

Veronica Meets Spring Boho Bracelet Crochet Pattern



Materials:

- Yarn: Approximately 20 Yards of Worsted (4) yarn in 2 coordinating colors.

Color 1: Approx. 11 Yards

Color 2: Approx. 9 Yards

Note – I do crochet tightly. If you are a loose crocheter, you may consider going down to a DK (3) weight yarn

- Crochet Hook: Size 5.0 mm (H)
- Yarn or Tapestry Needle

Gauge:

9 sts and 10 rows = 2 inches (5 centimeters)
in Single Crochet

It is important to check your gauge!

Abbreviations:

- SC: Single Crochet
- CH: Chain
- FPTRC: Front Post Triple Crochet
- FPTRC2tog: Front Post Triple Crochet decrease (decrease the two specified sts)
- **: Repeat the section in between the two stars as specified

****When working this pattern, all color changes are designated by the color # in () after the stitch. Color changes should be completed by using the new color as the last yarn over in the previous stitch.****

Bracelet Pattern

Chain 26 using Color 1 yarn

Row 1: SC into the second chain from hook and each chain across, CH1, Turn Work (25 total sts not including turning chain)

Row 2: SC into each stitch across, CH1, Turn Work

Pick up Color 2 yarn in preparation for Row 3. You'll be alternating between Colors 1&2 for Row 3.

Row 3: SC into each of the next 2 sts (Color 1), FPTRC around very first stitch in Row 1 (Color 2), Skip next stitch, SC into each of the next 3 sts (Color 1), Go to Row 1 and skip 7 sts after your last FPTRC stitch, FPTRC around the next stitch in Row 1 (Color 2), Skip next stitch, *SC into each of the next 3 sts (Color 1), FPTRC around the same stitch you did last FPTRC into (Color 2), Skip next stitch, SC into each of the next 3 sts, Go to Row 1 and skip 7 sts after your last FPTRC stitch, FPTRC around the next stitch in Row 1 (Color 2), Skip next stitch* Repeat one more time, SC into each of the last 2 sts (Color 1), CH1, Turn Work (25 total sts not including turning chain)

Drop Color 2 yarn (do not cut) and use Color 1 only for the following rows

Rows 4-6: SC into each stitch across, CH1, Turn Work

Pick up Color 2 yarn in preparation for Row 7. You'll be alternating between Colors 1&2 for Row 7.

Row 7: SC into each of the next 4 sts (Color 1), FPTRC2tog (Color 2) (Insert your hook around the top of the FPTRC sts you did below this stitch in Row 3 to bring them to a point), Skip next stitch, *SC into each of the next 7 sts (Color 1), FPTRC2tog (Color 2) (Insert your hook around the top of the FPTRC sts you did below this stitch in Row 3 to bring them to a point), Skip next stitch* Repeat one more time, SC into each of last 4 sts (Color 1) (25 total sts not including turning chain)

Fasten off. Secure and weave in all ends.

Cut 4 pieces of Color 2 yarn approx. 6 inches (15.25cm) each.

Take one strand and fold in half. Insert the folded section through one corner of your bracelet. Pull the ends through the loop that was created and pull tight. Repeat for all 4 corners. You've now seamlessly attached your strands to the bracelet to act as ties.

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
