

Foxy Pouch/Purse

This super cute design was made for those sneaky lil ones that have a soft spot for foxes. These would be great for the lil ones or added to a backpack or purse.



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Materials

- Yarn: 300 yds light worsted
- Hook: 4.0mm
- Notions: 2 buttons, large eye needle, large eye needle,

Sizing

- These measurements are approximated, and actual subjects may vary.
- Gauge: 4sts*2rows in 1 inch
- This pattern comes in the following sizes: not including tail

Size	Length	Width
One	8	6

Pattern Key

- Ch: Chain (for example)
- Dc: double crochet
- Sc: single crochet
- Dec: decrease
- Inc: increase
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Experience Level

- beginner

Pattern Instructions

Head

Starting each row of dc in a ch2 and in the same stitch

Using cream

Round 1: 10 dc into magic circle.

Round 2: *inc* repeat around (20 total sts)

Round 3: *dc in next st, inc* repeat around (30 total sts)

Round 4: *dc each of the next 2 sts, inc* repeat around (40 total sts)

Round 5: *dc each of the next 3 sts, inc* repeat around (50 total sts)

Round 6: dc each of the next 50 sts (50 total sts)

Change to orange or grey

Round 7-12: dc each of the next 50 sts (50 total sts)

Round 13: ch1, sc in same st* ch 3 skip 2 spaces sc in next st* sc in the last st repeat around (16 total ch spaces and 17 total sc)

Round 14: ch1 3sc in the ch spaces (48 total sts)

Leave a tail to sew in

Body

Using orange or grey

Round 1: 8 dc in magic circle

Round 2: * dc in the next st, inc* repeat around (16 total sts)

Round 3: *dc each of the next 2 sts, inc* repeat around (24 total sts)

Round 4: *dc each of the next 3 sts, inc* repeat around (32 total sts)

Round 5-8: dc each of the 32 sts (32 total sts)

Leave long tail to sew to head

Ears (make 2)

In black

Round 1: 6dc in magic circle

Change to orange/grey

Round 2: *dc in next st, inc* repeat around (9 total sts)

Round 3: *dc each of the next 2 sts, inc* repeat around (12 total sts)

Round 4: *dc each of the next 3 sts, inc* repeat around (15 total sts)

Round 5-6: dc each of the next 15 sts (15 total sts)

Tail

Finishing Notes: when you have finished sew the face and the feet the sew the body about half way up the cream on the back of the head make sure all your ends are sewn in

Finishing Notes: once you sew on the feet in the tutorial below sew the body onto the head of the piece about half way up the cream colour. sew the ear on as well
