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Oliver Twist Cap Crochet Pattern



Materials:

- Yarn: Approximately 55 yards of bulky (5) weight yarn for smaller sizes, and approx. 100 yards for larger sizes (I used two strands of Paton's Classic Wool held together)
- Crochet Hook: Size 6.5 mm (10.5/K) OR whatever size is needed to achieve gauge
- Yarn or Tapestry Needle

Abbreviations:

- SC: Single Crochet
- CH: Chain
- SC2tog: Single Crochet the next two (or the designated two) stitches together
- **: Repeat the section in between the two stars as specified

Gauge:

7 sts and 8 rows = 2 inches (5 centimeters)
in Moss Stitch (Pattern Stitch)
It is important to check your gauge!

Pattern For Gauge Swatch:

CH 22

Row 1: SC into 4th chain from hook, *CH1, Skip one chain, SC in the next chain*
Repeat to end, CH2, Turn Work

Row 2: SC in next CH1 space, *CH1, SC in next CH1 space* Repeat to end, and finish with SC in CH3 space from first row, CH2, Turn Work

Row 3: SC in next CH1 space, *CH1, SC in next CH1 space* Repeat to end, and finish with SC in turning CH2 space from previous row, CH2, Turn Work
Repeat Row 3 to end of swatch

Average Head Circumference:

Newborn: 13-14"
0-3 Months: 14-15"
3-6 Months: 14-17"
6-12 Months: 16-19"
1-3 Years: 18-20"
3-10 Years: 19-20.5"
Pre-teen/Teen: 20.5-22"
Adult Female: 21.5-22.5"
Adult Male: 23-24"

Newborn Hat Pattern

Chain 42

Join in the round by slip stitching first and last chains together. Place Stitch Marker (optional).

Round 1: CH2, Skip first chain and SC into second chain, *CH1, Skip next chain and SC into following chain* Repeat around, slip stitch into first stitch (42 total sts including one chain from starting CH2)

Round 2: CH1, SC into first CH1 space from previous round, *CH1, skip next stitch, SC into next CH1 space from previous round* Repeat to last stitch, CH1, slip stitch into first stitch (42 total sts not including beginning CH1)

Round 3: CH2, skip first stitch and SC into first CH1 space from previous round, *CH1, skip next stitch and SC into next CH1 space from previous round* Repeat around, slip stitch into first stitch

Repeat Rounds 2&3 until your piece measures approx. 3.5 inches (8.75cm) from the starting edge.

Decreases:

Round 1: CH1, *SC2tog* Repeat around (21 total sts)

Cut Yarn leaving 12 inch (30.5cm) tail. Fasten Off. Place tail onto yarn needle and weave through each stitch around the top of hat. Pull on yarn tail to cinch the top of the hat tightly. Your project should now have large ridges or waves at the top. Secure and weave in all ends.

Brim:

Connect a new strand of yarn to the front of the hat. Work Row 1 into the front loop only.

Row 1: CH2, *CH1, skip one stitch, SC into next stitch* Repeat five more times, CH2, Turn Work (13 total sts including starting chain)

Row 2: SC in next CH1 space, *CH1, SC in next CH1 space* Repeat to end and finish with SC in CH2 space from first row.

Fasten off and weave in all ends.

Add a SC edge around the outside of the brim. Fasten off. Weave in all ends.

Block if desired.

0-3 Month Hat Pattern

Chain 46

Join in the round by slip stitching first and last chains together. Place Stitch Marker (optional).

Round 1: CH2, Skip first chain and SC into second chain, *CH1, Skip next chain and SC into following chain* Repeat around, slip stitch into first stitch (46 total sts including one chain from starting CH2)

Round 2: CH1, SC into first CH1 space from previous round, *CH1, skip next stitch, SC into next CH1 space from previous round* Repeat to last stitch, CH1, slip stitch into first stitch (46 total sts not including beginning CH1)

Round 3: CH2, skip first stitch and SC into first CH1 space from previous round, *CH1, skip next stitch and SC into next CH1 space from previous round* Repeat around, slip stitch into first stitch

Repeat Rounds 2&3 until your piece measures approx. 3.75 inches (9.5cm) from the starting edge.

