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Swirl Sack Hat Knitting Pattern



Materials:

- Yarn: Approximately 60 yards of handspun thick and thin super bulky (6) weight yarn for smaller sizes, and approx. 140 yards for largest size
- Knitting Needles: Size 10.0 mm (US 15) Double Pointed Needles (DPNs) (or use the magic loop method) OR Use a circular needle with an overall length that is shorter than the circumference of the project you are working on (Ref. average head circumference chart below)
- 1 Medium or Large Button
- Yarn or Tapestry Needle

Abbreviations:

- **: Repeat the section in between the two stars as specified

Gauge:

9 sts and 18 rows = 4 inches (10 centimeters)
in stockinette stitch
It is important to check your gauge!

Average Head Circumference:

Newborn: 13-14"
0-3 Months: 14-15"
3-6 Months: 14-17"
6-12 Months: 16-19"
1-3 Years: 18-20"

Newborn Hat Pattern

Cast on 30 sts onto Double Pointed Needles (or use the magic loop method) or Circular Needles
Join in the round and place stitch marker

Rounds 1&2: Purl

Round 3: *P1, K2* Repeat around

Round 4: K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 8 more times, P1, K1

Round 5: K2, *P1, K2* Repeat 8 more times, P1

Rounds 6-28: Repeat rounds 3-5

Rounds 29&30: Purl

Bind off as if to purl. Cut approx. 5 - 7 inch tail. Using yarn needle, secure yarn ends and weave them into the inside of the hat. Using your choice of ribbon or yarn, gather the hat 1.5" from the top, and tie tightly. (Optional) Sew on your favorite button into the middle of the ribbon to add a fun touch! You can also sew just the ribbon down if you'd like to make sure it stays securely in place.

0-3 Month Pattern

Cast on 33 sts onto Double Pointed Needles (or use the magic loop method) or Circular Needles
Join in the round and place stitch marker

Rounds 1&2: Purl

Round 3: *P1, K2* Repeat around

Round 4: K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 9 more times, P1, K1

Round 5: K2, *P1, K2* Repeat 9 more times, P1

Rounds 6-30: Repeat rounds 3-5

Rounds 31&32: Purl

Bind off as if to purl. Cut approx. 5 - 7 inch tail. Using yarn needle, secure yarn ends and weave them into the inside of the hat. Using your choice of ribbon or yarn, gather the hat 1.5" from the top, and tie tightly. (Optional) Sew on your favorite button into the middle of the ribbon to add a fun touch! You can also sew just the ribbon down if you'd like to make sure it stays securely in place.

3-6 Month Pattern

Cast on 35 sts onto Double Pointed Needles (or use the magic loop method) or Circular Needles
Join in the round and place stitch marker

Rounds 1&2: Purl

Round 3: *P1, K2* Repeat 10 more times, P1, K1

Round 4: K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 10 more times, P1

Round 5: P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 10 more times

Round 6: K1, P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 9 more times, P1, K1

Round 7: K2, P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 9 more times, P1

Round 8: P1, K2, P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 9 more times

Round 9: K1, P1, K2, P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 8 more times, P1, K1

Round 10: K2, P1, K2, P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 8 more times, P1

Round 11: *P1, K2* Repeat once, P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 8 more times

Round 12: K1, *P1, K2* Repeat once, P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 7 more times, P1, K1

Round 13: K2, *P1, K2* Repeat once, P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 7 more times, P1

Round 14: *P1, K2* Repeat 2 more times, P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 7 more times

Round 15: K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 2 more times, P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 6 more times, P1, K1

Round 16: K2, *P1, K2* Repeat 2 more times, P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 6 more times, P1

Round 17: *P1, K2* Repeat 3 more times, P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 6 more times

Round 18: K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 3 more times, P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 5 more times, P1, K1

Round 19: K2, *P1, K2* Repeat 3 more times, P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 5 more times, P1

Round 20: *P1, K2* Repeat 4 more times, P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 5 more times

Round 21: K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 4 more times, P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 4 more times, P1, K1

Round 22: K2, *P1, K2* Repeat 4 more times, P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 4 more times, P1

Round 23: *P1, K2* Repeat 5 more times, P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 4 more times

Round 24: K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 5 more times, P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 3 more times, P1, K1

Round 25: K2, *P1, K2* Repeat 5 more times, P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 3 more times, P1

Round 26: *P1, K2* Repeat 6 more times, P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 3 more times

Round 27: K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 6 more times, P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 2 more times, P1, K1

Round 28: K2, *P1, K2* Repeat 6 more times, P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 2 more times, P1

Round 29: *P1, K2* Repeat 7 more times, P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 2 more times

Round 30: K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 7 more times, P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 1 more time, P1, K1

Round 31: K2, *P1, K2* Repeat 7 more times, P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 1 more time, P1

Round 32: *P1, K2* Repeat 8 more times, P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 1 more time

Rounds 33&34: Purl

Bind off as if to purl. Cut approx. 5 - 7 inch tail. Using yarn needle, secure yarn ends and weave them into the inside of the hat. Using your choice of ribbon or yarn, gather the hat 1.5" from the top, and tie tightly. (Optional) Sew on your favorite button into the middle of the ribbon to add a fun touch! You can also sew just the ribbon down if you'd like to make sure it stays securely in place.

