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Pebble Beach Hat Crochet Pattern



Materials:

- Yarn: Approximately 125-220 Yards of Worsted (4) Weight Yarn (I used Berroco Modern Cotton)
- Crochet Hook: Size 5.5 mm (I/9) OR whatever size is needed to obtain gauge
- Yarn or Tapestry Needle

Abbreviations:

- SC: Single Crochet
- HDC: Half Double Crochet
- DC: Double Crochet
- CH: Chain
- SC2tog: Single Crochet the next 2 sts together (decrease)
- **: Repeat the section in between the two stars as specified

Gauge:

9 sts and 10 rows = 2 inches (5 centimeters)
In Single Crochet
It is important to check your gauge!

Average Head Circumference:

Newborn: 13-14"
0-3 Months: 14-15"
3-6 Months: 14-17"
6-12 Months: 16-19"
1-3 Years: 18-20"
3-10 Years: 19-20.5"
Pre-teen/Teen: 20.5-22"
Adult Female: 21.5-22.5"

All of my patterns are written in US terms

Newborn Pattern

Create a Magic Circle with 6 SC sts in the center.

Join in the round by slip stitching first and last sts together. Place Stitch Marker.

You'll be working in continuous rounds.

Round 1: 2 SC in each stitch around (12 total sts)

Round 2: *2 SC in next stitch, SC in next stitch* Repeat around (18 total sts)

Round 3: *2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 2 sts* Repeat around (24 total sts)

Round 4: *2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 3 sts* Repeat around (30 total sts)

Round 5: *2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 4 sts* Repeat around (36 total sts)

Round 6: *SC in next stitch, (HDC, 3 DC, HDC) in next stitch, SC in each of next 2 sts* Repeat around (72 total sts / 9 total scallops)

Round 7: *CH1, move your hook underneath the next scallop, skipping all scallop sts, skip next SC stitch, (HDC, 3 DC, HDC) in next stitch (this should be the center of 3 SC sts), skip next stitch* Repeat around to very last stitch and end with a scallop in very last stitch (54 total sts)

Round 8: *(HDC, 3 DC, HDC) in previous round's chain space, CH1, move your hook underneath the next scallop, skipping all scallop sts* Repeat around (54 total sts)

Round 9: *CH1, move your hook underneath the next scallop, skipping all scallop sts (HDC, 3 DC, HDC) in previous round's chain space* Repeat around (54 total sts)

Repeat Rounds 8&9 until your hat measures approx. 3 inches (7.5cm) in length from the crown.

Round 10: SC in each stitch or chain space around (54 total sts)

Repeat Round 10 until your hat measures approx. 4 inches (10cm) in length from the crown.

Round 11: Working in the front loop only, *2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 8 sts* Repeat around (60 total sts)

Round 12: *2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 9 sts* Repeat around (66 total sts)

Round 13: *SC in each of next 5 sts, 2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 5 sts* Repeat around (72 total sts)

Round 14: *2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 11 sts* Repeat around (78 total sts)

Round 15: *SC in each of next 6 sts, 2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 6 sts* Repeat around (84 total sts)

Fasten Off. Secure and weave in all ends.

For a more feminine touch, choose a contrasting color and cut 6 or 9 strands of yarn approx. 28 inches (71cm) in length. Braid these strands and tie a knot on either end. Weave this braided piece through the holes in your hat and tie a large bow on the front or side.

0-3 Month Pattern

Create a Magic Circle with 6 SC sts in the center.

Join in the round by slip stitching first and last sts together. Place Stitch Marker.

You'll be working in continuous rounds.

Round 1: 2 SC in each stitch around (12 total sts)

Round 2: *2 SC in next stitch, SC in next stitch* Repeat around (18 total sts)

Round 3: *2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 2 sts* Repeat around (24 total sts)

Round 4: *2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 3 sts* Repeat around (30 total sts)

Round 5: *2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 4 sts* Repeat around (36 total sts)

Round 6: *2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 8 sts* Repeat around (40 total sts)

Round 7: *SC in next stitch, (HDC, 3 DC, HDC) in next stitch, SC in each of next 2 sts* Repeat around (80 total sts / 10 total scallops)

