## Snowflake Pants and Beanie Set Knitting Pattern



Materials:

- Yarn: Approximately 200 yards of worsted (4) yarn for smaller sizes, and approx. 325 yards for larger sizes. You will need approx. 40 yards of color 2 for smaller sizes and approx. 60 yards for larger sizes (I used Paton's Classic Wool Worsted)
- Knitting Needles: Size 5.5 mm (US 9) Double Pointed Needles (or use the magic loop method)
- Yarn or Tapestry Needle


## Abbreviations:

- BO: Bind Off
- CO: Cast On
- K2tog: Knit two stitches together
-**: Repeat the section in between the two stars as specified

Gauge:
10 sts and 14 rows = 2 inches ( 5 centimeters) in stockinette stitch

Average Head Circumference:
Newborn: 13-14"
0-3 Months: 14-15"
3-6 Months: $14-17$ "
6-12 Months: 16-19"

## Newborn Pants Pattern - Should measure approx. 12" (30.5cm) in circumference and approx. 10" ( 25.5 cm ) in length

CO 60 sts with color 1 (white) yarn onto double pointed needles (or use the magic loop method) Join in the round and place stitch marker
Rounds 1-12: *K2, P2* Repeat around
Round 13-15: Knit
Pick up color 2 yarn (grey). You are going to be alternating between the two color for the next rounds. Loosely carry the unused color behind your work until picking it back up.
Round 16: *K1 (grey), K3 (white)* Repeat around
Round 17: K2 (grey), K1 (white), *K3 (grey), K1 (white)* Repeat 13 more times, K1 (grey)
Round 18: Repeat round 16
Round 19: K2 (white), *K1 (grey), K3 (white)* Repeat 13 more times, K1 (grey), K1 (white)
Round 20: *K1 (white), K3 (grey)* Repeat around
Round 21: Repeat round 19
Rounds 22-27: Repeat rounds 16-21
Rounds 28-33: Repeat rounds 16-21
Rounds 34-39: Repeat rounds 16-21
Round 40: *K1 (grey), K3 (white)* Repeat 6 more times, K1 (grey), K1 (white)
Place the other 30 stitches from round 40 on a stitch holder.
Join the first 30 stitches in the round and place stitch marker.
Round 1: K2 (grey), K1 (white), *K3 (grey), K1 (white)* Repeat 5 more times, K3 (grey)
Round 2: *K1 (grey), K3 (white)* Repeat 6 more times, K1 (grey), K1 (white)
Round 3: K2 (white), *K1 (grey), K3 (white)* Repeat 6 more times
Round 4: *K1 (white), K3 (grey)* Repeat 6 more times, K1 (white), K1 (grey)
Round 5: Repeat round 3
Round 6: *K1 (grey), K3 (white)* Repeat 6 more times, K1 (grey), K1 (white)
Rounds 7-11: Repeat rounds 1-5
Round 12: Repeat round 6
Rounds 13-17: Repeat rounds 1-5
Round 18: Repeat round 6
Rounds 19-23: Repeat rounds 1-5
Drop and cut color 2 yarn.
Rounds 24\&25: Knit
Round 26: K1, M1, K15, M1, K14 (32 total sts)
Rounds 27-33: *K2, P2* Repeat around
Bind off in pattern.
Place the 30 stitches you had on a stitch holder onto your DPNs. Pick up a new strand of yarn
(leave an approx. $7^{\prime \prime}$ ( 17.75 cm ) yarn tail to use to seam crotch later)
Join in the round and place stitch marker.
Round 1: K2 (white), *K1 (grey), K3 (white)* Repeat 6 more times
Round 2: *K1 (white), K3 (grey)* Repeat 6 more times, K1 (white), K1 (grey)
Round 3: Repeat round 1
Round 4: *K1 (grey), K3 (white)* Repeat 6 more times, K1 (grey), K1 (white)
Round 5: K2 (grey), K1 (white), *K3 (grey), K1 (white)* Repeat 5 more times, K3 (grey)
Round 6: Repeat round 4
Rounds 7-12: Repeat rounds 1-6
Rounds 13-18: Repeat rounds 1-6
Rounds 19-24: Repeat rounds 1-6
Drop and cut color 2 yarn.

Rounds 25\&26: Knit
Round 27: K1, M1, K15, M1, K14 (32 total sts)
Rounds 28-34: *K2, P2* Repeat around
Bind off in pattern.
Cut yarn and weave in ends. Using your yarn tail from earlier on and your yarn needle, seam up the crotch section as needed.

