

## **Yellow Crochet Bandana Headband**

Skill Level: Easy

**Materials:** 

Yarn: Cascade Sunseeker (1.8oz)

Hook: US size 4.5 mm

**Notions:** Tapestry needle

## **Abbreviations:**

Sl st - Slip Stitch

Ch - Chain

Sc - Single Crochet

Dc - Double Crochet

## Crochet Bandana Pattern

Row 1: Ch 5, dc into the 5th chain from the hook, ch 2, dc into the same chain; turn.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc into the first stitch, skip 2 chains, 5 dc into the next stitch, skip 2 chains, sc into the next stitch; turn. (1 shell)

**Row 3:** Ch 5, dc into the first stitch, ch 2, \*skip 2 stitches, sc into the next stitch, ch 2, skip 2 stitches, dc into the next stitch, ch 2; repeat from \* to the end; dc into the same stitch; turn.

**Row 4:** Ch 1, sc into the first stitch, \*skip 2 chains, 5 dc into the next stitch, skip 2 chains, sc into the next stitch; repeat from \* to the end; turn. (2 shells)

Rows 5-32: repeat rows 3-4 (Shell count will be 16 on row 32)

Tie off and cut the yarn.

**Row 33:** Ch 32, join with the last stitch in row 32 of the bandana, sc into each chain stitch, ch 32. Tie off and cut the yarn. Weave in all the loose ends.
