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## Twinkle Star Night Cap Knitting Pattern



### Materials:

- Yarn: Approximately 50 yards of worsted (4) yarn for smaller sizes, and approx. 90 yards for larger sizes (I used Brown Sheep Company's - Lamb's Pride Worsted).
- Knitting Needles: Size 5.0 mm (US 8) Double Pointed Needles (or use the magic loop method)
- Yarn or Tapestry Needle
- 1 Square of felt
- Sewing Needle and Thread

### Abbreviations:

- K2tog: Knit two stitches together
- \*\*: Repeat the section in between the two stars as specified

### Gauge:

10 sts and 14 rows = 2 inches (5 centimeters) in stockinette stitch  
\*\*\*It is important to check your gauge!\*\*\*

### Average Head Circumference:

Preemie: 11.5-13"  
Newborn: 13-14"  
0-3 Months: 14-15"  
3-6 Months: 14-17"  
6-12 Months: 16-19"  
1-3 Years: 18-20"  
3-10 Years: 19-20.5"

## **Preemie Pattern (approx. 5 lbs.)**

CO 44 sts onto Double Pointed Needles (or use the Magic Loop Method)

Join in the round and place stitch marker.

**Rounds 1-5:** \*K2, P2\* Repeat around

**Rounds 6-25:** Knit

**Round 26:** \*K2tog, K9\* Repeat around (40 total sts)

**Round 27:** Knit

**Round 28:** \*K2tog, K8\* Repeat around (36 total sts)

**Round 29:** Knit

**Round 30:** \*K2tog, K7\* Repeat around (32 total sts)

**Round 31:** Knit

**Round 32:** \*K2tog, K6\* Repeat around (28 total sts)

**Round 33:** Knit

**Round 34:** \*K2tog, K5\* Repeat around (24 total sts)

**Round 35:** Knit

**Round 36:** \*K2tog, K4\* Repeat around (20 total sts)

**Round 37:** Knit

**Round 38:** \*K2tog, K3\* Repeat around (16 total sts)

**Round 39:** Knit

**Round 40:** \*K2tog, K2\* Repeat around (12 total sts)

**Round 41:** Knit

Set aside

Braid six pieces of yarn together to approx. 4 inches. Tie a knot on either end. Return to your hat. Do not bind off. Cut approx. 7 inch tail. Using yarn needle, remove all sts from DPNs or magic loop, as if to purl. Place the braided piece inside the loop you have created at the top of the hat. Pull tail through to cinch the top of hat around the braid. Using yarn needle, pull tail through to the inside of the hat. Tie a knot and weave in ends. Cut out two felt stars – one slightly larger than the other (you can use the stars I have included at the end of the patterns to get an idea for sizing if you are using Microsoft Word). Using a sewing needle and thread, attach the larger star to the end of the braid, and the smaller star to the base of the hat.

## Newborn Pattern

CO 48 sts onto Double Pointed Needles (or use the Magic Loop Method)

Join in the round and place stitch marker.

**Rounds 1-5:** \*K2, P2\* Repeat around

**Rounds 6-25:** Knit

**Round 26:** \*K2tog, K10\* Repeat around (44 total sts)

**Round 27:** Knit

**Round 28:** \*K2tog, K9\* Repeat around (40 total sts)

**Round 29:** Knit

**Round 30:** \*K2tog, K8\* Repeat around (36 total sts)

**Round 31:** Knit

**Round 32:** \*K2tog, K7\* Repeat around (32 total sts)

**Round 33:** Knit

**Round 34:** \*K2tog, K6\* Repeat around (28 total sts)

**Round 35:** Knit

**Round 36:** \*K2tog, K5\* Repeat around (24 total sts)

**Round 37:** Knit

**Round 38:** \*K2tog, K4\* Repeat around (20 total sts)

CO 50 sts onto Double Pointed Needles (or use the Magic Loop Method)

Join in the round and place stitch marker.

**Rounds 1-5:** K2, \*P2, K2\* Repeat around

**Rounds 6-25:** Knit

**Round 26:** \*K2tog, K23\* Repeat around (48 total sts)

**Round 27:** Knit

**Round 28:** \*K2tog, K10\* Repeat around (44 total sts)

**Round 29:** Knit

**Round 30:** \*K2tog, K9\* Repeat around (40 total sts)

**Round 31:** Knit

**Round 32:** \*K2tog, K8\* Repeat around (36 total sts)

**Round 33:** Knit

**Round 34:** \*K2tog, K7\* Repeat around (32 total sts)

**Round 35:** Knit

**Round 36:** \*K2tog, K6\* Repeat around (28 total sts)

**Round 31:** Knit

**Round 32:** \*K2tog, K11\* Repeat around (48 total sts)

**Round 33:** Knit

**Round 34:** \*K2tog, K10\* Repeat around (44 total sts)

**Round 35:** Knit

**Round 36:** \*K2tog, K9\* Repeat around (40 total sts)

**Round 37:** Knit

**Round 38:** \*K2tog, K8\* Repeat around (36 total sts)

**Round 39:** Knit

**Round 27:** \*K2tog, K31\* Repeat around (64 total sts)

**Round 28:** \*K2tog, K14\* Repeat around (60 total sts)

**Round 29:** Knit

**Round 30:** \*K2tog, K13\* Repeat around (56 total sts)

**Round 31:** Knit

**Round 32:** \*K2tog, K12\* Repeat around (52 total sts)

**Round 33:** Knit

**Round 34:** \*K2tog, K11\* Repeat around (48 total sts)

**Round 35:** Knit

**Round 36:** \*K2tog, K10\* Repeat around (44 total sts)

**Round 30:** Knit

**Round 32:** Knit

**Round 33:** \*K2tog, K14\* Repeat around (60 total sts)

**Round 34:** Knit

**Round 35:** \*K2tog, K13\* Repeat around (56 total sts)

**Round 36:** Knit

**Round 37:** \*K2tog, K12\* Repeat around (52 total sts)

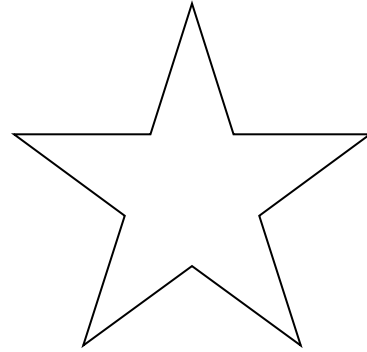
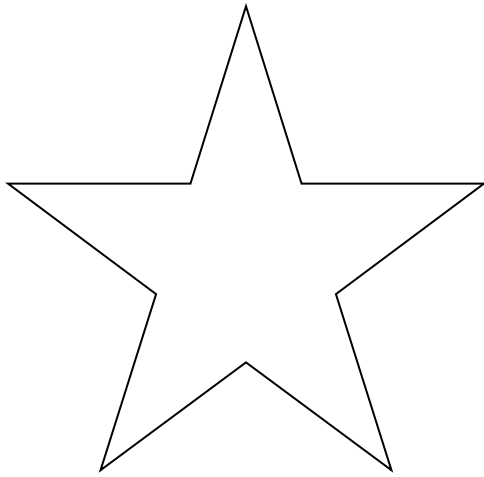