## Newborn Hat Pattern

Cast on 60 sts with Color 1 yarn (white) onto Double Pointed Needles (or use the magic loop method)
Join in the round and place stitch marker
Rounds 1-7: *K2, P2* Repeat around
Round 8-11: Knit
Pick up color 2 yarn (grey). You are going to be alternating between the two color for the next three rounds. Loosely carry the unused color behind your work until picking it back up.
Round 12: *K1 (grey), K3 (white)* Repeat around
Round 13: K2 (grey), K1 (white), *K3 (grey), K1 (white)* Repeat 13 more times, K1 (grey)
Round 14: Repeat round 12
Drop and cut color 2 yarn
Round 15: Knit
Continue to knit each round until your piece measures approx. $3.5^{\prime \prime}(9 \mathrm{~cm})$ from the cast on edge.
Decreases:
Round 1: *K2tog, K10* Repeat around (55 total sts)
Round 2: *K2tog, K9* Repeat around ( 50 total sts)
Round 3: *K2tog, K8* Repeat around (45 total sts)
Round 4: *K2tog, K7* Repeat around (40 total sts)
Round 5: *K2tog, K6* Repeat around (35 total sts)
Round 6: *K2tog, K5* Repeat around (30 total sts)
Round 7: *K2tog, K4* Repeat around ( 25 total sts)
Round 8: *K2tog, K3* Repeat around (20 total sts)
Round 9: *K2tog, K2* Repeat around (15 total sts)
Round 10: *K2tog, K1* Repeat around (10 total sts)
Round 11: *K2tog* Repeat around (5 total sts)
Do not bind off. Cut approx. 7 inch tail. Using yarn needle, remove all sts from DPNs or magic loop, as if to purl. Pull tail through to cinch the top of hat. Using yarn needle, pull tail through to the inside of the hat. Tie a knot and secure and weave in all ends.

## 0-3 Month Pants Pattern - Should measure approx. 13" (33cm) in circumference and approx. 11" $(28 \mathrm{~cm})$ in length

CO 64 sts with color 1 (white) yarn onto double pointed needles (or use the magic loop method) Join in the round and place stitch marker
Rounds 1-12: *K2, P2* Repeat around
Round 13-15: Knit
Pick up color 2 yarn (grey). You are going to be alternating between the two color for the next rounds. Loosely carry the unused color behind your work until picking it back up.
Round 16: *K1 (grey), K3 (white)* Repeat around
Round 17: K2 (grey), K1 (white), *K3 (grey), K1 (white)* Repeat 14 more times, K1 (grey)
Round 18: Repeat round 16
Round 19: K2 (white), *K1 (grey), K3 (white)* Repeat 14 more times, K1 (grey), K1 (white)
Round 20: *K1 (white), K3 (grey)* Repeat around
Round 21: Repeat round 19
Rounds 22-27: Repeat rounds 16-21
Rounds 28-33: Repeat rounds 16-21
Rounds 34-39: Repeat rounds 16-21
Round 40: *K1 (grey), K3 (white)* Repeat 7 more times
Place the other 32 stitches from round 40 on a stitch holder.
Join the first 32 stitches in the round and place stitch marker.
Round 1: K2 (grey), K1 (white), *K3 (grey), K1 (white)* Repeat 6 more times, K1 (grey)
Round 2: *K1 (grey), K3 (white)* Repeat around
Round 3: K2 (white), *K1 (grey), K3 (white)* Repeat 6 more times, K1 (grey), K1 (white)
Round 4: *K1 (white), K3 (grey)* Repeat around
Round 5: Repeat round 3
Round 6: *K1 (grey), K3 (white)* Repeat around
Rounds 7-11: Repeat rounds 1-5
Round 12: Repeat round 6
Rounds 13-17: Repeat rounds 1-5
Round 18: Repeat round 6
Rounds 19-23: Repeat rounds 1-5
Drop and cut color 2 yarn.
Rounds 24-26: Knit

Bind off in pattern.
Place the 32 stitches you had on a stitch holder onto your DPNs. Pick up a new strand of yarn (leave an approx. $7^{\prime \prime}(17.75 \mathrm{~cm})$ yarn tail to use to seam crotch later)
Join in the round and place stitch marker.
Round 1: *K1 (grey), K3 (white)* Repeat around
Round 2: K2 (grey), *K1, (white), K3 (grey)* Repeat 6 more times, K1 (white), K1 (grey)
Round 3: Repeat round 1
Round 4: K2 (white), *K1 (grey), K3 (white)* Repeat 6 more times, K1 (grey), K1 (white)
Round 5: *K1 (white), K3 (grey)* Repeat around
Round 6: Repeat round 4
Rounds 7-12: Repeat rounds 1-6
Rounds 13-18: Repeat rounds 1-6
Rounds 19-24: Repeat rounds 1-6
Drop and cut color 2 yarn.