Decreases:

Round 1: CH1, *SC2tog* Repeat around (23 total sts)

Cut Yarn leaving 12 inch (30.5cm) tail. Fasten Off. Place tail onto yarn needle and weave through each stitch around the top of hat. Pull on yarn tail to cinch the top of the hat tightly. Your project should now have large ridges or waves at the top. Secure and weave in all ends.

Brim:

Connect a new strand of yarn to the front of the hat. Work Row 1 into the front loop only.

Row 1: CH2, *CH1, skip one stitch, SC into next stitch* Repeat five more times, CH2, Turn Work (13 total sts including starting chain)

Row 2: SC in next CH1 space, *CH1, SC in next CH1 space* Repeat to end and finish with SC in CH2 space from first row.

Fasten off and weave in all ends.

Add a SC edge around the outside of the brim. Fasten off. Weave in all ends.

Block if desired.

3-6 Month Hat Pattern

Chain 52

Join in the round by slip stitching first and last chains together. Place Stitch Marker (optional).

Round 1: CH2, Skip first chain and SC into second chain, *CH1, Skip next chain and SC into following chain* Repeat around, slip stitch into first stitch (52 total sts including one chain from starting CH2)

Round 2: CH1, SC into first CH1 space from previous round, *CH1, skip next stitch, SC into next CH1 space from previous round* Repeat to last stitch, CH1, slip stitch into first stitch (52 total sts not including beginning CH1)

Round 3: CH2, skip first stitch and SC into first CH1 space from previous round, *CH1, skip next stitch and SC into next CH1 space from previous round* Repeat around, slip stitch into first stitch

Repeat Rounds 2&3 until your piece measures approx. 4 inches (10.25cm) from the starting edge.

Decreases:

Round 1: CH1, *SC2tog* Repeat around (26 total sts)

Cut Yarn leaving 12 inch (30.5cm) tail. Fasten Off. Place tail onto yarn needle and weave through each stitch around the top of hat. Pull on yarn tail to cinch the top of the hat tightly. Your project should now have large ridges or waves at the top. Secure and weave in all ends.

Brim:

Connect a new strand of yarn to the front of the hat. Work Row 1 into the front loop only.

Row 1: CH2, *CH1, skip one stitch, SC into next stitch* Repeat six more times, CH2, Turn Work (15 total sts including starting chain)

Row 2: SC in next CH1 space, *CH1, SC in next CH1 space* Repeat to end and finish with SC in CH2 space from first row.

Fasten off and weave in all ends.

Add a SC edge around the outside of the brim. Fasten off. Weave in all ends.

Block if desired.

6-12 Month Hat Pattern

Chain 56

Join in the round by slip stitching first and last chains together. Place Stitch Marker (optional).

Round 1: CH2, Skip first chain and SC into second chain, *CH1, Skip next chain and SC into following chain* Repeat around, slip stitch into first stitch (56 total sts including one chain from starting CH2)

Round 2: CH1, SC into first CH1 space from previous round, *CH1, skip next stitch, SC into next CH1 space from previous round* Repeat to last stitch, CH1, slip stitch into first stitch (56 total sts not including beginning CH1)

Round 3: CH2, skip first stitch and SC into first CH1 space from previous round, *CH1, skip next stitch and SC into next CH1 space from previous round* Repeat around, slip stitch into first stitch

Repeat Rounds 2&3 until your piece measures approx. 4.5 inches (11.5cm) from the starting edge.

Decreases:

Round 1: CH1, *SC next stitch, SC2tog* Repeat seventeen more times, SC each of next two sts (38 total sts)

Round 2: CH1, *SC2tog* Repeat around (19 total sts)

Cut Yarn leaving 12 inch (30.5cm) tail. Fasten Off. Place tail onto yarn needle and weave through each stitch around the top of hat. Pull on yarn tail to cinch the top of the hat tightly. Your project should now have large ridges or waves at the top. Secure and weave in all ends.

Brim:

Connect a new strand of yarn to the front of the hat. Work Row 1 into the front loop only.

Row 1: CH2, *CH1, skip one stitch, SC into next stitch* Repeat seven more times, CH2, Turn Work (17 total sts including starting chain)

Row 2: SC in next CH1 space, *CH1, SC in next CH1 space* Repeat to end and finish with SC in CH2 space from first row.

