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## Christmas Wreath Hot Pad Knitting Pattern



### Materials:

- Yarn: Approximately 50 yards of worsted (4) yarn (approx. 40 yards of green, and approx. 10 yards of red)
- Knitting Needles: Size 5.5 mm (US9) Straight Needles
- Yarn or Tapestry Needle

### Abbreviations:

- K: Knit
- K2tog: Knit the next 2 sts together
- \*\*: Repeat the section in between the two stars as specified

## Christmas Wreath Hot Pad Pattern

Cast on 9 sts using Green Yarn

**Row 1:** K3 (Short Row – leave 6 sts un-worked and Turn Work)

**Row 2:** Knit (3 total sts)

**Row 3:** K6 (Short Row - leave 6 sts un-worked and Turn Work)

**Row 4:** Knit (6 total sts)

**Rows 5&6:** Knit (9 total sts)

**Repeat Rows 1-6** until the two ends of your project meet in a circle.

**Fasten off** leaving an approx. 10 inch yarn tail.

Use your yarn or tapestry needle and yarn tail to sew the two edges together.

### Leaf Pattern (Make 2)

Cast on 3 using Red Yarn. Leave an approx. 10 inch starting yarn tail to use for sewing to your project later.

**Row 1:** Knit

**Row 2:** K1, M1, K1, M1, K1 (5 total sts)

**Row 3:** Knit

**Row 4:** K1, M1, K3, M1, K1 (7 total sts)

**Row 5:** Knit

**Row 6:** K1, M1, K5, M1, K1 (9 total sts)

**Row 7:** Knit

**Row 8:** K2tog, K5, K2tog (7 total sts)

**Row 9:** K2tog, K3, K2tog (5 total sts)

**Row 10:** K2tog, K1, K2tog (3 total sts)

**Row 11:** Knit

**Row 12:** K1, M1, K1, M1, K1 (5 total sts)

**Row 13:** Knit

**Row 14:** K1, M1, K3, M1, K1 (7 total sts)

**Row 15:** Knit

**Row 16:** K2tog, K3, K2tog (5 total sts)

**Row 17:** K2tog, K1, K2tog (3 total sts)

**Row 18:** K1, M1, K1, M1, K1 (5 total sts)

**Row 19:** K2tog, K1, K2tog (3 total sts)

**Row 20:** Knit

**Row 21:** K2tog, K1 (2 total sts)

**Row 22:** K2tog

Secure and weave in end.

Use your starting yarn tail to sew the leaves over the seam on your wreath.

Tie a piece of red yarn and a piece of green yarn in a knot multiple times in order to create one large knot. Attach to your project as one of the berries. Make 3 total.

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