Rounds 28-34: *K2, P2* Repeat around

Bind off in pattern.
Cut yarn and weave in ends. Using your yarn tail from earlier on and your yarn needle, seam up the crotch section as needed.

## 0-3 Month Hat Pattern

Cast on 64 sts with Color 1 yarn (white) onto Double Pointed Needles (or use the magic loop method)
Join in the round and place stitch marker
Rounds 1-7: *K2, P2* Repeat around
Round 8-11: Knit
Pick up color 2 yarn (grey). You are going to be alternating between the two color for the next three rounds. Loosely carry the unused color behind your work until picking it back up.
Round 12: *K1 (grey), K3 (white)* Repeat around
Round 13: K2 (grey), K1 (white), *K3 (grey), K1 (white)* Repeat 14 more times, K1 (grey)
Round 14: Repeat round 12
Drop and cut color 2 yarn
Round 15: Knit
Continue to knit each round until your piece measures approx. 3.75 " $(9.5 \mathrm{~cm})$ from the cast on edge.
Decreases:
Round 1: *K2tog, K14* Repeat around ( 60 total sts)
Round 2: *K2tog, K10* Repeat around (55 total sts)
Round 3: *K2tog, K9* Repeat around (50 total sts)
Round 4: *K2tog, K8* Repeat around (45 total sts)
Round 5: *K2tog, K7* Repeat around (40 total sts)
Round 6: *K2tog, K6* Repeat around ( 35 total sts)
Round 7: *K2tog, K5* Repeat around (30 total sts)
Round 8: *K2tog, K4* Repeat around ( 25 total sts)
Round 9: *K2tog, K3* Repeat around (20 total sts)
Round 10: *K2tog, K2* Repeat around (15 total sts)
Round 11: *K2tog, K1* Repeat around (10 total sts)
Round 12: *K2tog* Repeat around (5 total sts)
Do not bind off. Cut approx. 7 inch tail. Using yarn needle, remove all sts from DPNs or magic loop, as if to purl. Pull tail through to cinch the top of hat. Using yarn needle, pull tail through to the inside of the hat. Tie a knot and secure and weave in all ends.

## 3-6 Month Pants Pattern - Should measure approx. 15" (38cm) in circumference and approx. 12" ( 30.5 cm ) in length

CO 72 sts with color 1 (white) yarn onto double pointed needles (or use the magic loop method) Join in the round and place stitch marker
Rounds 1-16: *K2, P2* Repeat around
Round 17-19: Knit
Pick up color 2 yarn (grey). You are going to be alternating between the two color for the next rounds. Loosely carry the unused color behind your work until picking it back up.
Round 20: *K1 (grey), K3 (white)* Repeat around
Round 21: K2 (grey), K1 (white), *K3 (grey), K1 (white)* Repeat 16 more times, K1 (grey)
Round 22: Repeat round 20
Round 23: K2 (white), *K1 (grey), K3 (white)* Repeat 16 more times, K1 (grey), K1 (white)
Round 24: *K1 (white), K3 (grey)* Repeat around
Round 25: Repeat round 23
Rounds 26-31: Repeat rounds 20-25
Rounds 32-37: Repeat rounds 20-25
Rounds 38-43: Repeat rounds 20-25

Round 2: K2 (grey), K1 (white), *K3 (grey), K1 (white)* Repeat 7 more times, K1 (grey)
Round 3: Repeat round 1

## 3-6 Month Hat Pattern

Cast on 72 sts with Color 1 yarn (white) onto Double Pointed Needles (or use the magic loop method)
Join in the round and place stitch marker
Rounds 1-7: *K2, P2* Repeat around
Round 8-11: Knit
Pick up color 2 yarn (grey). You are going to be alternating between the two color for the next three rounds. Loosely carry the unused color behind your work until picking it back up.
Round 12: *K1 (grey), K3 (white)* Repeat around
Round 13: K2 (grey), K1 (white), *K3 (grey), K1 (white)* Repeat 16 more times, K1 (grey)
Round 14: Repeat round 12
Drop and cut color 2 yarn
Round 15: Knit
Continue to knit each round until your piece measures approx. 4 " $(10.25 \mathrm{~cm})$ from the cast on edge.
Decreases:
Round 1: *K2tog, K34* Repeat around (70 total sts)
Round 2: *K2tog, K12* Repeat around ( 65 total sts)
Round 3: *K2tog, K11* Repeat around ( 60 total sts)
Round 4: *K2tog, K10* Repeat around ( 55 total sts)
Round 5: *K2tog, K9* Repeat around (50 total sts)
Round 6: *K2tog, K8* Repeat around (45 total sts)
Round 7: *K2tog, K7* Repeat around (40 total sts)
Round 8: *K2tog, K6* Repeat around ( 35 total sts)
Round 9: *K2tog, K5* Repeat around (30 total sts)
Round 10: *K2tog, K4* Repeat around ( 25 total sts)

