Pebble Beach Hat Knitting Pattern



Materials:

- Yarn: Approximately 125-220 Yards of Worsted (4) Weight Yarn (I used Berroco Modern Cotton)
- Knitting Needles: Size 5.0 mm (US8) Double Pointed Needles (or use the Magic Loop Method) OR whatever size is needed to obtain gauge
- Yarn or Tapestry Needle

Abbreviations:

- K: Knit
- P: Purl
- Bobble Stitch: *K1 (don't drop from needles), Yarn Over* Repeat 2 more times in same knit stitch, Turn Work, Purl across those 6 sts, Turn Work, Knit Across those 6 sts, Turn Work, P2tog, P2tog, P2tog, Turn Work, K3tog
- K2tog: Knit the next 2 sts together
- P2tog: Purl the next 2 sts together
- K3tog: Knit the next 3 sts together
- **: Repeat the section in between the two stars as specified

Gauge:

10 sts and 13 rows = 2 inches (5 centimeters)
In Stockinette Stitch
It is important to check your gauge!

Average Head Circumference:

Newborn: 13-14"
0-3 Months: 14-15"
3-6 Months: 14-17"
6-12 Months: 16-19"
1-3 Years: 18-20"
3-10 Years: 19-20.5"
Pre-teen/Teen: 20.5-22"
Adult Female: 21.5-22.5"

Newborn Pattern

Cast on 95 sts onto Double Pointed Needles (or use the Magic Loop Method)

Join in the round and place stitch marker.

Round 1: Knit

Round 2: *P2tog, P17* Repeat around (90 total sts)

Round 3: *K8, K2tog, K8* Repeat around (85 total sts)

Round 4: *P2tog, P15* Repeat around (80 total sts)

Round 5: *K7, K2tog, K7* Repeat around (75 total sts)

Round 6: *P2tog, P13* Repeat around (70 total sts)

Round 7: *K6, K2tog, K6* Repeat around (65 total sts)

Round 8: *P2tog, P11* Repeat around (60 total sts)

Round 9: Knit

Repeat Round 9 until your project measures approx. 2 inches (5cm) from the cast on edge.

Round 10: *K2, Bobble Stitch, K3* Repeat around

Round 11: Knit

Round 12: *K5, Bobble Stitch* Repeat around

Round 13: Knit

Repeat Rounds 10-13 until your project measures approx. 3.5 inches (8.75cm) in length from the cast on edge.

Decreases:

Round 1: *K2tog, K10* Repeat around (55 total sts)

Round 2: *K2tog, K9* Repeat around (50 total sts)

Round 3: *K2tog, K8* Repeat around (45 total sts)

Round 4: *K2tog, K7* Repeat around (40 total sts)

Round 5: *K2tog, K6* Repeat around (35 total sts)

Round 6: *K2tog, K5* Repeat around (30 total sts)

Round 7: *K2tog, K4* Repeat around (25 total sts)

Round 8: *K2tog, K3* Repeat around (20 total sts)

Round 9: *K2tog, K2* Repeat around (15 total sts)

Round 10: *K2tog, K1* Repeat around (10 total sts)

Round 11: *K2tog* Repeat around (5 total sts)

Do not bind off. Cut approx. 7 inch tail. Using yarn needle, remove all sts from DPNs or magic loop, as if to purl. Pull tail through sts to cinch the top of hat. Using yarn needle, pull tail through to the inside of the hat. Tie a knot and weave in ends.

For a more feminine touch, choose a contrasting color and cut 6 or 9 strands of yarn approx. 28 inches (71cm) in length. Braid these strands and tie a knot on either end. Wrap this braided piece around your hat just above the brim and tie a large bow on the front or side.

0-3 Month Pattern

Cast on 100 sts onto Double Pointed Needles (or use the Magic Loop Method)

Join in the round and place stitch marker.