Round 8: *CH1, move your hook underneath the next scallop, skipping all scallop sts, skip next SC stitch, (HDC, 3 DC, HDC) in next stitch (this should be the center of 3 SC sts), skip next stitch* Repeat around to very last stitch and end with a scallop in very last stitch (60 total sts)

Round 9: *(HDC, 3 DC, HDC) in previous round's chain space, CH1, move your hook underneath the next scallop, skipping all scallop sts* Repeat around (60 total sts)

Round 10: *CH1, move your hook underneath the next scallop, skipping all scallop sts (HDC, 3 DC, HDC) in previous round's chain space* Repeat around (60 total sts)

Repeat Rounds 9&10 until your hat measures approx. 3.5 inches (8.75cm) in length from the crown.

Round 11: SC in each stitch or chain space around (60 total sts)

Repeat Round 11 until your hat measures approx. 4.5 inches (11.5cm) in length from the crown.

Round 12: Working in the front loop only, *2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 9 sts* Repeat around (66 total sts)

Round 13: *SC in each of next 5 sts, 2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 5 sts* Repeat around (72 total sts)

Round 14: *2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 11 sts* Repeat around (78 total sts)

Round 15: *SC in each of next 6 sts, 2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 6 sts* Repeat around (84 total sts)

Round 16: *2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 12 sts* Repeat around (90 total sts)

Fasten Off. Secure and weave in all ends.

For a more feminine touch, choose a contrasting color and cut 6 or 9 strands of yarn approx. 28 inches (71cm) in length. Braid these strands and tie a knot on either end. Weave this braided piece through the holes in your hat and tie a large bow on the front or side.

3-6 Month Pattern

Create a Magic Circle with 6 SC sts in the center.

Join in the round by slip stitching first and last sts together. Place Stitch Marker.

You'll be working in continuous rounds.

Round 1: 2 SC in each stitch around (12 total sts)

Round 2: *2 SC in next stitch, SC in next stitch* Repeat around (18 total sts)

Round 3: *2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 2 sts* Repeat around (24 total sts)

Round 4: *2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 3 sts* Repeat around (30 total sts)

Round 5: *2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 4 sts* Repeat around (36 total sts)

Round 6: *2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 5 sts* Repeat around (42 total sts)

Round 7: *2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 6 sts* Repeat around (48 total sts)

Round 8: *SC in next stitch, (HDC, 3 DC, HDC) in next stitch, SC in each of next 2 sts* Repeat around (96 total sts / 12 total scallops)

Round 9: *CH1, move your hook underneath the next scallop, skipping all scallop sts, skip next SC stitch, (HDC, 3 DC, HDC) in next stitch (this should be the center of 3 SC sts), skip next stitch* Repeat around to very last stitch and end with a scallop in very last stitch (72 total sts)

Round 10: *(HDC, 3 DC, HDC) in previous round's chain space, CH1, move your hook underneath the next scallop, skipping all scallop sts* Repeat around (72 total sts)

Round 11: *CH1, move your hook underneath the next scallop, skipping all scallop sts (HDC, 3 DC, HDC) in previous round's chain space* Repeat around (72 total sts)

Repeat Rounds 10&11 until your hat measures approx. 4 inches (10cm) in length from the crown.

Round 12: SC in each stitch or chain space around (72 total sts)

Repeat Round 12 until your hat measures approx. 5 inches (12.75cm) in length from the crown.

Round 13: Working in the front loop only, *2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 11 sts* Repeat around (78 total sts)

Round 14: *SC in each of next 6 sts, 2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 6 sts* Repeat around (84 total sts)

Round 15: *2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 13 sts* Repeat around (90 total sts)

Round 16: *SC in each of next 7 sts, 2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 7 sts* Repeat around (96 total sts)

Round 17: *2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 15 sts* Repeat around (102 total sts)

Round 18: *SC in each of next 8 sts, 2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 8 sts* Repeat around (108 total sts)

Fasten Off. Secure and weave in all ends.

For a more feminine touch, choose a contrasting color and cut 6 or 9 strands of yarn approx. 28 inches (71cm) in length. Braid these strands and tie a knot on either end. Weave this braided piece through the holes in your hat and tie a large bow on the front or side.

6-12 Month Pattern

Create a Magic Circle with 6 SC sts in the center.

Join in the round by slip stitching first and last sts together. Place Stitch Marker.

