## Oliver Twist Cap Knitting Pattern



### Materials:

- Yarn: Approximately 60 yards for smaller sizes and 80 yards for larger sizes of bulky (5) weight yarn  
(I used Lamb's Pride Bulky)
- Knitting Needles: Size 9 mm (US 13) (Or Size Needed to Obtain Gauge) small Circular Needle (for the smallest sizes, 12" circular would be ideal) or Double Pointed Needles and Straight Needles
- Yarn or Tapestry Needle

### Abbreviations:

- \*\*: Repeat the section in between the two stars as specified

### Gauge:

5 sts and 10 rows = 2 inches (5 centimeters)  
in seed stitch (pattern stitch)  
\*\*\*It is important to check your gauge!\*\*\*

### Average Head Circumference:

Newborn: 13-14"  
0-3 Months: 14-15"  
3-6 Months: 14-17"  
6-12 Months: 16-19"  
1-3 Years: 18-20"  
3-10 Years: 19-20.5"

## Newborn Pattern

Cast on 36 sts onto circular needles

Join in the round and place stitch marker.

**Round 1:** \*K1, P1\* Repeat around.

**Round 2:** \*P1, K1\* Repeat around.

**Repeat Rounds 1&2** until your project measures approx. 3.5 inches (8.75cm) from the cast on edge.

Do not bind off. Cut approx. 7 inch tail. Using yarn needle, remove all sts from DPNs or magic loop, as if to purl. Pull tail through sts to cinch the top of hat. Using yarn needle, pull tail through to the inside of the hat. Tie a knot and weave in ends.

Using your straight needles, pick up 10 sts on the front of the hat (pick up the stitches from the outside to the inside) starting on a purl stitch.

**Row 1:** \*P1, K1\* Repeat across

**Row 2:** \*K1, P1\* Repeat across

**Row 3:** Repeat row 1

Bind off in pattern

Cut yarn and secure and weave in all ends.

## 0-3 Month Pattern

Cast on 38 sts onto circular needles

Join in the round and place stitch marker.

**Round 1:** \*K1, P1\* Repeat around.

**Round 2:** \*P1, K1\* Repeat around.

**Repeat Rounds 1&2** until your project measures approx. 4 inches (10.25cm) from the cast on edge.

Do not bind off. Cut approx. 7 inch tail. Using yarn needle, remove all sts from DPNs or magic loop, as if to purl. Pull tail through sts to cinch the top of hat. Using yarn needle, pull tail through to the inside of the hat. Tie a knot and weave in ends.

Using your straight needles, pick up 12 sts on the front of the hat (pick up the stitches from the outside to the inside) starting on a purl stitch.

**Row 1:** \*P1, K1\* Repeat across

**Row 2:** \*K1, P1\* Repeat across

**Row 3:** Repeat row 1

Bind off in pattern

Cut yarn and secure and weave in all ends.

### 3-6 Month Pattern

Cast on 40 sts onto circular needles

Join in the round and place stitch marker.

**Round 1:** \*K1, P1\* Repeat around.

**Round 2:** \*P1, K1\* Repeat around.

**Repeat Rounds 1&2** until your project measures approx. 4.5 inches (11.5cm) from the cast on edge.

Do not bind off. Cut approx. 7 inch tail. Using yarn needle, remove all sts from DPNs or magic loop, as if to purl. Pull tail through sts to cinch the top of hat. Using yarn needle, pull tail through to the inside of the hat. Tie a knot and weave in ends.

Using your straight needles, pick up 14 sts on the front of the hat (pick up the stitches from the outside to the inside) starting on a purl stitch.

**Row 1:** \*P1, K1\* Repeat across

**Row 2:** \*K1, P1\* Repeat across

**Row 3:** Repeat row 1

Bind off in pattern

Cut yarn and secure and weave in all ends.

### 6-12 Month Pattern

Cast on 44 sts onto circular needles

Join in the round and place stitch marker.

**Round 1:** \*K1, P1\* Repeat around.

**Round 2:** \*P1, K1\* Repeat around.

**Repeat Rounds 1&2** until your project measures approx. 5 inches (12.75cm) from the cast on edge.

Do not bind off. Cut approx. 7 inch tail. Using yarn needle, remove all sts from DPNs or magic loop, as if to purl. Pull tail through sts to cinch the top of hat. Using yarn needle, pull tail through to the inside of the hat. Tie a knot and weave in ends.

Using your straight needles, pick up 18 sts on the front of the hat (pick up the stitches from the outside to the inside) starting on a purl stitch.

**Row 1:** \*P1, K1\* Repeat across

**Row 2:** \*K1, P1\* Repeat across

**Row 3:** Repeat row 1

Bind off in pattern

Cut yarn and secure and weave in all ends.

### 1-3 Year Pattern

Cast on 48 sts onto circular needles

Join in the round and place stitch marker.

**Round 1:** \*K1, P1\* Repeat around.

**Round 2:** \*P1, K1\* Repeat around.

**Repeat Rounds 1&2** until your project measures approx. 5.5 inches (14cm) from the cast on edge.

Do not bind off. Cut approx. 7 inch tail. Using yarn needle, remove all sts from DPNs or magic loop, as if to purl. Pull tail through sts to cinch the top of hat. Using yarn needle, pull tail through to the inside of the hat. Tie a knot and weave in ends.

Using your straight needles, pick up 20 sts on the front of the hat (pick up the stitches from the outside to the inside) starting on a purl stitch.

**Row 1:** \*P1, K1\* Repeat across

**Row 2:** \*K1, P1\* Repeat across

**Row 3:** Repeat row 1

Bind off in pattern

Cut yarn and secure and weave in all ends.

### 3-10 Year Pattern

Cast on 50 sts onto circular needles

Join in the round and place stitch marker.

**Round 1:** \*K1, P1\* Repeat around.

**Round 2:** \*P1, K1\* Repeat around.

**Repeat Rounds 1&2** until your project measures approx. 6 inches (15.25cm) from the cast on edge.

Do not bind off. Cut approx. 7 inch tail. Using yarn needle, remove all sts from DPNs or magic loop, as if to purl. Pull tail through sts to cinch the top of hat. Using yarn needle, pull tail through to the inside of the hat. Tie a knot and weave in ends.

Using your straight needles, pick up 22 sts on the front of the hat (pick up the stitches from the outside to the inside) starting on a purl stitch.

**Row 1:** \*P1, K1\* Repeat across

**Row 2:** \*K1, P1\* Repeat across

**Row 3:** Repeat row 1

Bind off in pattern

Cut yarn and secure and weave in all ends.
