

## Patriotic Mason Jar Cozy Knitting Pattern



### Materials:

- Yarn: Approx. 33 yards of worsted (4) weight yarn (approx. 13 yards white, 9 yards blue, and 9 yards red.  
(I used Red Heart Super Saver)

- Knitting Needles: Size 5.0 mm (US8) Double Pointed Needles (or use the Magic Loop Method) OR whatever size is needed to obtain gauge
- Yarn or Tapestry Needle

### Abbreviations:

- K: Knit
- P: Purl
- K2tog: Knit the next 2 sts together (decrease)
- \*\*: Repeat the section in between the two stars as specified

### Gauge:

8 sts and 13 rows = 2 inches (5 centimeters)  
in Stockinette Stitch  
\*\*\*It is important to check your gauge!\*\*\*

This pattern is designed to fit a wide mouth pint sized mason jar with a 10" (25.5cm) circumference.

## Patriotic Mason Jar Cozy Pattern

Cast on 40 sts using white yarn

Join in the round and place stitch marker.

**Rounds 1-4:** \*K2, P2\* Repeat around

Drop white yarn (do not cut) and pick up red yarn

**Rounds 5&6:** Knit

Drop red yarn (do not cut) and pick up white yarn

**Rounds 7&8:** Knit

Drop white yarn (do not cut) and pick up red yarn

**Rounds 9&10:** Knit

Drop red yarn (do not cut) and pick up white yarn

**Rounds 11&12:** Knit

Drop white yarn (do not cut) and pick up blue yarn

**Round 13:** Knit

Pick up white yarn. You'll be alternating between white and blue for the next round.

**Round 14:** \*K1 (white), K1 (blue)\* Repeat around

Drop white yarn (do not cut) and pick up blue yarn

**Round 15:** Knit

Pick up white yarn. You'll be alternating between white and blue for the next round.

**Round 16:** \*K3 (blue), K1 (white)\* Repeat around

Drop white yarn (do not cut) and pick up blue yarn

**Rounds 17&18:** Knit

Pick up white yarn. You'll be alternating between white and blue for the next round.

**Round 19:** \*K3 (blue), K1 (white)\* Repeat around

Drop white yarn (do not cut) and pick up blue yarn

**Round 20:** Knit

Pick up white yarn. You'll be alternating between white and blue for the next round.

**Round 21:** \*K1 (white), K1 (blue)\* Repeat around

Drop white yarn (do not cut) and pick up blue yarn

**Round 22:** Knit

Drop blue yarn (do not cut) and pick up white yarn

**Rounds 23&24:** Knit

Drop white yarn (do not cut) and pick up red yarn

**Rounds 25&26:** Knit

Drop red yarn (do not cut) and pick up white yarn

**Rounds 27&28:** Knit

Drop white yarn (do not cut) and pick up red yarn

**Rounds 29&30:** Knit

Drop red yarn (do not cut) and pick up white yarn

**Round 31:** \*K2tog, K6\* Repeat around (35 total sts)

**Round 32:** \*K2tog, K5\* Repeat around (30 total sts)

**Round 33:** \*K2tog, K4\* Repeat around (25 total sts)

**Round 34:** \*K2tog, K3\* Repeat around (20 total sts)

**Round 35:** \*K2tog, K2\* Repeat around (15 total sts)

**Round 36:** \*K2tog, K1\* Repeat around (10 total sts)

**Round 37:** \*K2tog\* Repeat around (5 total sts)

Do not bind off. Cut approx. 7 inch tail. Using yarn needle, remove all sts from DPNs or magic loop, as if to purl. Pull tail through sts to cinch the bottom of cozy. Using yarn needle, pull tail through to the inside of the cozy. Tie a knot and weave in ends.

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