You'll be working in continuous rounds.

Round 1: 2 SC in each stitch around (12 total sts)

Round 2: *2 SC in next stitch, SC in next stitch* Repeat around (18 total sts)

Round 3: *2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 2 sts* Repeat around (24 total sts)

Round 4: *2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 3 sts* Repeat around (30 total sts)

Round 5: *2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 4 sts* Repeat around (36 total sts)

Round 6: *2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 5 sts* Repeat around (42 total sts)

Round 7: *2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 6 sts* Repeat around (48 total sts)

Round 8: *2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 11 sts* Repeat around (52 total sts)

Round 9: *SC in next stitch, (HDC, 3 DC, HDC) in next stitch, SC in each of next 2 sts* Repeat around (104 total sts / 13 total scallops)

Round 10: *CH1, move your hook underneath the next scallop, skipping all scallop sts, skip next SC stitch, (HDC, 3 DC, HDC) in next stitch (this should be the center of 3 SC sts), skip next stitch* Repeat around to very last stitch and end with a scallop in very last stitch (78 total sts)

Round 11: *(HDC, 3 DC, HDC) in previous round's chain space, CH1, move your hook underneath the next scallop, skipping all scallop sts* Repeat around (78 total sts)

Round 12: *CH1, move your hook underneath the next scallop, skipping all scallop sts (HDC, 3 DC, HDC) in previous round's chain space* Repeat around (78 total sts)

Repeat Rounds 11&12 until your hat measures approx. 4.5 inches (11.5cm) in length from the crown.

Round 13: SC in each stitch or chain space around (78 total sts)

Repeat Round 13 until your hat measures approx. 5.5 inches (14cm) in length from the crown.

Round 14: Working in the front loop only, *2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 12 sts* Repeat around (84 total sts)

Round 15: *2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 13 sts* Repeat around (90 total sts)

Round 16: *SC in each of next 7 sts, 2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 7 sts* Repeat around (96 total sts)

Round 17: *2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 15 sts* Repeat around (102 total sts)

Round 18: *SC in each of next 8 sts, 2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 8 sts* Repeat around (108 total sts)

Round 19: *2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 17 sts* Repeat around (114 total sts)

Round 20: *SC in each of next 9 sts, 2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 9 sts* Repeat around (120 total sts)

Fasten Off. Secure and weave in all ends.

For a more feminine touch, choose a contrasting color and cut 6 or 9 strands of yarn approx. 28 inches (71cm) in length. Braid these strands and tie a knot on either end. Weave this braided piece through the holes in your hat and tie a large bow on the front or side.

Toddler/Child Pattern

Create a Magic Circle with 6 SC sts in the center.

Join in the round by slip stitching first and last sts together. Place Stitch Marker.

You'll be working in continuous rounds.

Round 1: 2 SC in each stitch around (12 total sts)

Round 2: *2 SC in next stitch, SC in next stitch* Repeat around (18 total sts)

Round 3: *2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 2 sts* Repeat around (24 total sts)

Round 4: *2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 3 sts* Repeat around (30 total sts)

Round 5: *2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 4 sts* Repeat around (36 total sts)

Round 6: *2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 5 sts* Repeat around (42 total sts)

Round 7: *2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 6 sts* Repeat around (48 total sts)

Round 8: *2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 7 sts* Repeat around (54 total sts)

Round 9: *2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 26 sts* Repeat around (56 total sts)

Round 10: *SC in next stitch, (HDC, 3 DC, HDC) in next stitch, SC in each of next 2 sts* Repeat around (112 total sts / 14 total scallops)

Round 11: *CH1, move your hook underneath the next scallop, skipping all scallop sts, skip next SC stitch, (HDC, 3 DC, HDC) in next stitch (this should be the center of 3 SC sts), skip next stitch* Repeat around to very last stitch and end with a scallop in very last stitch (84 total sts)

Round 12: *(HDC, 3 DC, HDC) in previous round's chain space, CH1, move your hook underneath the next scallop, skipping all scallop sts* Repeat around (84 total sts)

Round 13: *CH1, move your hook underneath the next scallop, skipping all scallop sts (HDC, 3 DC, HDC) in previous round's chain space* Repeat around (84 total sts)

Repeat Rounds 12&13 until your hat measures approx. 5 inches (12.75cm) in length from the crown.