## 6-12 Month Pants Pattern - Should measure approx. 17" (43.25cm) in circumference and approx. 14 " ( 35.5 cm ) in length

CO 84 sts with color 1 (white) yarn onto double pointed needles (or use the magic loop method)
Join in the round and place stitch marker
Rounds 1-16: *K2, P2* Repeat around
Round 17-19: Knit
Pick up color 2 yarn (grey). You are going to be alternating between the two color for the next rounds. Loosely carry the unused color behind your work until picking it back up.
Round 20: *K1 (grey), K3 (white)* Repeat around
Round 21: K2 (grey), K1 (white), *K3 (grey), K1 (white)* Repeat 19 more times, K1 (grey)
Round 22: Repeat round 20
Round 23: K2 (white), *K1 (grey), K3 (white)* Repeat 19 more times, K1 (grey), K1 (white)
Round 24: *K1 (white), K3 (grey)* Repeat around
Round 25: Repeat round 23
Rounds 26-31: Repeat rounds 20-25
Rounds 32-37: Repeat rounds 20-25
Rounds 38-43: Repeat rounds 20-25
Rounds 44-49: Repeat rounds 20-25
Rounds 50-55: Repeat rounds 20-25
Round 56: *K1 (grey), K3 (white)* Repeat 9 more times, K1 (grey), K1 (white)
Place the other 42 stitches from round 56 on a stitch holder.
Join the first 42 stitches in the round and place stitch marker.

Round 2: *K1 (white), K3 (grey)* Repeat 9 more times, K1 (white), K1 (grey)
Round 3: Repeat round 1
Round 4: *K1 (grey), K3 (white)* Repeat 9 more times, K1 (grey), K1 (white)
Round 5: K2 (grey), *K1 (white), K3 (grey)* Repeat around

Round 6: Repeat round 4
Rounds 7-12: Repeat rounds 1-6
Rounds 13-18: Repeat rounds 1-6
Rounds 19-24: Repeat rounds 1-6
Rounds 25-30: Repeat rounds 1-6
Rounds 31-36: Repeat rounds 1-6
Drop and cut color 2 yarn.
Rounds 37\&38: Knit
Round 39: K1, M1, K21, M1, K20 (44 total sts)
Rounds 40-46: *K2, P2* Repeat around
Bind off in pattern.
Cut yarn and weave in ends. Using your yarn tail from earlier on and your yarn needle, seam up the crotch section as needed.

## 6-12 Month Hat Pattern

Cast on 84 sts with Color 1 yarn (white) onto Double Pointed Needles (or use the magic loop method)
Join in the round and place stitch marker
Rounds 1-7: *K2, P2* Repeat around
Round 8-11: Knit
Pick up color 2 yarn (grey). You are going to be alternating between the two color for the next three rounds. Loosely carry the unused color behind your work until picking it back up.
Round 12: *K1 (grey), K3 (white)* Repeat around
Round 13: K2 (grey), K1 (white), *K3 (grey), K1 (white)* Repeat 19 more times, K1 (grey)
Round 14: Repeat round 12
Drop and cut color 2 yarn
Round 15: Knit
Continue to knit each round until your piece measures approx. $4.25^{\prime \prime}$ ( 10.75 cm ) from the cast on edge.
Decreases:
Round 1: *K2tog, K19* Repeat around (80 total sts)
Round 2: *K2tog, K14* Repeat around ( 75 total sts)
Round 3: *K2tog, K13* Repeat around ( 70 total sts)
Round 4: *K2tog, K12* Repeat around ( 65 total sts)
Round 5: *K2tog, K11* Repeat around ( 60 total sts)
Round 6: *K2tog, K10* Repeat around ( 55 total sts)
Round 7: *K2tog, K9* Repeat around (50 total sts)
Round 8: *K2tog, K8* Repeat around (45 total sts)
Round 9: *K2tog, K7* Repeat around (40 total sts)
Round 10: *K2tog, K6* Repeat around ( 35 total sts)
Round 11: *K2tog, K5* Repeat around ( 30 total sts)
Round 12: *K2tog, K4* Repeat around ( 25 total sts)
Round 13: *K2tog, K3* Repeat around (20 total sts)
Round 14: *K2tog, K2* Repeat around ( 15 total sts)
Round 15: *K2tog, K1* Repeat around (10 total sts)
Round 16: *K2tog* Repeat around (5 total sts)
Do not bind off. Cut approx. 7 inch tail. Using yarn needle, remove all sts from DPNs or magic loop, as if to purl. Pull tail through to cinch the top of hat. Using yarn needle, pull tail through to the inside of the hat. Tie a knot and secure and weave in all ends.

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
