K1* Repeat 8 more times, K2tog (19 total sts)

Do not bind off. Cut approx. 7 inch tail. Using yarn needle, remove all sts from DPNs or magic loop, as if to purl. Pull tail through sts to cinch the back of hat. Using yarn needle, pull tail through to the inside of the hat. Tie a knot and weave in ends. See instructions for flower at the end of pattern.

Cut two strands of yarn and one strand of lace approx. 20 inches long and pull them in a loop through the tip of one earflap. Pull the ends of the yarn through this loop (this attaches the yarn without any knots, and makes your project look smoother). Separate the yarn into three sections and braid them to desired length. Secure and cut yarn evenly on the ends. Repeat on the other earflap as well.

0-3 Month Pattern

Cast on 63 sts onto straight needles

Row 1: K1, P61, K1

Row 2: P2, *P5togM5, P1* Repeat 9 more times, P1 (63 total sts)

Row 3: K1, P61, K1

Row 4: P1 (wrap your yarn two extra times), K61 (wrap yarn two extra times on each st), P1 (wrap yarn two extra times) (189 total sts)

Row 5: K1 (drop the two extra wraps from row 4), P61 (drop two extra wraps for each st), K1 (drop two extra wraps) (63 total sts)

Rows 6-17: Alternate between knitting and purling, knitting row 6

Row 18: K30, M1, K3, M1, K30 (65 total sts)

Row 19: Purl

Row 20: K30, M1, K5, M1, K30 (67 total sts)

Row 21: Purl

Row 22: K30, M1, K7, M1, K30 (69 total sts)

Row 23: Purl

Row 24: K30, M1, K9, M1, K30 (71 total sts)

Row 25: Purl

Row 26: K30, M1, K11, M1, K30 (73 total sts)

Row 27: Purl

Row 28: K30, K2tog, K9, K2tog, K30 (71 total sts)

Row 29: Purl

Row 30: K30, K2tog, K7, K2tog, K30 (69 total sts)

Row 31: Purl

Row 32: K30, K2tog, K5, K2tog, K30 (67 total sts)

Row 33: Purl

Row 34: K30, K2tog, K3, K2tog, K30 (65 total sts)

Move to Double Pointed Needles, Join in the round and place stitch marker

Round 1: K2tog, K9, K2tog, K9, K2tog, K8, K2tog, K9, K2tog, K9, K2tog, K9 (59 total sts)

Round 2: *K2tog, K4* Repeat 8 more times, K2tog, K3 (49 total sts)

Round 3: *K2tog, K3* Repeat 8 more times, K2tog, K2 (39 total sts)

Round 4: *K2tog, K2* Repeat 8 more times, K2tog, K1 (29 total sts)

Round 5: *K2tog, K1* Repeat 8 more times, K2tog (19 total sts)

Do not bind off. Cut approx. 7 inch tail. Using yarn needle, remove all sts from DPNs or magic loop, as if to purl. Pull tail through sts to cinch the back of hat. Using yarn needle, pull tail through to the inside of the hat. Tie a knot and weave in ends. See instructions for flower at the end of pattern.

Cut two strands of yarn and one strand of lace approx. 20 inches long and pull them in a loop through the tip of one earflap. Pull the ends of the yarn through this loop (this attaches the yarn without any knots, and makes your project look smoother). Separate the yarn into three sections and braid them to desired length. Secure and cut yarn evenly on the ends. Repeat on the other earflap as well.