Round 1: Knit

Round 2: *P2tog, P18* Repeat around (95 total sts)

Round 3: *K9, K2tog, K8* Repeat around (90 total sts)

Round 4: *P2tog, P16* Repeat around (85 total sts)

Round 5: *K8, K2tog, K7* Repeat around (80 total sts)

Round 6: *P2tog, P14* Repeat around (75 total sts)

Round 7: *K7, K2tog, K6* Repeat around (70 total sts)

Round 8: *P2tog, P15, P2tog, P16* Repeat around (66 total sts)

Round 9: Knit

Repeat Round 9 until your project measures approx. 2 inches (5cm) from the cast on edge.

Round 10: *K2, Bobble Stitch, K3* Repeat around

Round 11: Knit

Round 12: *K5, Bobble Stitch* Repeat around

Round 13: Knit

Repeat Rounds 10-13 until your project measures approx. 3.75 inches (9.5cm) in length from the cast on edge.

Decreases:

Round 1: *K2tog, K9* Repeat around (60 total sts)

Round 2: *K2tog, K10* Repeat around (55 total sts)

Round 3: *K2tog, K9* Repeat around (50 total sts)

Round 4: *K2tog, K8* Repeat around (45 total sts)

Round 5: *K2tog, K7* Repeat around (40 total sts)

Round 6: *K2tog, K6* Repeat around (35 total sts)

Round 7: *K2tog, K5* Repeat around (30 total sts)

Round 8: *K2tog, K4* Repeat around (25 total sts)

Round 9: *K2tog, K3* Repeat around (20 total sts)

Round 10: *K2tog, K2* Repeat around (15 total sts)

Round 11: *K2tog, K1* Repeat around (10 total sts)

Round 12: *K2tog* Repeat around (5 total sts)

Do not bind off. Cut approx. 7 inch tail. Using yarn needle, remove all sts from DPNs or magic loop, as if to purl. Pull tail through sts to cinch the top of hat. Using yarn needle, pull tail through to the inside of the hat. Tie a knot and weave in ends.

3-6 Month Pattern

Cast on 120 sts onto Double Pointed Needles (or use the Magic Loop Method)

Join in the round and place stitch marker.

Round 1: Knit

Round 2: *P2tog, P22* Repeat around (115 total sts)

Round 3: *K11, K2tog, K10* Repeat around (110 total sts)

Round 4: *P2tog, P20* Repeat around (105 total sts)

Round 5: *K10, K2tog, K9* Repeat around (100 total sts)

Round 6: *P2tog, P18* Repeat around (95 total sts)

Round 7: *K9, K2tog, K8* Repeat around (90 total sts)

Round 8: *P2tog, P16* Repeat around (85 total sts)

Round 9: *K8, K2tog, K7* Repeat around (80 total sts)

Round 10: *P2tog, P38* Repeat around (78 total sts)

Round 11: Knit

Repeat Round 11 until your project measures approx. 2.5 inches (6.25cm) from the cast on edge.

Round 12: *K2, Bobble Stitch, K3* Repeat around

Round 13: Knit

Round 14: *K5, Bobble Stitch* Repeat around

Round 15: Knit

Repeat Rounds 12-15 until your project measures approx. 4 inches (10cm) in length from the cast on edge.

Decreases:

Round 1: *K2tog, K24* Repeat around (75 total sts)

Round 2: *K2tog, K13* Repeat around (70 total sts)

Round 3: *K2tog, K12* Repeat around (65 total sts)

Round 4: *K2tog, K11* Repeat around (60 total sts)

Round 5: *K2tog, K10* Repeat around (55 total sts)

Round 6: *K2tog, K9* Repeat around (50 total sts)

Round 7: *K2tog, K8* Repeat around (45 total sts)

Round 8: *K2tog, K7* Repeat around (40 total sts)

Round 9: *K2tog, K6* Repeat around (35 total sts)

Round 10: *K2tog, K5* Repeat around (30 total sts)

Round 11: *K2tog, K4* Repeat around (25 total sts)

Round 12: *K2tog, K3* Repeat around (20 total sts)

Round 13: *K2tog, K2* Repeat around (15 total sts)

Round 14: *K2tog, K1* Repeat around (10 total sts)

6-12 Month Pattern

Cast on 135 sts onto Double Pointed Needles (or use the Magic Loop Method)

Join in the round and place stitch marker.