6-12 Month Pattern

Cast on 38 sts onto Double Pointed Needles (or use the magic loop method) or Circular Needles
Join in the round and place stitch marker

Rounds 1&2: Purl

Round 3: *P1, K2* Repeat 11 more times, P1, K1

Round 4: K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 11 more times, P1

Round 5: P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 11 more times

Round 6: K1, P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 10 more times, P1, K1

Round 7: K2, P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 10 more times, P1

Round 8: P1, K2, P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 10 more times

Round 9: K1, P1, K2, P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 9 more times, P1, K1

Round 10: K2, P1, K2, P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 9 more times, P1

Round 11: *P1, K2* Repeat once, P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 9 more times

Round 12: K1, *P1, K2* Repeat once, P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 8 more times, P1, K1

Round 13: K2, *P1, K2* Repeat once P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 8 more times, P1

Round 14: *P1, K2* Repeat 2 more times, P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 8 more times

Round 15: K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 2 more times, P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 7 more times, P1, K1

Round 16: K2, *P1, K2* Repeat 2 more times, P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 7 more times, P1

Round 17: *P1, K2* Repeat 3 more times, P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 7 more times

Round 18: K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 3 more times, P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 6 more times, P1, K1

Round 19: K2, *P1, K2* Repeat 3 more times, P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 6 more times, P1

Round 20: *P1, K2* Repeat 4 more times, P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 6 more times

Round 21: K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 4 more times, P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 5 more times, P1, K1

Round 22: K2, *P1, K2* Repeat 4 more times, P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 5 more times, P1

Round 23: *P1, K2* Repeat 5 more times, P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 5 more times

Round 24: K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 5 more times, P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 4 more times, P1, K1

Round 25: K2, *P1, K2* Repeat 5 more times, P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 4 more times, P1

Round 26: *P1, K2* Repeat 6 more times, P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 4 more times

Round 27: K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 6 more times, P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 3 more times, P1, K1

Round 28: K2, *P1, K2* Repeat 6 more times, P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 3 more times, P1

Round 29: *P1, K2* Repeat 7 more times, P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 3 more times

Round 30: K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 7 more times, P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 2 more times, P1, K1

Round 31: K2, *P1, K2* Repeat 7 more times, P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 2 more times, P1

Round 32: *P1, K2* Repeat 8 more times, P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 2 more times

Round 33: K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 8 more times, P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 1 more time, P1, K1

Round 34: K2, *P1, K2* Repeat 8 more times, P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 1 more time, P1

Rounds 35&36: Purl

Bind off as if to purl. Cut approx. 5 - 7 inch tail. Using yarn needle, secure yarn ends and weave them into the inside of the hat. Using your choice of ribbon or yarn, gather the hat 1.5" from the top, and tie tightly. (Optional) Sew on your favorite button into the middle of the ribbon to add a fun touch! You can also sew just the ribbon down if you'd like to make sure it stays securely in place.

1-3 Year Pattern

Cast on 41 sts onto Double Pointed Needles (or use the magic loop method) or Circular Needles
Join in the round and place stitch marker

Rounds 1&2: Purl

Round 3: *P1, K2* Repeat 12 more times, P1, K1

Round 4: K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 12 more times, P1

Round 5: P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 12 more times

Round 6: K1, P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 11 more times, P1, K1

Round 7: K2, P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 11 more times, P1

Round 8: P1, K2, P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 11 more times

Round 9: K1, P1, K2, P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 10 more times, P1, K1

Round 10: K2, P1, K2, P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 10 more times, P1

Round 11: *P1, K2* Repeat once, P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 10 more times

Round 12: K1, *P1, K2* Repeat once, P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 9 more times, P1, K1

Round 13: K2, *P1, K2* Repeat once P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 9 more times, P1

Round 14: *P1, K2* Repeat 2 more times, P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 9 more times

Round 15: K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 2 more times, P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 8 more times, P1, K1

Round 16: K2, *P1, K2* Repeat 2 more times, P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 8 more times, P1

Round 35: *P1, K2* Repeat 9 more times, P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 2 more times

Round 36: K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 9 more times, P1, K1, *P1, K2* Repeat 1 more time, P1, K1

Rounds 37&38: Purl

Bind off as if to purl. Cut approx. 5 - 7 inch tail. Using yarn needle, secure yarn ends and weave them into the inside of the hat. Using your choice of ribbon or yarn, gather the hat 1.5" from the top, and tie tightly. (Optional) Sew on your favorite button into the middle of the ribbon to add a fun touch! You can also sew just the ribbon down if you'd like to make sure it stays securely in place.

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