3-6 Month Pattern

Cast on 69 sts onto straight needles

Row 1: K1, P67, K1

Row 2: P2, *P5togM5, P1* Repeat 10 more times, P1 (69 total sts)

Row 3: K1, P67, K1

Row 4: P1 (wrap your yarn two extra times), K67 (wrap yarn two extra times on each st), P1 (wrap yarn two extra times) (207 total sts)

Row 5: K1 (drop the two extra wraps from row 4), P67 (drop two extra wraps for each st), K1 (drop two extra wraps) (69 total sts)

Rows 6-23: Alternate between knitting and purling, knitting row 6

Row 24: K33, M1, K3, M1, K33 (71 total sts)

Row 25: Purl

Row 26: K33, M1, K5, M1, K33 (73 total sts)

Row 27: Purl

Row 28: K33, M1, K7, M1, K33 (75 total sts)

Row 29: Purl

Row 30: K33, M1, K9, M1, K33 (77 total sts)

Row 31: Purl

Row 32: K33, M1, K11, M1, K33 (79 total sts)

Row 33: Purl

Row 34: K33, K2tog, K9, K2tog, K33 (77 total sts)

Row 35: Purl

Row 36: K33, K2tog, K7, K2tog, K33 (75 total sts)

Row 37: Purl

Row 38: K33, K2tog, K5, K2tog, K33 (73 total sts)

Row 39: Purl

Row 40: K33, K2tog, K3, K2tog, K33 (71 total sts)

Move to Double Pointed Needles, Join in the round and place stitch marker

Round 1: K2tog, K33, K2tog, K34 (69 total sts)

Round 2: *K2tog, K5* Repeat 8 more times, K2tog, K4 (59 total sts)

Round 3: *K2tog, K4* Repeat 8 more times, K2tog, K3 (49 total sts)

Round 4: *K2tog, K3* Repeat 8 more times, K2tog, K2 (39 total sts)

Round 5: *K2tog, K2* Repeat 8 more times, K2tog, K1 (29 total sts)

Round 6: *K2tog, K1* Repeat 8 more times, K2tog (19 total sts)

Do not bind off. Cut approx. 7 inch tail. Using yarn needle, remove all sts from DPNs or magic loop, as if to purl. Pull tail through sts to cinch the back of hat. Using yarn needle, pull tail through to the inside of the hat. Tie a knot and weave in ends. See instructions for flower at the end of pattern.

Cut two strands of yarn and one strand of lace approx. 20 inches long and pull them in a loop through the tip of one earflap. Pull the ends of the yarn through this loop (this attaches the yarn without any knots, and makes your project look smoother). Separate the yarn into three sections and braid them to desired length. 6-12 Month Pattern

Cast on 81 sts onto straight needles

Row 1: K1, P79, K1

Row 2: P2, *P5togM5, P1* Repeat 12 more times, P1 (81 total sts)

Row 3: K1, P79, K1

Row 4: P1 (wrap your yarn two extra times), K79 (wrap yarn two extra times on each st), P1 (wrap yarn two extra times) (243 total sts)

Row 5: K1 (drop the two extra wraps from row 4), P79 (drop two extra wraps for each st), K1 (drop two extra wraps) (81 total sts)

Rows 6-29: Alternate between knitting and purling, knitting row 6

Row 30: K39, M1, K3, M1, K39 (83 total sts)

Row 31: Purl

Row 32: K39, M1, K5, M1, K39 (85 total sts)

Row 33: Purl

Row 34: K39, M1, K7, M1, K39 (87 total sts)

Row 35: Purl

Row 36: K39, M1, K9, M1, K39 (89 total sts)

Row 37: Purl

Row 38: K39, M1, K11, M1, K39 (91 total sts)

Row 39: Purl

Row 40: K39, K2tog, K9, K2tog, K39 (89 total sts)

Row 41: Purl

Row 42: K39, K2tog, K7, K2tog, K39 (87 total sts)

Row 43: Purl

Row 44: K39, K2tog, K5, K2tog, K39 (85 total sts)

Row 45: Purl

Row 46: K39, K2tog, K3, K2tog, K39 (83 total sts)

Move to Double Pointed Needles, Join in the round and place stitch marker

Round 1: K2tog, K18, K2tog, K19, K2tog, K19, K2tog, K19 (79 total sts)

Round 2: *K2tog, K6* Repeat 8 more times, K2tog, K5 (69 total sts)

Round 3: *K2tog, K5* Repeat 8 more times, K2tog, K4 (59 total sts)

Round 4: *K2tog, K4* Repeat 8 more times, K2tog, K3 (49 total sts)