Round 14: SC in each stitch or chain space around (84 total sts)

Repeat Round 14 until your hat measures approx. 6 inches (15.25cm) in length from the crown.

Round 15: Working in the front loop only, *2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 13 sts* Repeat around (90 total sts)

Round 16: *SC in each of next 7 sts, 2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 7 sts* Repeat around (96 total sts)

Round 17: *2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 15 sts* Repeat around (102 total sts)

Round 18: *SC in each of next 8 sts, 2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 8 sts* Repeat around (108 total sts)

Round 19: *2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 17 sts* Repeat around (114 total sts)

Round 20: *SC in each of next 9 sts, 2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 9 sts* Repeat around (120 total sts)

Round 21: *2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 19 sts* Repeat around (126 total sts)

Round 22: *SC in each of next 10 sts, 2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 10 sts* Repeat around (132 total sts)

Fasten Off. Secure and weave in all ends.

For a more feminine touch, choose a contrasting color and cut 6 or 9 strands of yarn approx. 28 inches (71cm) in length. Braid these strands and tie a knot on either end. Weave this braided piece through the holes in your hat and tie a large bow on the front or side.

Adult Pattern

Create a Magic Circle with 6 SC sts in the center.

Join in the round by slip stitching first and last sts together. Place Stitch Marker.

You'll be working in continuous rounds.

Round 1: 2 SC in each stitch around (12 total sts)

Round 2: *2 SC in next stitch, SC in next stitch* Repeat around (18 total sts)

Round 3: *2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 2 sts* Repeat around (24 total sts)

Round 4: *2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 3 sts* Repeat around (30 total sts)

Round 5: *2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 4 sts* Repeat around (36 total sts)

Round 6: *2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 5 sts* Repeat around (42 total sts)

Round 7: *2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 6 sts* Repeat around (48 total sts)

Round 8: *2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 7 sts* Repeat around (54 total sts)

Round 9: *2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 8 sts* Repeat around (60 total sts)

Round 10: *SC in next stitch, (HDC, 3 DC, HDC) in next stitch, SC in each of next 2 sts* Repeat around (120 total sts / 15 total scallops)

Round 11: *CH1, move your hook underneath the next scallop, skipping all scallop sts, skip next SC stitch, (HDC, 3 DC, HDC) in next stitch (this should be the center of 3 SC sts), skip next stitch* Repeat around to very last stitch and end with a scallop in very last stitch (90 total sts)

Round 12: *(HDC, 3 DC, HDC) in previous round's chain space, CH1, move your hook underneath the next scallop, skipping all scallop sts* Repeat around (90 total sts)

Round 13: *CH1, move your hook underneath the next scallop, skipping all scallop sts (HDC, 3 DC, HDC) in previous round's chain space* Repeat around (90 total sts)

Repeat Rounds 12&13 until your hat measures approx. 6 inches (15.25cm) in length from the crown.

Round 14: SC in each stitch or chain space around (90 total sts)

Repeat Round 14 until your hat measures approx. 7 inches (17.75cm) in length from the crown.

Round 15: Working in the front loop only, *2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 14 sts* Repeat around (96 total sts)

Round 16: *2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 15 sts* Repeat around (102 total sts)

Round 17: *SC in each of next 8 sts, 2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 8 sts* Repeat around (108 total sts)

Round 18: *2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 17 sts* Repeat around (114 total sts)

Round 19: *SC in each of next 9 sts, 2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 9 sts* Repeat around (120 total sts)

Round 20: *2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 19 sts* Repeat around (126 total sts)

Round 21: *SC in each of next 10 sts, 2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 10 sts* Repeat around (132 total sts)

Round 22: *2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 21 sts* Repeat around (138 total sts)

Round 23: *SC in each of next 11 sts, 2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 11 sts* Repeat around (144 total sts)

Round 24: *2 SC in next stitch, SC in each of next 23 sts* Repeat around (150 total sts)

Fasten Off. Secure and weave in all ends.

For a more feminine touch, choose a contrasting color and cut 6 or 9 strands of yarn approx. 28 inches (71cm) in length. Braid these strands and tie a knot on either end. Weave this braided piece through the holes in your hat and tie a large bow on the front or side.

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