Round 1: Knit

Round 2: *P2tog, P25* Repeat around (130 total sts)

Round 3: *K12, K2tog, K12* Repeat around (125 total sts)

Round 4: *P2tog, P23* Repeat around (120 total sts)

Round 5: *K11, K2tog, K11* Repeat around (115 total sts)

Round 6: *P2tog, P21* Repeat around (110 total sts)

Round 7: *K10, K2tog, K10* Repeat around (105 total sts)

Round 8: *P2tog, P19* Repeat around (100 total sts)

Round 9: *K9, K2tog, K9* Repeat around (95 total sts)

Round 10: *P2tog, P17* Repeat around (90 total sts)

Round 11: *K2tog, K13* Repeat around (84 total sts)

Round 12: Knit

Repeat Round 12 until your project measures approx. 2.5 inches (6.25cm) from the cast on edge.

Round 13: *K2, Bobble Stitch, K3* Repeat around

Round 14: Knit

Round 15: *K5, Bobble Stitch* Repeat around

Round 16: Knit

Repeat Rounds 13-16 until your project measures approx. 4.5 inches (11.5cm) in length from the cast on edge.

Decreases:

Round 1: *K2tog, K19* Repeat around (80 total sts)

Round 2: *K2tog, K14* Repeat around (75 total sts)

Round 3: *K2tog, K13* Repeat around (70 total sts)

Round 4: *K2tog, K12* Repeat around (65 total sts)

Round 5: *K2tog, K11* Repeat around (60 total sts)

Round 6: *K2tog, K10* Repeat around (55 total sts)

Round 7: *K2tog, K9* Repeat around (50 total sts)

Round 8: *K2tog, K8* Repeat around (45 total sts)

Round 9: *K2tog, K7* Repeat around (40 total sts)

Round 10: *K2tog, K6* Repeat around (35 total sts)

Round 11: *K2tog, K5* Repeat around (30 total sts)

Round 12: *K2tog, K4* Repeat around (25 total sts)

Round 13: *K2tog, K3* Repeat around (20 total sts)

Cast on 150 sts onto Double Pointed Needles (or use the Magic Loop Method)

Join in the round and place stitch marker.

Round 1: Knit

Round 2: *P2tog, P28* Repeat around (145 total sts)

Round 3: *K13, K2tog, K14* Repeat around (140 total sts)

Round 4: *P2tog, P26* Repeat around (135 total sts)

Round 5: *K12, K2tog, K13* Repeat around (130 total sts)

Round 6: *P2tog, P24* Repeat around (125 total sts)

Round 7: *K11, K2tog, K12* Repeat around (120 total sts)

Round 8: *P2tog, P22* Repeat around (115 total sts)

Round 9: *K10, K2tog, K11* Repeat around (110 total sts)

Round 10: *P2tog, P20* Repeat around (105 total sts)

Round 11: *K9, K2tog, K10* Repeat around (100 total sts)

Round 12: *P2tog, P18* Repeat around (95 total sts)

Round 13: *K8, K2tog, K9* Repeat around (90 total sts)

Round 14: Knit

Repeat Round 14 until your project measures approx. 2.75 inches (7cm) from the cast on edge.

Round 15: *K2, Bobble Stitch, K3* Repeat around

Round 16: Knit

Round 17: *K5, Bobble Stitch* Repeat around

Round 18: Knit

Repeat Rounds 15-18 until your project measures approx. 5 inches (12.75cm) in length from the cast on edge.