Round 5: *K2tog, K3* Repeat 8 more times, K2tog, K2 (39 total sts)

Round 6: *K2tog, K2* Repeat 8 more times, K2tog, K1 (29 total sts)

Round 7: *K2tog, K1* Repeat 8 more times, K2tog (19 total sts)

Do not bind off. Cut approx. 7 inch tail. Using yarn needle, remove all sts from DPNs or magic loop, as if to purl. Pull tail through sts to cinch the back of hat. Using yarn needle, pull tail through to the inside of the hat. Tie a knot and weave in ends. See instructions for flower at the end of pattern.

12 Month – 3 Year Pattern

Cast on 87 sts onto straight needles

Row 1: K1, P85, K1

Row 2: P2, *P5togM5, P1* Repeat 13 more times, P1 (87 total sts)

Row 3: K1, P85, K1

Row 4: P1 (wrap your yarn two extra times), K85 (wrap yarn two extra times on each st), P1 (wrap yarn two extra times) (261 total sts)

Row 5: K1 (drop the two extra wraps from row 4), P85 (drop two extra wraps for each st), K1 (drop two extra wraps) (87 total sts)

Rows 6-33: Alternate between knitting and purling, knitting row 6

Row 34: K42, M1, K3, M1, K42 (89 total sts)

Row 35: Purl

Row 36: K42, M1, K5, M1, K42 (91 total sts)

Row 37: Purl

Row 38: K42, M1, K7, M1, K42 (93 total sts)

Row 39: Purl

Row 40: K42, M1, K9, M1, K42 (95 total sts)

Row 41: Purl

Row 42: K42, M1, K11, M1, K42 (97 total sts)

Row 43: Purl

Row 44: K42, K2tog, K9, K2tog, K42 (95 total sts)

Row 45: Purl

Row 46: K42, K2tog, K7, K2tog, K42 (93 total sts)

Row 47: Purl

Row 48: K42, K2tog, K5, K2tog, K42 (91 total sts)

Row 49: Purl

Row 50: K42, K2tog, K3, K2tog, K42 (89 total sts)

Move to Double Pointed Needles, Join in the round and place stitch marker

Round 1: *K2tog, K7* Repeat 8 more times, K2tog, K6 (79 total sts)

Round 2: *K2tog, K6* Repeat 8 more times, K2tog, K5 (69 total sts)

Round 3: *K2tog, K5* Repeat 8 more times, K2tog, K4 (59 total sts)

Round 4: *K2tog, K4* Repeat 8 more times, K2tog, K3 (49 total sts)

Round 5: *K2tog, K3* Repeat 8 more times, K2tog, K2 (39 total sts)

Round 6: *K2tog, K2* Repeat 8 more times, K2tog, K1 (29 total sts)

Round 7: *K2tog, K1* Repeat 8 more times, K2tog (19 total sts)

Do not bind off. Cut approx. 7 inch tail. Using yarn needle, remove all sts from DPNs or magic loop, as if to purl. Pull tail through sts to cinch the back of hat. Using yarn needle, pull tail through to the inside of the hat. Tie a knot and weave in ends. See instructions for flower at the end of pattern.

Cut two strands of yarn and one strand of lace approx. 20 inches long and pull them in a loop through the tip of one earflap. Flower



Materials: 1 yard lace, Needle and thread, Approx. 8 pearls, Measuring Tape (Not required, but helpful)



Fold the end of the lace over itself to 2 inches



Extend the lace two inches past the fold



Fold at a 45 degree angle at the center



Fold lace over itself again at 2 inches from the last fold



Fold over itself again at 4 inches from the last fold
Fold back to the center and fold at another 45 degree angle



Fold yarn again and take it 4 inches straight across



Wrap the remaining lace under the flower and cut the lace tail



Use your sewing needle and thread to sew the center down into position



Then use your sewing needle to pinch the base of each flower





Sew approx. 8 pearl beads into the center of the flower and then sew the flower onto the side of your hat.

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
