# Melody's Makings

## **Veronica Meets Spring Boho Bracelet Knitting Pattern**



#### **Materials:**

• Yarn: Approximately 20 Yards of Worsted (4) yarn in 2 coordinating colors.

**Color 1:** Approx. 11 Yards **Color 2:** Approx. 9 Yards

- Knitting Needles: Size 5.0 mm (US8) Straight Needles
  - Yarn or Tapestry Needle

#### **Abbreviations:**

- K: Knit
- P: Purl
- LTS: Left Traveling Stitch (Worked over 2 sts. More detailed instructions in pattern.)
- RTS: Right Traveling Stitch (Worked over 2 sts. More detailed instructions in pattern.)
- \*\*: Repeat the section in between the two stars as specified

#### Gauge:

10 sts and 13 rows = 2 inches (5 centimeters) in Stockinette Stitch

\*It is important to match gauge!\*

### **Bracelet Pattern**

Cast on 12 sts onto Straight Needles using Color 1 Yarn

**Row 1:** K1, P1, K8, P1, K1

Pick up Color 2 Yarn. You'll be alternating between Colors 1 & 2 for the following rows.

**Row 2:** K1 (Color 1), P1 (Color 1), K1 (Color 1), P5 (Color 1), P1 (Color 2), K1 (Color 1), P1 (Color 1), K1 (Color 1)

**Row 3:** K1 (Color 1), P1 (Color 1), K1 (Color 1), LTS (Knit the back loop of 2<sup>nd</sup> stitch using Color 1 and the front loop of 1<sup>st</sup> stitch using Color 2), K5 (Color 1), P1 (Color 1), K1 (Color 1)

**Row 4:** K1 (Color 1), P1 (Color 1), K1 (Color 1), P4 (Color 1), P1 (Color 2), P1 (Color 1), K1 (Color 1), P1 (Color 1), K1 (Color 1)

**Row 5:** K1 (Color 1), P1 (Color 1), K2 (Color 1), LTS (Knit the back loop of 2<sup>nd</sup> stitch using Color 1 and the front loop of 1<sup>st</sup> stitch using Color 2), K4 (Color 1), P1 (Color 1), K1 (Color 1)

**Row 6:** K1 (Color 1), P1 (Color 1), K1 (Color 1), P3 (Color 1), P1 (Color 2), P2 (Color 1), K1 (Color 1), P1 (Color 1), K1 (Color 1)

**Row 7:** K1 (Color 1), P1 (Color 1), K3 (Color 1), LTS (Knit the back loop of 2<sup>nd</sup> stitch using Color 1 and the front loop of 1<sup>st</sup> stitch using Color 2), K3 (Color 1), P1 (Color 1), K1 (Color 1)

**Row 8:** K1 (Color 1), P1 (Color 1), K1 (Color 1), P2 (Color 1), P1 (Color 2), P3 (Color 1), K1 (Color 1), P1 (Color 1), K1 (Color 1)

**Row 9:** K1 (Color 1), P1 (Color 1), K4 (Color 1), LTS (Knit the back loop of 2<sup>nd</sup> stitch using Color 1 and the front loop of 1<sup>st</sup> stitch using Color 2), K2 (Color 1), P1 (Color 1), K1 (Color 1)

**Row 10:** K1 (Color 1), P1 (Color 1), K1 (Color 1), P1 (Color 1), P1 (Color 2), P4 (Color 1), K1 (Color 1), P1 (Color 1), K1 (Color 1)

**Row 11:** K1 (Color 1), P1 (Color 1), K5 (Color 1), LTS (Knit the back loop of 2<sup>nd</sup> stitch using Color 1 and the front loop of 1<sup>st</sup> stitch using Color 2), K1 (Color 1), P1 (Color 1), K1 (Color 1)

**Row 12:** K1 (Color 1), P1 (Color 1), K1 (Color 1), P1 (Color 2), P5 (Color 1), K1 (Color 1), K1 (Color 1), K1 (Color 1)

**Row 13:** K1 (Color 1), P1 (Color 1), K5 (Color 1), RTS (Knit the front loop of 2<sup>nd</sup> stitch using Color 2 and the front loop of 1<sup>st</sup> stitch using Color 1), K1 (Color 1), P1 (Color 1), K1 (Color 1)

**Row 14:** K1 (Color 1), P1 (Color 1), K1 (Color 1), P1 (Color 1), P1 (Color 2), P4 (Color 1), K1 (Color 1), P1 (Color 1), K1 (Color 1)

**Row 15:** K1 (Color 1), P1 (Color 1), K4 (Color 1), RTS (Knit the front loop of 2<sup>nd</sup> stitch using Color 2 and the front loop of 1<sup>st</sup> stitch using Color 1), K2 (Color 1), P1 (Color 1), K1 (Color 1)

**Row 16:** K1 (Color 1), P1 (Color 1), K1 (Color 1), P2 (Color 1), P1 (Color 2), P3 (Color 1), K1 (Color 1), P1 (Color 1), K1 (Color 1)

**Row 17:** K1 (Color 1), P1 (Color 1), K3 (Color 1), RTS (Knit the front loop of 2<sup>nd</sup> stitch using Color 2 and the front loop of 1<sup>st</sup> stitch using Color 1), K3 (Color 1), P1 (Color 1), K1 (Color 1)

**Row 18:** K1 (Color 1), P1 (Color 1), K1 (Color 1), P3 (Color 1), P1 (Color 2), P2 (Color 1), K1 (Color 1), P1 (Color 1), K1 (Color 1)

**Row 19:** K1 (Color 1), P1 (Color 1), K2 (Color 1), RTS (Knit the front loop of 2<sup>nd</sup> stitch using Color 2 and the front loop of 1<sup>st</sup> stitch using Color 1), K4 (Color 1), P1 (Color 1), K1 (Color 1)

**Row 20:** K1 (Color 1), P1 (Color 1), K1 (Color 1), P4 (Color 1), P1 (Color 2), P1 (Color 1), K1 (Color 1), P1 (Color 1), K1 (Color 1)

**Row 21:** K1 (Color 1), P1 (Color 1), K1 (Color 1), RTS (Knit the front loop of 2<sup>nd</sup> stitch using Color 2 and the front loop of 1<sup>st</sup> stitch using Color 1), K5 (Color 1), P1 (Color 1), K1 (Color 1)

**Row 22:** K1 (Color 1), P1 (Color 1), K1 (Color 1), P5 (Color 1), P1 (Color 2), K1 (Color 1), P1 (Color 1), K1 (Color 1)

**Repeat Rows 3-22** until your project measures approx. 6 inches (15.25cm) in total length. End after a repeat of Row 22. Drop Color 2 Yarn. Bind off using Color 1 Yarn only.

Secure and weave in all ends.

Cut 4 pieces of Color 2 yarn approx. 6 inches (15.25cm) each. Take one strand and fold in half. Insert the folded section through one corner of your bracelet. Pull the ends through the loop that was created and pull tight. Repeat for all 4 corners. You've now seamlessly attached your strands to the bracelet to act as ties.