Decreases:

Round 1: *K2tog, K16* Repeat around (85 total sts)

Round 2: *K2tog, K15* Repeat around (80 total sts)

Round 3: *K2tog, K14* Repeat around (75 total sts)

Round 4: *K2tog, K13* Repeat around (70 total sts)

Round 5: *K2tog, K12* Repeat around (65 total sts)

Round 6: *K2tog, K11* Repeat around (60 total sts)

Round 7: *K2tog, K10* Repeat around (55 total sts)

Round 8: *K2tog, K9* Repeat around (50 total sts)

Round 9: *K2tog, K8* Repeat around (45 total sts)

Round 10: *K2tog, K7* Repeat around (40 total sts)

Round 11: *K2tog, K6* Repeat around (35 total sts)

Round 12: *K2tog, K5* Repeat around (30 total sts)

Cast on 175 sts onto Double Pointed Needles (or use the Magic Loop Method)

Join in the round and place stitch marker.

Round 1: Knit

Round 2: *P2tog, P33* Repeat around (170 total sts)

Round 3: *K16, K2tog, K16* Repeat around (165 total sts)

Round 4: *P2tog, P31* Repeat around (160 total sts)

Round 5: *K15, K2tog, K15* Repeat around (155 total sts)

Round 6: *P2tog, P29* Repeat around (150 total sts)

Round 7: *K14, K2tog, K14* Repeat around (145 total sts)

Round 8: *P2tog, P27* Repeat around (140 total sts)

Round 9: *K13, K2tog, K13* Repeat around (135 total sts)

Round 10: *P2tog, P25* Repeat around (130 total sts)

Round 11: *K12, K2tog, K12* Repeat around (125 total sts)

Round 12: *P2tog, P23* Repeat around (120 total sts)

Round 13: *K11, K2tog, K11* Repeat around (115 total sts)

Round 14: *P2tog, P21* Repeat around (110 total sts)

Round 15: *K10, K2tog, K10* Repeat around (105 total sts)

Round 16: *P2tog, P33* Repeat around (102 total sts)

Round 17: Knit

Repeat Round 17 until your project measures approx. 3 inches (7.5cm) from the cast on edge.

Round 18: *K2, Bobble Stitch, K3* Repeat around

Round 19: Knit

Round 20: *K5, Bobble Stitch* Repeat around

Round 21: Knit

Repeat Rounds 18-21 until your project measures approx. 6 inches (14cm) in length from the cast on edge.

Decreases:

Round 1: *K2tog, K49* Repeat around (100 total sts)

Round 2: *K2tog, K18* Repeat around (95 total sts)

Round 3: *K2tog, K17* Repeat around (90 total sts)

Round 4: *K2tog, K16* Repeat around (85 total sts)

Round 5: *K2tog, K15* Repeat around (80 total sts)

Round 6: *K2tog, K14* Repeat around (75 total sts)

Round 7: *K2tog, K13* Repeat around (70 total sts)

Round 8: *K2tog, K12* Repeat around (65 total sts)

Round 9: *K2tog, K11* Repeat around (60 total sts)

Round 10: *K2tog, K10* Repeat around (55 total sts)

Round 11: *K2tog, K9* Repeat around (50 total sts)

Round 12: *K2tog, K8* Repeat around (45 total sts)

Round 13: *K2tog, K7* Repeat around (40 total sts)

Round 14: *K2tog, K6* Repeat around (35 total sts)

Round 15: *K2tog, K5* Repeat around (30 total sts)

Round 16: *K2tog, K4* Repeat around (25 total sts)

Round 17: *K2tog, K3* Repeat around (20 total sts)

Round 18: *K2tog, K2* Repeat around (15 total sts)

Round 19: *K2tog, K1* Repeat around (10 total sts)

Round 20: *K2tog* Repeat around (5 total sts)

Do not bind off. Cut approx. 7 inch tail. Using yarn needle, remove all sts from DPNs or magic loop, as if to purl. Pull tail through sts to cinch the top of hat. Using yarn needle, pull tail through to the inside of the hat. Tie a knot and weave in ends.