Fasten off and weave in all ends.

Add a SC edge around the outside of the brim. Fasten off. Weave in all ends.

Block if desired.

1-3 Year Hat Pattern

Chain 62

Join in the round by slip stitching first and last chains together. Place Stitch Marker (optional).

Round 1: CH2, Skip first chain and SC into second chain, *CH1, Skip next chain and SC into following chain* Repeat around, slip stitch into first stitch (62 total sts including one chain from starting CH2)

Round 2: CH1, SC into first CH1 space from previous round, *CH1, skip next stitch, SC into next CH1 space from previous round* Repeat to last stitch, CH1, slip stitch into first stitch (62 total sts not including beginning CH1)

Round 3: CH2, skip first stitch and SC into first CH1 space from previous round, *CH1, skip next stitch and SC into next CH1 space from previous round* Repeat around, slip stitch into first stitch

Repeat Rounds 2&3 until your piece measures approx. 5 inches (12.75cm) from the starting edge.

Decreases:

Round 1: CH1, *SC next stitch, SC2tog* Repeat nineteen more times, SC each of next two sts (42 total sts)

Round 2: CH1, *SC2tog* Repeat around (21 total sts)

Cut Yarn leaving 12 inch (30.5cm) tail. Fasten Off. Place tail onto yarn needle and weave through each stitch around the top of hat. Pull on yarn tail to cinch the top of the hat tightly. Your project should now have large ridges or waves at the top. Secure and weave in all ends.

Brim:

Connect a new strand of yarn to the front of the hat. Work Row 1 into the front loop only.

Row 1: CH2, *CH1, skip one stitch, SC into next stitch* Repeat nine more times, CH2, Turn Work (21 total sts including starting chain)

Row 2: SC in next CH1 space, *CH1, SC in next CH1 space* Repeat to end and finish with SC in CH2 space from first row.

Row 3: SC in next CH1 space, *CH1, SC in next CH1 space* Repeat to end and finish with SC in CH2 space from Row 2.

Fasten off and weave in all ends.

Add a SC edge around the outside of the brim. Fasten off. Weave in all ends.

Block if desired.

3-10 Year Hat Pattern

Chain 66

Join in the round by slip stitching first and last chains together. Place Stitch Marker.

Round 1: CH2, Skip first chain and SC into second chain, *CH1, Skip next chain and SC into following chain* Repeat around, slip stitch into first stitch (66 total sts including one chain from starting CH2)

Round 2: CH1, SC into first CH1 space from previous round, *CH1, skip next stitch, SC into next CH1 space from previous round* Repeat to last stitch, CH1, slip stitch into first stitch (66 total sts not including beginning CH1)

Round 3: CH2, skip first stitch and SC into first CH1 space from previous round, *CH1, skip next stitch and SC into next CH1 space from previous round* Repeat around, slip stitch into first stitch

Repeat Rounds 2&3 until your piece measures approx. 5.5 inches (14cm) from the starting edge.

Decreases:

Round 1: CH1, *SC next stitch, SC2tog* Repeat around (44 total sts)

Round 2: CH1, *SC2tog* Repeat around (22 total sts)

Cut Yarn leaving 12 inch (30.5cm) tail. Fasten Off. Place tail onto yarn needle and weave through each stitch around the top of hat. Pull on yarn tail to cinch the top of the hat tightly. Your project should now have large ridges or waves at the top. Secure and weave in all ends.

Brim:

Connect a new strand of yarn to the front of the hat. Work Row 1 into the front loop only.

Row 1: CH2, *CH1, skip one stitch, SC into next stitch* Repeat eleven more times, CH2, Turn Work (25 total sts including starting chain)

Row 2: SC in next CH1 space, *CH1, SC in next CH1 space* Repeat to end and finish with SC in CH2 space from first row.

Row 3: SC in next CH1 space, *CH1, SC in next CH1 space* Repeat to end and finish with SC in CH2 space from Row 2.

Fasten off and weave in all ends.

Add a SC edge around the outside of the brim. Fasten off. Weave in all ends.

Block if desired.

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
